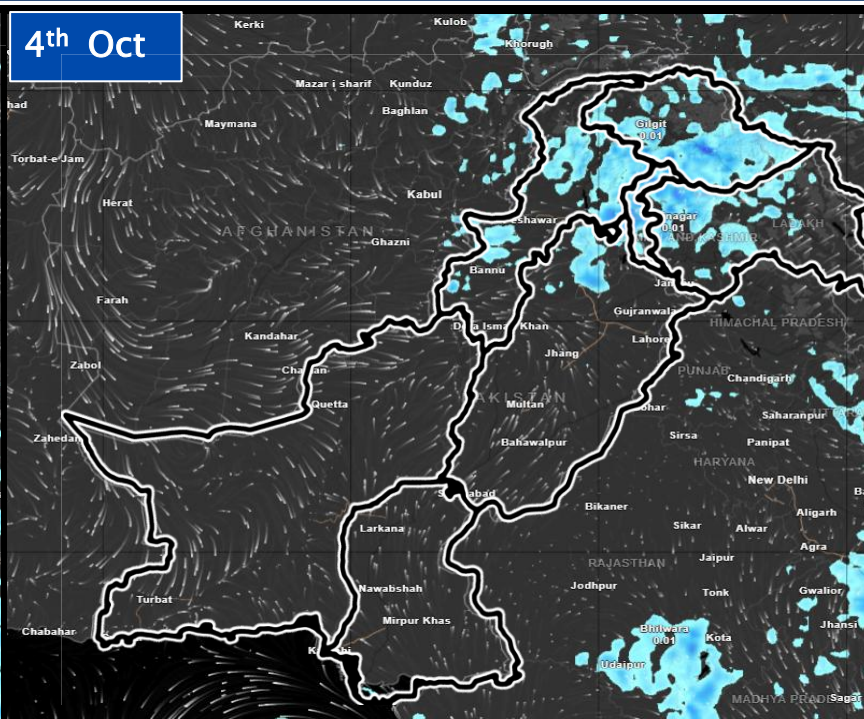
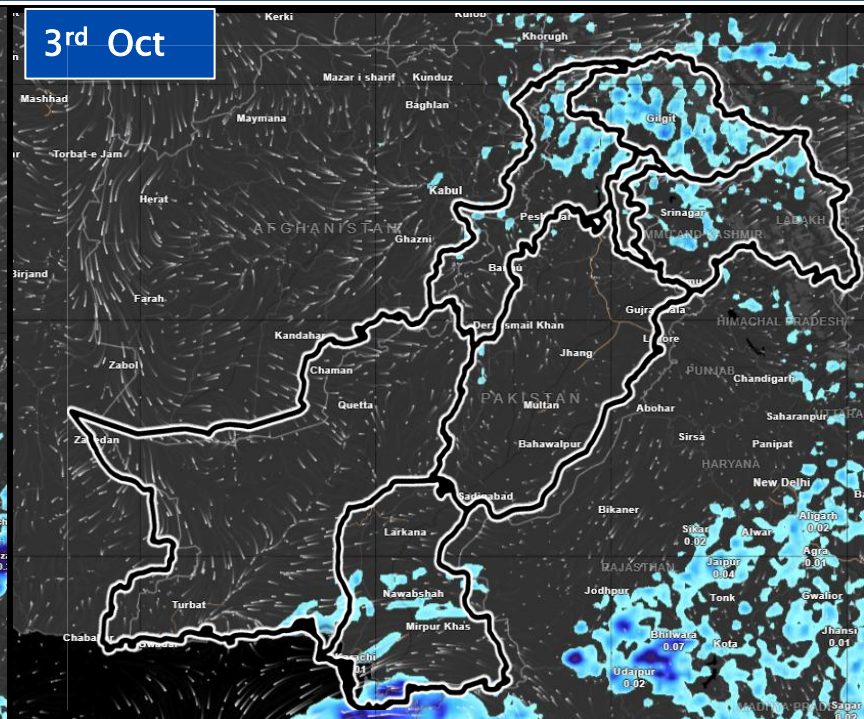
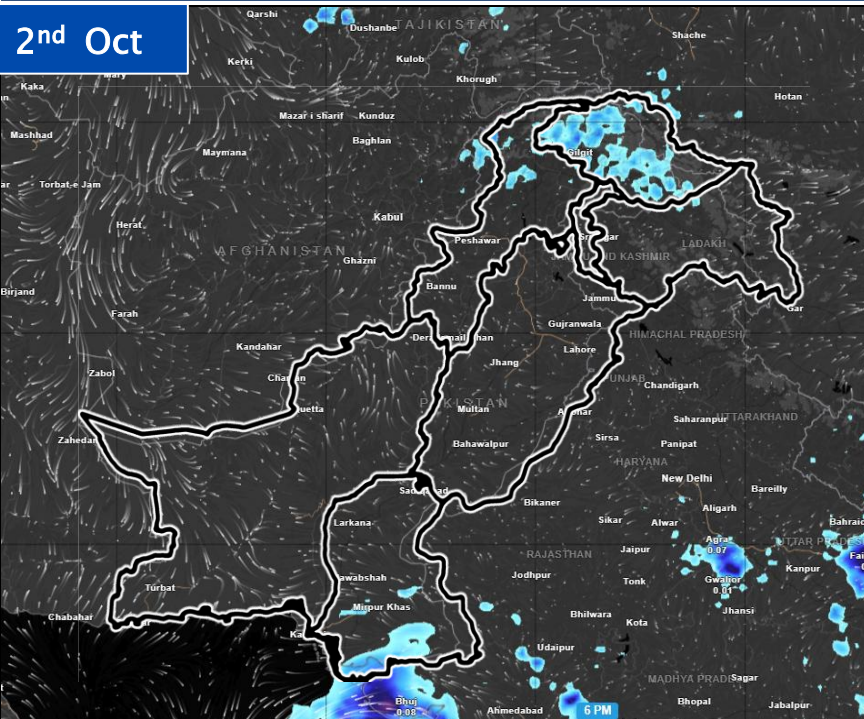




Weather Advisory (2nd to 7th October, 2025)

National Emergency Operation Centre – National Disaster Management Authority



A strong westerly disturbance will affect Pakistan from 4th to 7th of October 2025, bringing light to moderate rain with isolated thunderstorms over KP, northeastern and central Punjab, along with a noticeable drop in temperatures due to cold continental air.

Punjab:

Isolated rainfall, and thunderstorms are expected in upper and central parts of the province including Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Hafizabad, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Okara, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Multan, Bahawalpur, Rahim yar Khan, Dera Ghazi Khan, and surrounding areas from 4th to 4th of October, 2025 with occasional gaps.

Balochistan:

Isolated rainfall is expected in Quetta, Zhob, Ziarat, Kalat, and surrounding areas from 4th to 6th of October, 2025.

Sindh:

Mostly dry weather is expected in most parts of the province. However, Isolated rainfall is expected in souther parts of the province including Karachi, Hyderabad, Tharparkar, Thatta, Badin, Mirpur Khas, and surrounding areas on 3rd of October, 2025.

KP:

Isolated rainfall and thunderstorm is expected in Chitral, Dir, Haripur, Karak, Kohat, Kohistan, Khyber, Kurram, Mansehra, Mohmand, Nowshera, Malakand, Charsadda, Abbottabad, Bannu, Buner, Hazara, Peshawar, Swabi, Swat, Waziristan, and surrounding areas 2nd to 7th of October, 2025 with occasional gaps.

GB & AJK:

Isolated rainfall is expected in Astore, Skardu, Hunza, Shighar, Bagh, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, and surrounding areas from from 2nd to 7th of October, 2025.
