SMOG ADVISORY

Due to stable atmospheric conditions, **smoggy conditions** are likely to **persist**. A shallow westerly wave will produce light to moderate rain in northeast Punjab & Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and snow over mountains bringing little relief. Less than average rainfall is expected in November-December, therefore **smog, fog and mist** will **remain prevalent phenomena**. Higher concentration of smog is expected in urban areas. Smog containing the pollutants may cause eye / throat irritations as well as difficulty in breathing. Public may exercise precautionary measures.
