Subject: **Rain Windstorm/ Thundershowers Predicted in Upper Parts during Weekend**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (**Annex-A**) has predicted that **moist currents** from the **Arabian Sea** are continuously penetrating the **Upper parts** of the country and likely to strengthen on **Saturday (Evening)**. Meanwhile, a **Westerly wave** is also likely to approach **Upper parts** on **Saturday**. Under the influence of this weather system:

- a. **Azad Jammu & Kashmir.** **Rain-windstorm/ thundershower (with isolated heavy falls)** is expected in Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber and Mirpur from **10th (night) to 13th July 2026** with **occasional gaps**.
- b. **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.** **Rain-windstorm/ thundershower (with isolated heavy falls)** is expected in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Nowshera, Charsadda, Karak, Tank, Lakki Marwat, Swabi, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Kurram, D.I Khan, Bannu, Waziristan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan and Hangu on **11th and 12th July 2026**.
- c. **Punjab/ Islamabad.** **Scattered rain-windstorm/ thundershower (with isolated heavy falls)** Islamabad/ Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahaiddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Faisalabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot and Okara from **11th and 12th July 2026**, while in Noor Pur Thal, Bhakkar, Layyah Mianwali, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Kot Addu, Rahim Yar Khan and Rajanpur from **11th (evening/night) and 12th July 2026** with **occasional gaps**.
- d. **Gilgit Baltistan.** **Rain-windstorm/ thunderstorm** (Diamer, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche and Shigar from **11th (evening/night) & 13th July 2026** with **occasional gaps**.
- e. **Balochistan.** **Isolated rain-windstorm/ thundershower** is expected in North/ Northeastern parts (Zhob, Sherani, Kohlu, Barkhan, Khuzdar and Dera Bugti) from **11th and 12th July 2026**.
- f. **Sindh.** Mainly **hot and very humid** weather is expected in most parts of the province. However, **isolated rain-windstorm/ thundershower** is likely in Tharparkar, Sukkur, Shikarpur, Larkana, Dadu and Jacobabad on **12th and 13th July**.

2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -
- Strong Windstorm/ hailstorm** and **lightning** may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc) during the forecast period.
 - Heavy rains may cause **Urban/ Flash flooding** in Rawalpindi/ Islamabad, Peshawar, Gujranwala, Lahore and Faisalabad on **11th to 12th July 2026**.
 - Landslides** may occur in vulnerable areas of upper **Khyber** Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from **11th to 12th July 2026**. Water flow may increase in local streams and nullahs of Kashmir, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit Baltistan & hill torrents of D.G Khan on **11th to 12th July 2026**.
 - Prevailing hot & humid conditions are likely to subside during the forecast period.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid situation general public is advised to follow the safety measures mentioned below :-

a. **Aspects for Mass Awareness/ Enforcement**

- (1) During **hailstorm**, follow these safety tips to protect yourself:-
 - Seek Shelter Immediately.** Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or vehicle.
 - Stay Away from Windows.** Hail can shatter glass - stay in a windowless room if possible.
 - Protect Your Head.** If caught outside, use anything available (bag, jacket, helmet) to cover your head and neck.
 - Pull Over Safely (if driving).** Stop the vehicle under a bridge, roofed area, or off the road. Stay inside with seatbelt fastened.
 - Do Not Drive in Heavy Hail.** Visibility drops drastically and roads become slippery.
 - Listen to Weather Updates.** Use radio, mobile alerts, or apps to monitor the situation.
 - Cover Vehicles and Equipment.** If time allows, protect vehicles, livestock and outdoor equipment with tarps or blankets.
 - Wait for the All-Clear.** Stay sheltered until authorities confirm it's safe to move.
- (2) During **thunder-storm** and **lightning strike**, follow these safety tips to protect yourself: -
 - Do Not Seek Shelter Under Trees or Poles.** These attract lightning and don't protect well from hail.
 - Avoid Open Fields and Hilltops.** These are more exposed to hail and lightning.

- (c) **Do Not Use Electrical Appliances**. Avoid wired devices, plumbing and electronics during accompanying thunderstorms.
 - (d) **Move Away from Drainage Canals and Pondages**. Avoid standing nearby drainage canals and pondages as it attracts lightning.
 - (e) **Seek Shelter Immediately**. Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or **seek shelter** in a **dry place**.
- (3) **Travelers/ tourists** are advised to:-
- (a) Plan travels to picnic and tourist spots **considering weather** and traffic **conditions**.
 - (b) Properly dispose-off garbage at **designated areas** to prevent **clogging** of **drainage systems**.
 - (c) **Avoid overcrowding picnic** and **tourist spots** and ensure personal safety.
 - (d) Keep children away from **nullahs/ pot holes/ drainage lines** to avoid accidents.
 - (e) Keep adequate **supply** of **clean drinking water** and **food item**.
 - (f) Wear **weather appropriate clothing**.
 - (g) Keep at least **20 feet distance** from **River** and **Nullahs**.
 - (h) Choose **hotels** or **guest houses** located on **higher ground** and **away** from **rivers, lakes or nullahs** during this time period.
 - (i) Ask **hotel staff** about **emergency exits**, **local hazards** and **evacuation procedures** in **case of flooding**.
 - (j) **Avoid swimming** in the rivers/ nullah and any water body during this time period.
 - (k) **Avoid walking** or **driving through** flooded areas just **6 inches** of **moving water can knock you off your feet**.
 - (l) **Avoid trekking, hiking, or camping** during **heavy rains** risk of **landslides, slippery trails** and **flash floods** increases.
 - (m) **Avoid self-driving** in unfamiliar or **hilly areas** **during rains** opt for **local drivers** who know the terrain.
 - (n) **Do not attempt** to cross **bridges** or **roads submerged** in water they may be **damaged** or **unstable**.
 - (o) **Cooperate with locals** and **district authorities, rescue agencies** during emergencies or **weather** disruptions.
- (4) Do not risk cross any **drain** or **road overtopping** with **water flow**. Wait for flows to normalize and priorities/ ensure safety.

- (5) Do not risk **enter** a **ponded under-construction road**.
- (6) Do not take/ allow children **close** to **ponds/ stagnant** water, water **drainage lines** or any place where **pot holes** are **present**.
- (7) Sensitize all concerned on risks posed by **venturing into water channels** and **crossing nullahs** during flash floods.
- (8) Do not handle/ repair any **electrical equipment**, especially with **exposed lines** to preclude risk of electrocution **during rainfall/ thunderstorms** and water pondage.
- (9) Avoid staying in **weak structures**. In case of **intense rain**, seek shelter in safe places such as schools, government buildings, or any concrete buildings.

4. In this regard, all concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMA/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMA/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure following along with any other measures deemed necessary**: -

a. **DDMA/ Local Administrations/ DM Responders**

- (1) Activation and deputation of duty staff for **round-the-clock monitoring** through Emergency Operation Centres (**EOCs**) during this time period.
- (2) Collect and share the **latest information** with line departments, **provincial** and **national authorities**.
- (3) Disseminate **advisories**, **alerts** and **guidelines** to **all concerned**.
- (4) Generate Situation Reports (**SITREPs**) to cover any major incidents/ developments, if required.
- (5) Civic Agencies and **Rescue Services** (1122/ Fire Brigade/ Ambulance/ Civil Defence) to **remain alert** and have **sufficient emergency response personnel** and **equipment** during the forecasted holiday period.
- (6) Alert **masses living** in **low-lying areas** to exercise **extra caution** and activate **community-based alert systems**.
- (7) Limit the number of **tourists allowed entry** to **picnic** and **tourist spots** to **avoid overcrowding**.
- (8) Regulate **traffic** at **picnic** and **tourist spots** to ensure a smooth flow and **prevent congestion**.
- (9) Secure **loose structures including billboards/ hoardings/ solar panels** from effects of windstorms/ thunder showers.

b. **PDMA/ SDMA/ GBDMA/ ICT Administration**

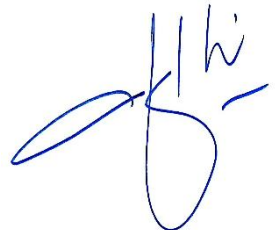
- (1) Coordinate with respective PDMA to **align local efforts** with provincial strategies and guidelines.

- (2) Activate/ **ensure staffing** of **HR** in **EOCs** for effective **coordination** and **response**.
- (3) Establish a **streamlined** and **efficient communication channel** to ensure **timely dissemination** of weather forecasts, **advisories** and **alerts** to local administrations and the **public**.
- (4) Ensure flow of information **among all stakeholders** is **accurate, timely** and effectively **coordinated**.
- (5) Ensure **enforcement/ dissemination** of **mitigative/ preparedness/ response guidelines** to **all** concerned.
- (6) Ensure **rapid damage** and **needs assessments** following major incidents.

c. **Federal Ministries/ Departments**

- (1) Ensuring **interagency coordination** and **information sharing** for monitoring and handling emergencies.
- (2) Raise **mass awareness through respective platforms** relevant stakeholders about **seasonal hazards**.
- (3) Ensure **strict** and **proactive monitoring** of the **movement** around/ in close vicinity of nullahs and water channels to **avert possibilities** of **drowning**.

Met office predicted that moist currents from the Arabian Sea are continuously penetrating the upper parts of the country and likely to strengthen on Saturday (Evening). Meanwhile, a westerly wave is also likely to approach upper parts on Saturday. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Kashmir:** Rain windstorm/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls) is expected in (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from 10th (night) to 13th July with occasional gaps.
- **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa:** Rain windstorm/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls) is expected in (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Nowshera, Charsadda, Karak, Tank, Lakki Marwat, Swabi, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Kurram, D.I Khan, Bannu, Waziristan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu on 11th & 12th
- **Punjab/Islamabad:** Scattered rain windstorm/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls) is expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Faisalabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Okara, on 11th and 12th, while in Noor Pur Thal, Bhakkar, Mianwali, Layyah, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Kot Addu, Rahim Yar Khan and Rajanpur on 11th (evening/night) & 12th July with occasional gaps.
- **Gilgit-Baltistan:** Rain windstorm/thunderstorm is expected in (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar) on 11th (evening/night) to 13th with occasional gaps.
- **Balochistan:** Isolated rain windstorm/thundershower is expected in north/northeastern parts (Zob, Sherani, Kohlu, Barkhan, Dera Bugti and Khuzdar) on 11th & 12th July.
- **Sindh:** Mainly hot and very humid weather is expected in most parts of the province. However, isolated rain windstorm/thundershower is likely in Tharparkar, Sukkur, Shikarpur, Larkana, Dadu, Jacobabad, on 12/13th July.

Possible Impacts and advises:

- Windstorm & lightning may damage weak structures (solar panels, electric poles, bill boards etc.) during the forecast period.
- Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir on 11th & 12th July. Water flow may increase in local streams and Nullahs of Kashmir, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit Baltistan and hill torrents of D. G. Khan on 11th & 12th July.
- Heavy rains may cause localized Urban flooding in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Peshawar, Gujranwala, Lahore and Faisalabad on 11th & 12th July.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- Prevailing hot and humid conditions are likely to subside during the forecast period.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "Vigilant" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward Situation during the forecast period.

دیکھنے کے دوران ملک کے ہائی علاقوں آمد می / بھڑا اور گرج چنک کے ساتھ بارش کی پیش گوئی

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق بحیرہ عرب سے مرطوب ہوائیں مسلسل ملک کے ہائی علاقوں میں داخل ہو رہی ہیں، جن کے ہفتہ (شام) سے مزید شدت اختیار کرنے کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران ایک مغربی لہر بھی ہفتہ کے روز ملک کے ہائی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کی توقع ہے۔ اس موسمی نظام کے زیر اثر:

• **کشمیر 10 جولائی (رات) سے 13 جولائی کے دوران:** غلیم و پٹی، مظفر آباد، راولا کوٹ، پونچھ، بیٹیاں، باغ، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، بھمبر اور میرپور میں آمد می / تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چنک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند

مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش کا بھی امکان ہے۔

• **خیبر پختونخوا: 11 اور 12 جولائی کے روز:** (دیر، چترال، سوات، کوہستان، مالاکنڈ، نوشہرہ، چارسدہ، کرک، تانک، گل مروت، صوابی، شانگلہ، بنگرام، پونیر، کوہاٹ، کرم باڑی آئی خان، بنوں، وزیرستان، ہاجوڑ، مہمند، خیبر، اورکزئی، ماہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، ہری پور، پشاور، مردان اور بنگلہ میں تیز ہواؤں / آمد می اور گرج چنک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ (چند مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش) کی توقع ہے۔

• **پنجاب / اسلام آباد:** 11 اور 12 جولائی کے روز: اسلام آباد اور اوپنڈی، مری، گھمات، ٹانک، چکوال، جہلم، منڈی بہاؤ الدین، گجرات، گوجرانوالہ، حافظ آباد، وزیر آباد، فیصل آباد، خوشاب، سرگودھا، لاہور، شیخوپورہ، سیالکوٹ، ٹارووال، ساہیوال، جہنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، ٹکناہ صاحب، چنیوٹ اور لاہور میں کہیں کہیں تیز ہواؤں / آمد می اور گرج چنک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش کا بھی امکان ہے۔

• **11 جولائی (شام / رات) سے 12 جولائی کے دوران:** نور پور، قنبر، میانوالی، لیہ، بہاولپور، بہاولنگر، ڈیرہ غازی خان، ملتان، خانیوال، لودھراں، مظفر گڑھ، کوٹ اور جیم پیر خان اور راجن پور میں وقفے وقفے سے آمد می / تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چنک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش کا بھی امکان ہے۔

• **گلگت بلتستان 11 کی (شام / رات) سے 13 جولائی کے دوران:** بویا، استور، غدر، سکرو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گانچے اور شکر میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں / آمد می اور گرج چنک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔

• **بلوچستان 11 اور 12 جولائی کے روز:** شمالی / شمال مشرقی بلوچستان (ژوب، شیرانی، کوہلو، بارکھان، ڈیرہ گنجنی اور خضدار) میں تیز ہواؤں / آمد می اور گرج چنک کے ساتھ بارش کی توقع ہے۔

• **سندھ 12 اور 13 جولائی کے روز:** صوبے کے بیشتر علاقوں میں موسم گرم اور شدید مرطوب رہنے کا امکان ہے۔ تاہم قحط پارکر، سکھر، شکارپور، لاڑکانہ، دادو اور جیکب آباد میں چند مقامات پر تیز ہواؤں / آمد می اور گرج چنک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔

محکمہ اثرات اور اقلیتی امور:

- موسلا حد بارش، تیز آمد می اور آسمانی ٹپنے کے باعث کمزور تعمیرات (سولہ خانہ، بجلی کے کھمبے، ٹی پورڈ وغیرہ) کو نقصان پہنچنے کا اندیشہ ہے۔
- 11 اور 12 جولائی کے دوران ہائی خیبر پختونخوا، گلگت بلتستان اور کشمیر کے پہاڑی علاقوں میں لینڈ سلائیڈنگ کا اندیشہ ہے۔ اس دوران کشمیر، خیبر پختونخوا، گلگت بلتستان کے مقامی ندی نالوں اور ڈیرہ غازی خان کے پہاڑی برساتی نالوں میں پانی کے بہاؤ میں اضافہ ہونے کا بھی امکان ہے۔
- 11 اور 12 جولائی کے دوران اسلام آباد اور اوپنڈی، پشاور، گوجرانوالہ، لاہور اور فیصل آباد میں موسلا حد بارش کے باعث مقامی سطحی سطحی علاقوں میں طغیانی علاقے زیر آب آنے کا اندیشہ ہے۔
- سیاحوں اور مسافروں کو ہدایت کی جاتی ہے کہ موسم کی پیش گوئی کے مطابق غیر ضروری سفر سے گریز کریں اور دوران سفر احتیاطی احتیاط برتیں۔
- کسان حضرات کو ہدایت کی جاتی ہے کہ موسمی حالات کو مد نظر رکھتے ہوئے اپنی فصلوں کے امور کو ترجیح دیں اور مویشیوں کی مناسب دیکھ بھال کو یقینی بنائیں۔
- بارشوں کے سلسلے کے دوران ملک میں جاری گرمی اور جس کی شدت میں بتدریج کمی آنے کی توقع ہے۔
- نوٹ: تمام حلقہ داروں کو ”مارٹ“ دہنے اور کسی ناگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔

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
