


**NDMA SITUATION REPORT ON COVID-19 NO. 09 (23 MARCH 2020)**

1. World Health Organisation (WHO) has declared Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) a pandemic. The Government of Pakistan has declared a National Health Emergency of Public Concern in regard to the same on 13 March 2020. The National Institute of Health (NIH) Risk Assessment for COVID-19 in Pakistan is currently **HIGH**. Provincial Governments in Balochistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Punjab, Sindh and Gilgit Baltistan have ordered a lockdown for the next 15 days in order to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 throughout the country.
2. As per World Health Organisation (WHO), Global Confirmed Cases are 292,142 and Global Deaths are 12,784.

- (6) **GB**. 493 x Pilgrims at Gilgit Baltistan are quarantined at various locations in Gilgit & Skardu.
5. **NDMA**. Following actions were undertaken: -
- Lahore Railway Station was decontaminated today.
  - NDMA disseminated COVID-19 Awareness SMS in coordination with Pakistan Telecommunications Authority (PTA) to travellers who recently returned to the country after performing Umrah in Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
6. **COVID-19 National Case Summary**. In the last 24 hours an increase of **213** confirmed cases occurred in the country. Total confirmed cases in Pakistan are now **875**. Complete COVID-19 National Case Summary is attached at **Annex A**.
7. **COVID-19 National Quarantine / Isolation Facilities**. Summary of available facilities at **Annex B**.
8. **COVID-19 Testing Facilities**. Fifteen testing facilities are available in the country. Details are attached at **Annex C**.
