**NDMA SITUATION REPORT ON COVID-19 NO. 08 (22 MARCH 2020)**

1. World Health Organisation (WHO) has declared Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) a pandemic. Furthermore, the Government of Pakistan has declared a National Health Emergency of Public Concern in regard to the same on 13 March 2020. The National Institute of Health (NIH) Risk Assessment for COVID-19 in Pakistan is currently **HIGH**. As per World Health Organisation (WHO), Global Confirmed Cases are 266,073 and Global Deaths are 11,184.
