<u>Widespread Moderate / Heavy Rains Predicted in Upper Parts in Next Three Days</u> (Sunday – Tuesday)

(Impact: Urban / Flash Flooding, Risk of Riverine Floods)

A strong rainy system is likely to approach in upper parts of the Country that will produce widespread rain with heavy fall at a number of places in Punjab, Upper KP, GB / AJK during **Sunday (evening) to Tuesday (30 August 2020 to 1 September 2020).** Under the influence of this system: -

- Heavy to Very Heavy falls are also expected in Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Hafizabad, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Faisalabad, Jhang, Sargodha, Mianwali, Khushab, Toba Tek Singh from Monday to Wednesday (31 August 2020 to 2 September 2020). Heavy falls may also likely in Rajanpur, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur, Khanewal, Zhob and Barkhan.
- Heavy to Very Heavy falls are also expected in Dir, Swat, Buner, Shangla, Kohistan, Haripur, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Peshawar, Charsadda, Swabi, Mardan, Kohat and Kurram from Monday to Wednesday (31 August 2020 to 2 September 2020).

Note:

- Heavy rainfall may generate urban / flash flooding and Land Sliding in Vulnerable Areas from Monday to Tuesday (31 August 2020 to 1 September 2020).
- Flows are expected to increase significantly in rivers, streams and local nullahs.
- All Concerned Authorities are advised to remain ALERT particularly the reservoirs operators / water managers.
