

Pakistan Meteorological Department (*PMD Press Release at Annex-A*) have forecasted that a **westerly wave** is entering from **9**th **March 2024** and likely to extend to upper parts on **11**th **March 2024**. Followed by another westerly wave on **12**th **March 2024**. Under the influence, **Rainwind / Thunderstorms with snowfall over hills is expected** in following areas of the country: -



2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -

a. KP, GB, Murree, Galliyat

- (1) Snowfall may **disrupt roads** in Murree, Galliyat, Naran, Kaghan, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Shangla, Astore, Hunza, Skardu, Neelum valley, Bagh, Poonch and Haveli during the forecast period.
- (2) **Tourists** are advised to **remain cautious** during the spell and check weather updates before traveling.
- (3) Electricity / other utility services may get disrupted.
- (4) Landslides, mudslides, isolated rain spells and snowfall may lead to potential road blockages in Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Murree, Galliyat, Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan.
- (5) **Temperatures** are likely to **drop** significantly.

b. Balochistan and Southern Punjab

- (1) Heavy rainfall may cause flash flooding in local nullahs.
- (2) Landslides / mudslides may lead to potential road blockages due to isolated rain spell.
- (3) **Farmers** are advised to remain **extra cautious** and plan agricultural activity accordingly during the spell.
- 3. All PDMAs / GBDMA / SDMA and ICT Administration, NHA, NH&MP, FWO, Rescue 1122, Dam Authorities, Line Departments, Ministries and Federal Agencies are required to undertake measures as per respective mandates. However, following is to be ensured by all concerned, in addition to measures deemed appropriate as per on ground situation / requirements: -
 - Ensure round-the-clock monitoring of the situation through EOCs with regular feedback to PEOCs and NEOC.
 - DDMA/ District Administration are advised to relocate families to safe sites and shelters from mud houses in order to prevent casualties.
 - c. **Forewarn travelers** / **visitors** about risks posed from flooding / landslides and likely snowfall over mountains in vulnerable locations and **provide guidance and assistance** in case of emergencies through local administration, police and rescue services.
 - d. Ensure that in places where there is a high risk of urban floods, flash flooding, hill torrents and landslides emergency services, personnel and equipment (such as Rescue 1122, Fire Brigade, Ambulance and Civil Defense, among others) are available.
 - e. **Preplace necessary emergency equipment** at vulnerable / strategic locations to expedite response efforts and **complete stocking** / replenishment of stocks.
 - f. NH&MP and Traffic Police to **coordinate** with **Law Enforcement Agencies** to **manage** and **redirect traffic** from affected areas to safer areas, to prevent congestion and

facilitate emergency response efforts.

- g. NHA / Line Departments to conduct regular inspections of critical infrastructure, such as bridges and roads, to identify and address any vulnerability that may lead to structural damage during heavy rainfall.
- h. PMD / FFD / PDMAs / PIDs to **proactively monitor nullahs** / **storm water drains**, to ensure their proper functioning and prevent blockages that may lead to inundation.
- i. Ensure widespread circulation of alerts and advisories, especially in local languages, to raise awareness and sensitize travelers / tourists and local communities in at-risk / vulnerable areas.
- j. Coordinate with relevant departments to secure loose structures such as electrical poles, solar panels, hoardings and under-construction buildings to mitigate potential damages from dust-wind / thunderstorms.
- k. Conduct mass public awareness campaigns to educate residents and travelers in vulnerable areas about the risks of flash flooding / landslides / avalanche / blizzard and take precautionary measures.
- I. Advise general public to seek shelter in safe areas, such as sturdy buildings or underground structures during dust-wind / hail-thunderstorms and avoid objects that pose a risk of falling / being struck by lightning.
- m. **Strengthen coordination** among all **relevant departments** and agencies to facilitate timely **sharing of information** and resources during emergency situations.
- n. **Establish reliable communication channels** with local communities to provide timely updates, instructions and emergency contact information.
- o. Advise farmers to take necessary mitigative and precautionary measures to safeguard their crops through timely harvesting, safe storage or any other precaution from adverse effects of dust-wind-thunderstorms / hailstorms and likely drop in temperatures.
- p. Share daily / routine updates with NDMA in case of any eventuality.

Rain with Wind/Thunderstorm predicted in the country.

Met Office informed that a westerly wave is likely to enter Balochistan on 09th March and likely to extend to upper parts on 11th March. Followed by another westerly wave on 12th March. Under the influence of these weather system:

Balochistan: Rain-wind/thunderstorm with isolated heavy falls in Turbat, Kech, Gwadar, Jiwani, Pasni, Ormara, Panjgur, Kharan, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella and Awaran on 09th (evening/night) & 10th March. While, rain-wind/thunderstorm (snowfall over the hills) is expected in Chagi, Noushki, Washuk, Mastung, Sibbi, Naseerabad, Zhob, Sherani, Barkhan, Musakhel, Kohlu, Jhal Magsi, Loralai, Ziarat, Quetta, Chaman, Pishin, Qila Abdullah and Qila Saifullah from 10th to 13th March with occasional gaps.

Khvber Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-wind/thunderstorm (snowfall over the hills) is expected in Waziristan, Kohat, Lakki Marwat, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Abbottabad, Mansehra, Haripur, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Bajaur, Karak, Khyber, Peshawar, Charsadda, Nowshera, Swabi, Mardan and Kurram from 10th (evening/night), 11th March & 12th (evening/night) to 14th March. Isolated heavy fall and hailstorm is also expected on 13th and 14th March.

Gilgit-Baltistan/Kashmir: Rain-wind/thunderstorm (snowfall over the hills) is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar), Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from 11th & 12 (night) to 15th March.

Punjab/Islamabad: Rain-wind/thunderstorm with few heavyfalls is expected in Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Jhang, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali and Bhakkar from 11th, 12th (evening/night) to 14th March. Rain-wind/thunderstorm is also expected in Multan, Kot Addu, Layyah, Rajanpur, Dera Ghazi Khan, Muzaffargarh, Rahim Yar Khan, Sadiqabad, Khanpur, Sahiwal, Bahawalpur and Bahawalnagar on 13th March. Isolated hailstorm is also likely during the period.

Sindh: Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Larkana and Dadu on 10th & 12th March during evening/night. Dry/windy weather is expected in southern parts of the province.

Possible Impacts and advises:

- Heavy rainfall may cause flash flooding in local nullah's of Gwadar, Ketch, Turbat, Panjgur on 09th (night) & 10th March,
 While snowfall may distrupt traffic flows in northern parts of Balochistan from 10th to 13th March.
- Heavy rain with isolated heavy snowfall may cause closure of roads in Murree, Galiyat, Naran, Kaghan, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Shangla, Astore, Hunza, Skardu, Neelum valley, Bagh, Poonch and Haveli on 13th & 14th March.
- Landslides in Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Murree, Galiyat, Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan may affect the vulnerable
 points in the area during the wet spell.
- Wind-thunderstorm/hailstorm may damage loose structures like electric poles, Vehicles and solar panels etc.
- Tourists are advised not to travel unnecessarily, while Farmers are advised to remain cautious about their crops

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period.
