Subject: Tropical Cyclone "TAUKTAE" in the Southeast Arabian Sea

Fresh Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) Tropical Cyclone (TC) Alert dated 15 May 2021 is attached as "Annex-A". It is informed that, the Depression over Southeast Arabian has intensified into a Cyclonic Storm "TAUKTAE" and lay centered near latitude 12.7N and longitude 72.3E, at a distance of about 1,460 km south-southeast of Karachi at 0800 hours PST on 15 May 2021. Maximum sustained winds around the system centre are 70-90 kmph gusting to 100 kmph. The system is likely to intensify further into a Severe Cyclonic Storm (SCS) during next 12-18 hours and move in north-northwest direction and reach Indian Gujarat by 18 May 2021 morning. According to present environmental conditions and under the influence of this system:-

- a. Widespread rain-dust / thunderstorms with few heavy to very heavy falls and gusty winds of 70-90 kmph are likely to occur in Districts Thatta, Badin, Tharparkar, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot & Sanghar from **17 May to 20 May 2021**.
- b. Rain-dust / thunderstorms with few heavy falls and gusty winds of 40-60 kmph are also likely in Districts Karachi, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Shaeed Banzirabad, Sukkur, Larkana, Shikarpur, Jacobabad and Dadu from **18-20 May 2021**.
- c. Sea Conditions will be rough to very rough and fishermen are advised not to venture into the sea from **16-20 May 2021**.
- 2. All concerned are requested to remain Alert and ensure following precautionary measures to avoid any loss of life or property:
 - a. Joint Maritime Information Control Centre (JMICC) to closely monitor the situation and apprise all concerned accordingly.
 - b. PDMAs to coordinate with concerned departments for restoration basic services and ensure following:-
 - (1) Arrange and pre-place necessary inventory and other essentials at vulnerable locations.
 - (2) Advise Fishermen community to avoid going into deep sea till 20th May 2021.

- (3) Coordinate with relevant District & Municipal Administrations to secure or remove billboards / hoardings in light of highspeed / gusty winds.
- (4) Travelers be apprised about weather forecast.
- c. Relevant departments may issue necessary instructions to stakeholders in the light of weather forecast.
- d. In case of any eventuality, twice daily updates should be shared with NDMA.



Tropical Cyclone "TAUKTAE" in the Southeast Arabian Sea

The Depression over Southeast Ambian has intensified into a Cyclonic Storm "TAUKTAE" and lay centered at 0000 PST of 15 May 2021 near latitude 12.7N and longitude 72.3E, at a distance of about 1460 Km south-southeast of Karachi. Maximum sustained winds around the system centre are 70-90 Kmph. gusting to 100 Knoph. The system is likely to intensify further into a Severe Cyclonic Storm (SCS) during next 12-18 hours and move in north-northwest direction and reach Indian Gujarat by 18th May morning.

According to present environmental conditions and under the influence of this system, widespread mindust/thunderstorm with few heavy to very heavy falls and gusty winds of 70-90 Kmph are likely to occur in Thatta, Badin, Thur, Mirpurkhus, Umerkot & Sanghar districts from 17 May to 20 May 2021. Raindust/thunderstorm with few heavy falls and gusty winds of 40-60 Kmph are also likely in Karachi, Hyderahad, Jamishoro, Shaced Banzirabad, Sukkur, Larkana, Shikamur, Jacobabad and Dadu during 18-20 May 2021; Sea Conditions will be rough to very rough and fishermen are advised not to venture in the sea during 16-20 May 2021.
