5. **Road Situation (NHA and Respective Provinces)**

a. Due to a landslide, Gilgit - Skardu Road (RD 26) was blocked on 17 July 2016 at 1600 hours. The landslide was cleared on 18 July 2016 by 0700 hours and the road is open for traffic.

b. Due to landslides at three locations between Matti Khwar and Baradam near Lowari Tunnel on Dir - Chitral Road (N-45), the road was blocked on 17 July 2016 at 2300 hours. Work is underway to clear the slides. Damages / losses are being assessed by PDMA KP.

c. All other roads across the Country are clear for all types of traffic.

7. **Preliminary Losses / Damages Reported.** No losses / damages during reporting period, however, overall details of losses / damages during Monsoon Season 2016 are at **Annex B.**

**PAST METEOROLOGICAL SITUATION AND FUTURE FORECAST BY PMD**

1. **Significant Rainfall Reported**
  - a. **Punjab**. Sargodha 103 mm, Okara 75 mm, Sahiwal 50 mm.
  - b. **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**. Shinkhari 64 mm, D.I.Khan 53 mm.
2. **Flash Flood Reported**. Nothing to report.
3. **Weather Forecast Next 24 Hours**. Rain-thunderstorm with isolated heavy falls is expected at scattered places in KP (Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Mardan, Kohat, Bannu, D.I.Khan Divisions), FATA, Islamabad, Punjab (Sargodha, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Multan, D.G.Khan, Bahawalpur Divisions), Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir, Northeast Balochistan (Zhub, Sibbi, Naseerabad Divisions). ***Heavy downpour may generate Flash Flooding and Landslides in the vulnerable areas of KP, Punjab, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir.*** Light rain is also expected along Sindh-Makran coast.
4. **Weather Last 24 Hours**. Rain-thunderstorm occurred at a number of places in Islamabad, Upper / Central Punjab while at scattered places in KP, Gilgit-Baltistan and Northeast Balochistan and Hyderabad Division.
