

Tropical Cyclone across the Mascarene Archipelago and Eastern Madagascar



Hazards Summary

A tropical cyclone induced disturbance is generating significant atmospheric instability across the Mascarene Archipelago and nearby regions. Elevated Convective Available Potential Energy (CAPE) indicates a strong potential for sudden and intense thunderstorms, frequent lightning, and torrential rainfall. These conditions may lead to flash flooding and landslides, particularly in mountainous areas. Affected regions include Mauritius, Rodrigues Island, La Réunion, St-Brandon, and the eastern coast of Madagascar, where persistent heavy rainfall, thunderstorms, and rough sea conditions are expected over the coming days.
