### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

### **HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:**

River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala is in High flood level & Rising. River Indus at Guddu is in Low flood

WARNING: According to latest Hydro-meteorological conditions, River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala is likely to remain in Very High Flood Level (subject to the releases from India). River Sutlej at Sulemanki is likely to attain High to Very High flood Level after 24-hours and at Islam High flood level, from 21st August 2023.

#### **II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. A fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northern parts of Iran.
- b. A low-pressure area has developed over Northwest Bay of Bengal.
- c. Light to moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over Northeast Balochistan.

### III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Islamabad along with Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala & Lahore Divisions.
