Rain and thunderstorm with isolated heavy falls are expected in Abbottabad, Bajaur, Bannu, Battagram, Buner, Charsadda, Chitral, Dera Ismail Khan, Dir, Hangu, Haripur, Khyber, Kohat, Kohistan, Kurram, Lakki Marwat, Malakand, Mansehra, Mardan, Mohmand, Nowshera, Orakzai, Peshawar, Shangla, Swabi, Swat, and Waziristan.

Punjab:

Rain and thunderstorm with isolated heavy falls are expected in most parts of the province, including the Attock, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, Bhakkar, Chakwal, Chiniot, Dera Ghazi Khan, Faisalabad, Galliyat, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Hafizabad, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Jhang, Jhelum, Kasur, Khanpur, Khushab, Lahore, Layyah, Mandi Bahauddin, Mianwali, Multan, Murree, Nankana Sahib, Narowal, Okara, Pakpattan, Rahimyar Khan, Rajanpur, Sahiwal, Sargodha, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Tala Gang, Toba Tek Singh, and Wazirabad

Balochistan:

Thundershowers with sporadic rainfall is expected intermittently in different parts of the province, including Awaran, Barkhan, Harnai, Kalat, Khuzdar, Kohlu, Lasbella, Loralai, Naseerabad, Qila Abdullah, Qila Saifullah, Quetta, Sherani, Sibi, Ziarat, and Zhob

Sindh

Thundershowers and isolated rainfall are expected in Badin, Dadu, Hyderabad, Jacobabad, Karachi, Khairpur, Larkana, Mithi, Mirpur Khas, Sanghar, Sukkur, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tharparkar, Thatta, and Umerkot

AJ&K & GB:

Cloudy weather, along with chances of isolated rainfall with few heavy downpours are expected in various parts of the province However, most parts of Kashmir will experience isolated rainfall/heavy falls during this period.
