Subject: <u>SIGNIFICANT FLOOD WARNING FOR EASTERN RIVERS & ASSOCIATED</u> NULLAHS

A Well-marked Monsoon low is present over Northwest Rajasthan, while a strong trough of a Westerly Wave lies over the Northern parts of the country. As a result of the combined effect of these significant weather systems Widespread Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall, along with Torrential Downpours at scattered locations is expected over the Upper catchments of Rivers Sutlej & Beas (Upstream of Ganda Singh Wala), Ravi, and Chenab, as well as in Lahore, Gujranwala and Gujrat Divisions during 1st to 3rd September 2025.

- 2. Forecasted rains have the potential to generate VERY HIGH TO EXTREMELY HIGH FLOWS in Rivers Sutlej, Ravi, & Chenab and along its Associated Nullah. The Heavy Downpour may also cause the Urban Flooding in Lahore, Gujranwala and Gujrat Divisions. Flood Forecasting Division Warning No A-12/2025 dated 31 August 2025 attached as Annex-A. All concerned Authorities are advised to take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period and ensure the following: -
 - Maintain enhanced alert level / monitoring of developing situation to reduce reaction / response times.
 - b. All civil agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment during this period, especially in at-risk areas.
 - Identification of vulnerable points / at-risk communities and devise mitigation and safety measures.
 - d. Launch urgent evacuation of trapped population using boats, heavy vehicles, and helicopters (if required).
 - e. **Prioritize vulnerable groups** (women, children, elderly, persons with disabilities).
 - f. Fully operationalize pre-identified relief camps with adequate capacity.
 - g. Deploy mobile medical units and health teams in flood-hit areas.
 - h. **Ensure availability of vaccine** (especially against waterborne diseases like cholera, diarrhea, snake bite and dengue).
 - Maintain strict control on vehicular movement near breached or inundated areas.

- j. Strengthen vulnerable embankments with sandbags and heavy machinery.
- k. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be forewarned to shift cattle away from low
 lying areas adjacent to Eastern Rivers & associated Nullahs.
- I. Ensure availability of fodder for livestock at designated safe sites.
- Provision of POL for back-up generators at water pumping stations and timely pre-placement of de-watering equipment for de-flooding.
- n. DISCOs and relevant Local Administration / Departments to ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken to avoid electrocution incidents and timely restoration of power supply.
- o. Coordinate with concerned departments for **clearance of roads** in case of any blockage / obstruction & waterlogging and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / appropriate locations.
- p. Travelers and Tourists are forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
- q. Highlight critical needs immediately for federal support.
- 2. <u>Flood Forecasting Division Only</u>. Please share regular updates on water flows on major rivers, especially Eastern Rivers & associated Nullahs every 3 hours with NDMA.
- 3. <u>Press Information Department Only</u>. With the request for wider circulation and public awareness.

SIGNIFICANT FLOOD WARNING

for Eastern Rivers & Associated Nullahs

A well-marked monsoon low is present over northwest Rajasthan, while a strong trough of a westerly wave lies over the northern parts of the country.

- 1. As a result of the combined affect of these significant weather systems, Widespread Heavy to Very Heavy rainfall, along with Torrential downpours at scattered locations, is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Sutlej & Beas (Upstream of Ganda Singh Wala), Ravi, and Chenab, as well as in Lahore, Gujranwala and Gujrat Divisions during 1st to 3rd September 2025.
- 2. Forecasted rains have the potential to generate **VERY HIGH TO EX-HIGH FLOWS** in Rivers Sutlej, Ravi, and Chenab, along with the Associated Nullahs of Rivers Ravi and Chenab and produce the **Urban Flooding in Lahore**, Gujranwala and Gujrat Divisions.
