Subject: Flood Advisory – Medium to High Flash in South Punjab, Sindh & Balochistan From 17 August (Evening) to 19 August 2024.

Widespread thunderstorm rain of Moderate to Heavy intensity with Scattered Very Heavy and Isolated Extremely Heavy falls is expected over Sindh along DG Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur, Zhob, Loralai, Nasirabad, Sibbi, Kalat and Makran Divisions.

Medium to High Level Flash Flooding is expected in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan division and in the Nullahs of Sibbi, Nasirabad, Zhob, Kalat Larkana and Hyderabad (Dadu and Naushahro Feroze Districts) Divisions from 17 August (Evening) to 19 August 2024. PDMAs, *Irrigation Departments* and respective district administration(s) / *DDMA*(s), municipal / city administration(s) of Balochistan, Sindh and Punjab are advised to ensure following: -

- a. Identification of vulnerable points / at-risk communities and devise mitigation and safety measures.
- Maintain enhanced alert level / monitoring of developing situation to reduce reaction / response times.
- c. All civic agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment during the mentioned period, especially in at-risk areas.
- d. People living along the banks of Rivers and their associated Tributaries / Nullahs to be sensitized about expected increase of water flows.
- e. Timely evacuation of at-risk population from low-lying / flood prone areas as per Evacuation Plans and ensure availability of shelter, food and medicines in those shelter camps.
- f. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be forewarned to shift cattle away from low lying areas adjacent to Rivers and their associated Tributaries / Nullahs.
- g. Restrict vehicle movement in **low lying / at-risk areas**, close to Rivers and its associated water channels, tributaries / nullahs.
- h. Provision of **POL** for **back-up generators** at **water pumping stations** and timely preplacement of **de-watering** equipment for **de-flooding**.
- i. DISCOs and relevant local administration / departments to ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken to avoid electrocution incidents and timely restoration

- of power supply.
- j. Coordinate with concerned departments for clearance of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction, waterlogging and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / appropriate locations.
- k. Travelers and tourists are forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
- I. In case of any eventuality, **Special SITREP / Update** be shared immediately with NDMA.
- 2. <u>Flood Forecasting Division Only</u>. Please share regular updates on water flows on major rivers, especially Hill torrents of Balochistan and Southern Punjab every 3 hours with NDMA.
- 3. <u>Press Information Department Only</u>. With the request for wider circulation and public awareness.
- 4. Forwarded for information / necessary action, please.
