AWARAN EARTHQUAKE BALOCHISTAN

SITUATION REPORT

(26 September 2013 at 1300 hrs)

- Earthquake Origin - Epicentre of earthquake was 120 kms South West of Khuzdar, Balochistan in Awaran District (Lat 27.09N, Long 65.61E).
- Time of Origin - On 24 September 2013, at 1630 hours
- Intensity - 7.7 on Richter scale
- After shocks - 11 Aftershocks of varying intensity
- Affected Areas - Awaran, Mashkay, Turbat (Kech)
- Summary of Initial losses and response is as follows:-

PDMA Punjab: Sent 50 tents, 500 food packs, 500 bags of atta (20 kg), 400 blankets and truck load of medicine airlifted by C-130 for Karachi

- **Medical Support**

- 1 x light field hospital with 10 Doctors (4 lady Doctors) and 31 paramedics.
- 3 x truck load of medicine from PDMA Sindh
- 4 Doctors and 6 nursing staff alongwith 2 tons of medicines, and one month of medicines.
- 5 Emergency Health Kits (sufficient for 1000 person each), 100 Trauma kits.
- One truck load of medicines sent from MSD Quetta
- **Provincial Health Department.** 3 x Medical Teams
 - **Team 1 (Awaran/Mashkay).** 5 Doctors, paramedics, requisite medicines.
 - **Team 2(Dandar).** 3 Doctors, paramedics, requisite medicines and one ambulance.
 - **Team 3 (Dandar).** 2 Doctors, paramedics, requisite medics and two ambulances.
