





Faisalabad Smog Outlook (October 2023)

- Faisalabad city will face hazardous air quality conditions during the month of October.
- The primary factors behind this hazardous air quality are the presence of textile industries and ongoing urbanization.
- **Most Affected Areas:** Among the central areas of Faisalabad, including **Clock Tower, Nishatabad, Wapda City, Madina Town, Samnabad, and Liaqatabad**, Air Quality Index (AQI) will be higher in these locations as compared to other parts of the city.

Precaution Measures against Smog:

- Limit outdoor activities, and spend more time indoors during smoggy days.
- Wear masks when going outside to reduce inhalation of smog particles.
- Stay informed about local air quality levels and follow recommendations from authorities.
- Drink plenty of water to keep your respiratory system hydrated.
