




Weather Projection (5th July to 10th July)



Monsoon currents from the Arabian Sea and Bay of Bengal, along with a westerly wave, are forecasted to impact the upper and central parts of the country

Balochistan:

Rain-wind/thundershower with heavy rainfall is expected in Northern Eastern Balochistan from 5th to 7th July. However, hot and humid weather will prevail, with rain-wind/thundershower in southern parts from 8th to 10th July.

Sindh:

Rain-thunderstorm/winds with sporadic rain in Upper & Eastern Sindh from 5th to 7th July. However, hot and humid weather will prevail, with rain-wind/thundershower in south/Southeastern parts from 8th to 10th July.

Punjab:

Overall, rain/wind/thunderstorm is expected in Punjab with very heavy rainfall in upper/central/eastern parts of the Punjab from 5th to 7th July.

KP:

Overall, Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in KP with heavy rainfall likely in Upper & Central KP from 5th to 7th July.

Gb and AJ&K:

Thunderstorm/wind/rain with sporadic heavy showers are expected.
