Heatwave in Hungary



Hungary experienced a protracted heatwave in August 2024, with highs of up to 40 degrees Celsius in several areas of the nation. The nation's agriculture has been severely harmed by the severe drought that has been brought on by high temperatures and little rainfall.

From orbit, the effects of the drought on the southern soils of the nation are discernible. This image, taken on August 31, 2024, by a Copernicus Sentinel-2 satellite, shows how barren and brownish the fields appear due to the lack of vegetation.
