River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala is in Exceptionally High flood level & is steady and at Sulemanki is in Low flood level and rising. River Indus at Guddu is in low flood level.

remain in Exceptionally High Flood Level (subject to the releases from India). River Sutlej at Sulemanki is likely to attain High to Very High flood Level during 24-hours and at Islam, High flood level from 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2023.
