




## Rains & Floods – Malaysia



Valid: From February 10<sup>th</sup> to February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026

### Affected Areas:

Most affected Areas include: Penang (George Town), Perak, Selangor, Kuala Lumpur. Moreover, with severely affected: Central-western Peninsular Malaysia, including parts of Selangor-Kuala Lumpur corridor and coastal Perak.

### Hazard Types

Heavy to very heavy rainfall; Flash flooding; Urban flooding; Landslides in hilly terrain; Transport and drainage disruption.

### Hazard Summary

A persistent low-level convergence zone and deep convective instability over Peninsular Malaysia are driving sustained heavy rainfall, particularly across central and western regions. Repeated convective cells and high moisture availability are elevating risks of flash flooding, urban inundation, and localized slope failures.
