EMERGENCY TENDER NOTICE

Procurement of Medicines

National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Islamabad intends to invite bids from authorized distributors/ suppliers/ service providers etc. duly registered with Income Tax and Sales Tax and shall be in Active Taxpayer List (ATL) of the Federal Board of Revenue for procurement of medicines as per details given in **Annex-A**.

2. The sealed bids prepared in accordance with the terms and conditions (enclosed) shall be submitted **at 1200 hours on 18th March 2026 (Wednesday)**. Sealed bids will be opened at 1230 hours on the same day in the presence of bidder's representatives who chose to attend in the bid opening at NDMA Headquarters Islamabad.

3. All bids, accompanied by a Bid Security amount to Rs. **5,000,000/-** (Rupees Five Million only) in the form of Pay Order/ Demand Draft, **must reach at the address mentioned below on or before the bid submission deadline as mentioned above.**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: -

1. Quoted rates must be inclusive of all applicable government taxes duties.
2. Items must strictly conform to the specifications and brands provided by NDMA. Bids offering substandard or low-quality brands will be rejected outrightly.
3. NDMA reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity based on evolving requirements.
4. No advance payment will be made. Payment will be processed after full delivery. subject to a satisfactory inspection report, and after deduction of all applicable taxes.
5. NDMA reserves the right to impose a penalty of 0.2% per day on any 'late-delivered quantity.
6. For imported product, the bidder must provide NoC that it can be used outside Pakistan, if required.
7. Firms must mention details of their readily available stock, Daily production capacity and estimated time required to complete the full delivery NDMA may give preference to firms offering shorter delivery timelines.
8. **Packing standard:** All medicines shall be packed in strong, export-quality cartons (approx. 2x2x2 feet), suitable for long-term storage, stacking, and transportation under field conditions.
9. **Carton Quality:** Cartons must be of high-strength corrugated material (minimum 5-ply) to withstand handling, humidity, and transportation stress without deformation.
10. **Labelling/Marking:** Each carton must bear a clearly visible NDMA logo sticker.
11. A detailed contents list shall be pasted on each carton indicating: -
 - a. Name of medicine.
 - b. Dosage form and strength.
 - c. Batch number.
 - d. Quantity per carton.
 - e. Manufacturing & Expiry dates.
12. **Expiry Requirements:** Medicines must have maximum available shelf life, and in any case, not less than 80% of total shelf life remaining at the time of delivery.
13. **Batch Uniformity:** As far as practicable, supplies shall be batch-wise uniforms to facilitate inventory management and traceability.
14. **Inspection Compliance:** Supply shall be subject to Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) at supplier premises and Post-Delivery Verification at NDMA warehouses, as per prescribed guidelines. No consignment shall be accepted without compliance with PDI requirements.
