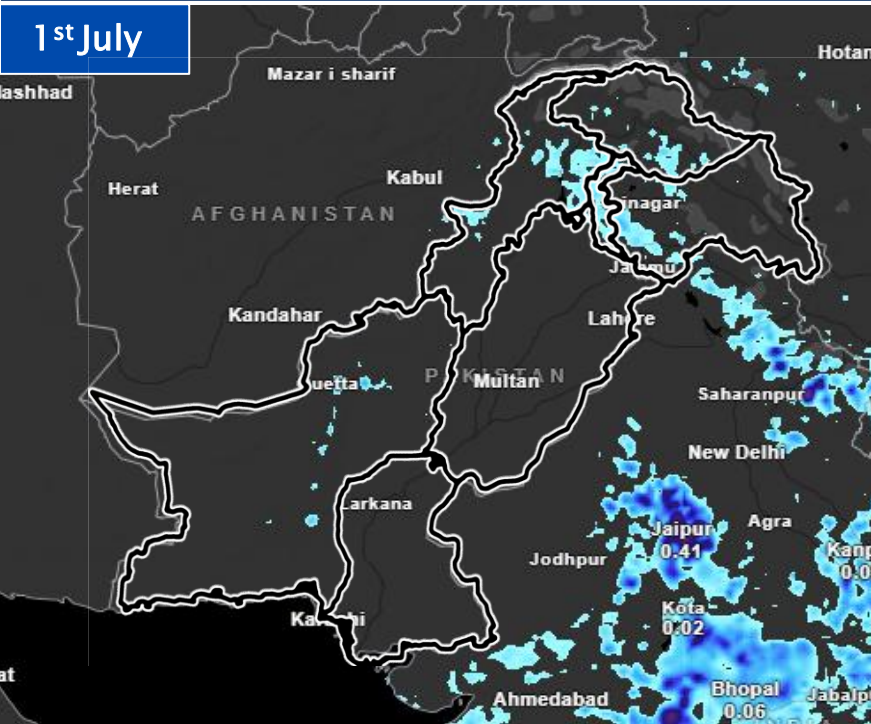




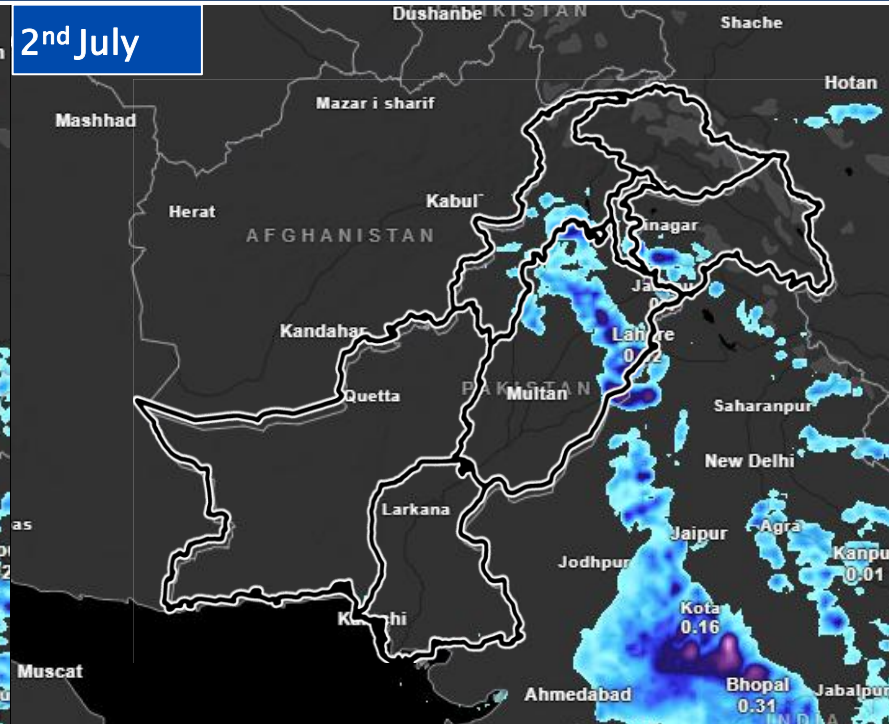

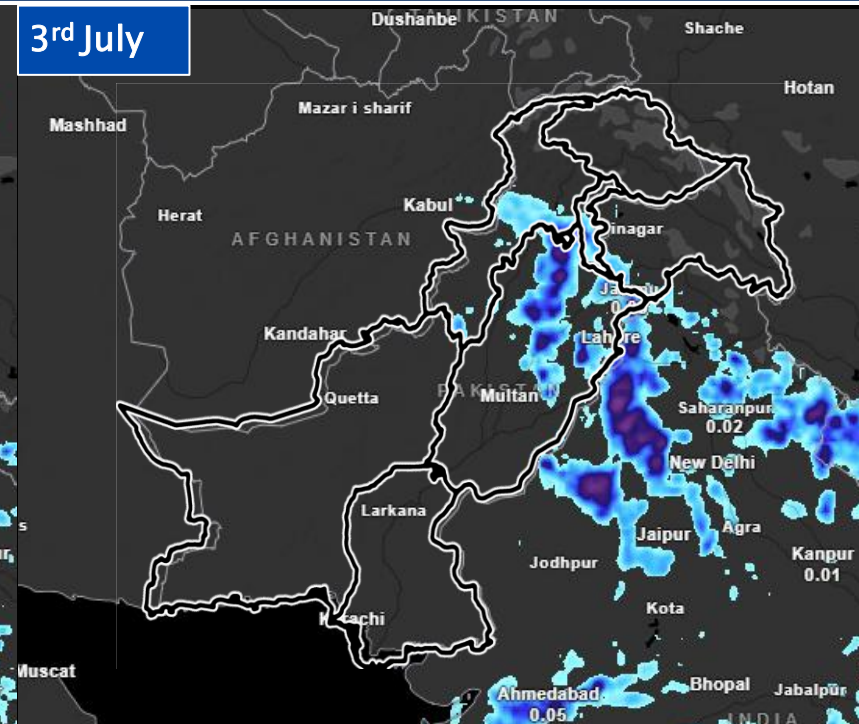

Moisture from the Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea is expected to bring moderate to heavy rainfall in most parts of the country in the coming days.

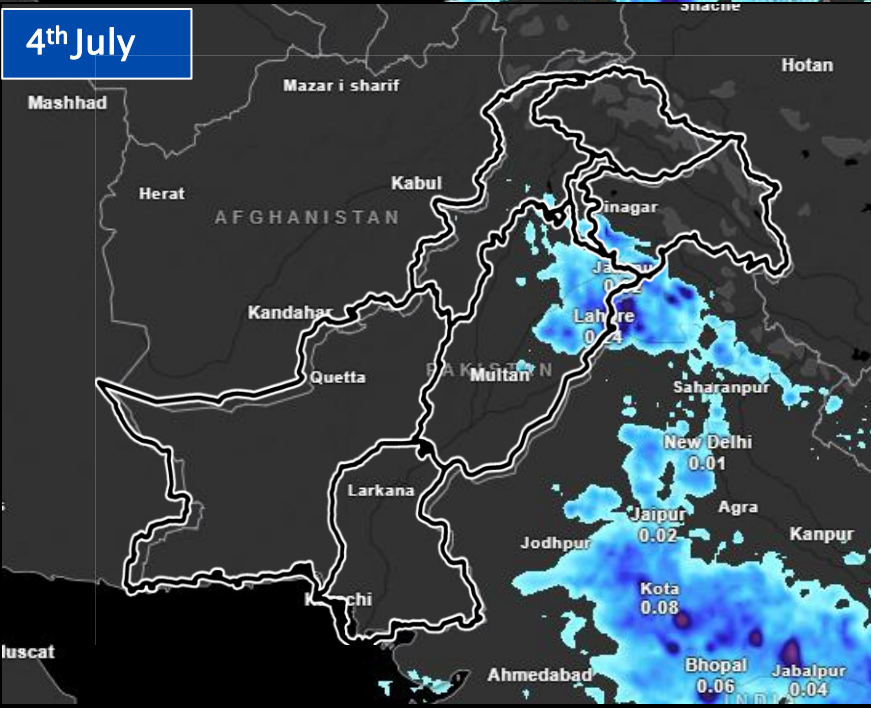
Punjab:

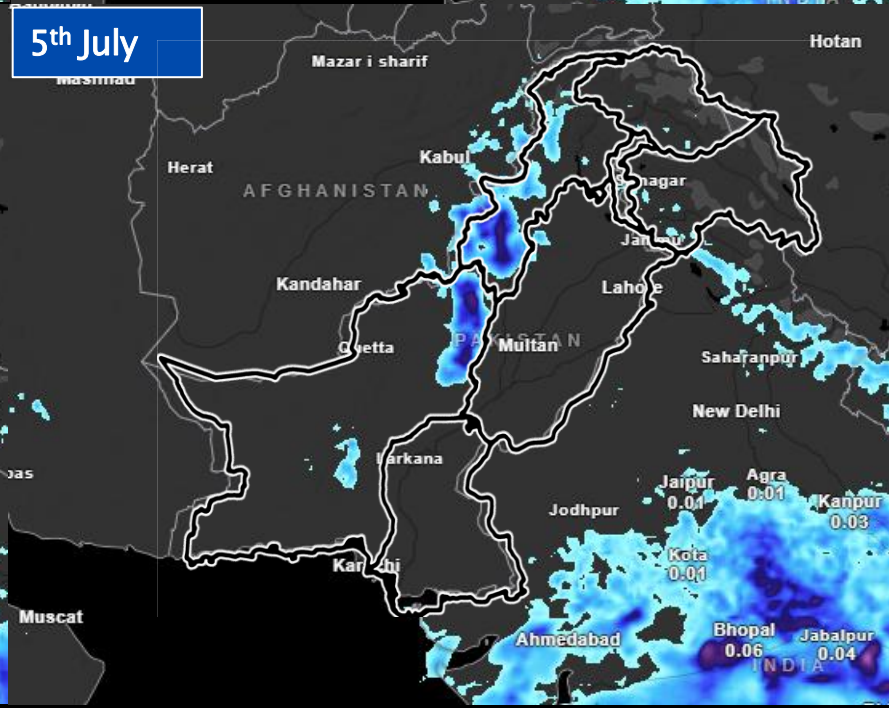
Balochistan:

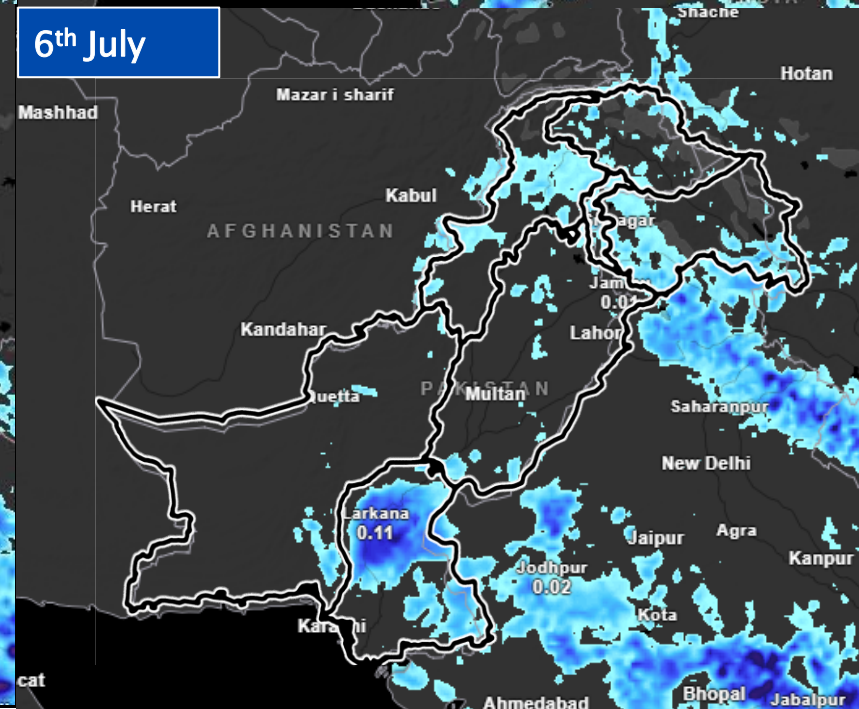
