NDMA dispatched 28th consignment of relief goods to Palestine

09-02-2026



On the directions of the Prime Minister of Pakistan, NDMA dispatched another consignment of relief goods to Palestine. The 28th relief consignment, comprising 100 tons of supplies, was sent in collaboration with Al-Khidmat Foundation.

The relief goods, consisting of 100 tons of tents, were dispatched via a special flight from Allama Iqbal International Airport, Lahore. So far, a total of 2,727 tons of aid has been sent through 28 relief consignments. The special guest at the departure ceremony was Punjab Minister for Housing, MPA Mian Bilal Yasin.

Officials from NDMA and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, along with representatives of the government and Al-Khidmat Foundation, were also present at the ceremony. The Government of Pakistan and its people stand with the people of Palestine in this difficult time and will make every possible effort to meet their needs.

Syrian High-Level Delegation visit to NDMA HQs 11-02-2026



High-level delegation from Syria visited Pak National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) to gain insights into Pakistan's disaster management framework and explore opportunities for cooperation in disaster risk reduction and emergency response. The delegation was welcomed at the NDMA Headquarters, where officials provided a comprehensive briefing on Pakistan's national disaster management structure, operational mechanisms, and the role of the National Emergencies Operation Center (NEOC) in monitoring and responding to natural and man-made hazards.

During the visit, NDMA officials highlighted Pakistan's advancements in early warning systems, risk communication strategies, and the use of modern technologies for disaster preparedness and response. The delegation was also briefed on NDMA's coordinated approach with federal and provincial stakeholders to ensure timely humanitarian assistance and effective disaster response.

The Syrian delegation appreciated Pakistan's institutional capacity and the operational capabilities of the NEOC. Both sides expressed interest in strengthening collaboration through knowledge sharing, capacity building, and exchange of best practices in disaster management to enhance regional resilience against disasters.

NDMA Dispatched the 29th Humanitarian Aid Consignment for Gaza (Palestine)

12-02-2026



Under the patronage of the GOP, Pakistan's National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) has coordinated dispatched of additional humanitarian aid consignment for the people of Palestine. The 29th relief consignment, comprising 100 tons of food items, has been sent with the support of Alkhidmat Foundation. The relief goods including dates, flour, rice, MRE and cooking oil were dispatched through a chartered flight from Allama Iqbal International Airport, Lahore to Al-arish Egypt for onward delivery to Gaza.

With the dispatch of this latest consignment, the total volume of humanitarian assistance sent to Palestine through 29 consignments has reached 2,827 tons. The sending-off ceremony was attended by Senior officials from NDMA, MoFA, along with representatives of government departments and Alkhidmat Foundation.

Government of Pakistan and the people of Pakistan stand firmly with the people of Palestine in this difficult time and will continue to make every possible effort to support them and address their humanitarian needs.

NDMA Conducts Natural and Industrial Disaster Risk Awareness Session in Mirpur Mathelo (Sindh)

NDMA, in collaboration with Fauji Fertilizer Company (FFC) conducted a comprehensive awareness and capacity-building session at Sona Public School & College, Mirpur Mathelo (Sindh). Community volunteers, college staff and senior students were oriented on climate-induced disasters, the evolving impacts of climate change in Sindh, and practical mitigation, community-level DRR, and response measures.

The session emphasized risk-informed preparedness and the role of youth as resilience ambassadors within their communities. Participants were also sensitized to industrial hazard risk mitigation, reflecting the importance of integrated disaster risk management in industrial zones. Group learning, physical mock drills, visual content and other interactive mediums were used for better understanding.

The activity brought together community representatives, district administration, and local NGOs, reinforcing a multi-stakeholder approach to resilience building. Students and community volunteers received hands-on training in, Basic Life Support (BLS), Fire Safety & Emergency Response and Response Coordination Mechanisms. Experts from NDMA, FFC-MM HSEQ Team and Rescue 1122 Ghotki facilitated the learning.

The initiative reflects NDMA's commitment to strengthening preparedness, enhancing public awareness, and promoting public-private partnerships for a safer and climate-resilient Pakistan.

Mr. Albert Khorev, Ambassador of the Russian Federation; and Mr. Anton Vereshchagin, Third Secretary and Head of the Bilateral Section, Embassy of the Russian Federation.

The visit focused on exploring avenues to enhance cooperation at both bilateral and multilateral levels in the field of disaster management. Discussions emphasized strengthening collaboration through information and experience exchange, capacity-building initiatives, and joint exercises. The proposal to establish a network of regional logistics hubs was also deliberated as a means to reinforce coordinated global efforts in disaster preparedness, response, and prevention.


