More Rains Predicted in the Country during the Current Week

Met Office informed that westerly wave is presently affecting upper and central parts of the country. This weather system is likely to interact with monsoon currents on Wednesday (evening / night) and it will grip most parts of the country on Thursday. Under the influence of this weather system:

- Widespread wind-thunderstorm / rain (with few moderate to isolated heavy falls) is expected in all districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore and Faisalabad), Islamabad, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from Wednesday to Sunday. While rain / thunderstorm is also expected in all districts of D.G Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur and Sahiwal from Wednesday (Evening) to Saturday.
- Scattered wind-thunderstorm / rain is expected in districts of Balochistan from Wednesday (Evening) to Friday.
- Wind-thunderstorm / rain is expected at scattered places in all districts of (Sukkur, Larkana Shaheed Benazirabad, Mirpurkhas, Hyderabad and Karachi) from Wednesday (Evening) to Saturday.
- Hail-Windstorm is also expected at isolated places in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Punjab, North Balochistan and Upper Sindh during the period.

**Note:** Heavy rains may trigger landslides in districts of Malakand, Hazara, Gilgit Baltistan and Kashmir during next 4-5 day. Farmers are particularly advised to take precautionary measures during the forecast period.
