Subject: **Rain Windstorm/ Thundershowers Predicted in Coming Days**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (**Annex-A**) has predicted that **monsoon currents** from the **Arabian Sea** are continuously penetrating the **Upper** and **Central parts** of the **country** and likely to **strengthen on weekend**. Meanwhile, a **Western disturbance** is also likely to approach **upper parts** on **20th July 2026**. Under the influence of this weather system:

- a. **Azad Jammu & Kashmir.** **Rain windstorm/ thundershower (with scattered heavy falls at times very heavy)** is expected in (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **18th (evening/ night) to 25th July 2026 with occasional gaps**.
- b. **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.** **Rain windstorm/ thundershower (with scattered heavy falls at times very heavy)** is expected in (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Nowshera, Charsadda, Karak, Tank, Lakki Marwat, Swabi, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Kurram, D.I Khan, Bannu, Waziristan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu from **19th (evening/ night) to 23rd July 2026**.
- c. **Punjab/ Islamabad.** **Rain windstorm/ thundershower (with scattered heavy falls at times very heavy)** is expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Faisalabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Okara, from **19th (evening/ night) to 23rd July 2026** while in Noor Pur Thal, Bhakkar, Mianwali, Layyah, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Kot Addu, Rahim Yar Khan and Rajanpur from **20th to 24th July with occasional gaps. Heavy falls is also expected during the period**.
- d. **Gilgit Baltistan.** **Rain windstorm/thunderstorm (with moderate to heavy falls)** is expected in (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar) from **18th (evening/ night) to 25th July 2026 with occasional gaps**.
- e. **Balochistan.** **Rain windstorm/thundershower (with isolated heavy falls)** is expected in North/**Northeastern parts** (Zhob, Sherani, Loralai, Kohlu, Sibbi, Naseerabad, Jhal Magsi, Jaffarabad, Barkhan, Dera Bugti and Khuzdar) from **19th (evening/ night) to 23rd July 2026**.

- f. **Sindh.** **Mainly hot** and **very humid weather** is expected in most parts of the province. However, **isolated rain windstorm/thundershower** is likely in Tharparkar, Mithi, Sukkur, Larkana, Shikarpur, Dadu, Jacobabad, from **20th (evening/ night) to 24th July 2026**.
2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -
- a. Strong **Windstorm/ hailstorm** and **lightning** may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc) during the forecast period.
 - b. **Landslides** may occur in vulnerable areas of Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Buner, Mansehra, Abbottabad) Gilgit-Baltistan, Murree & Galliyat, and Kashmir during **20th to 25th July 2026**.
 - c. **Flash flooding** in local streams and Nullahs of Kashmir, Murree & Galliyat, Northeastern Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit Baltistan, hill torrents of D. G. Khan and Northeastern parts of Balochistan during the wet spell.
 - d. Heavy rains may cause Urban flooding in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Peshawar, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sialkot, Multan and Faisalabad from **20th to 23th July 2026**.
 - e. Prevailing hot & humid conditions are likely to subside during the forecast period.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid situation general public is advised to follow the safety measures mentioned below:-
- a. **Aspects for Mass Awareness/ Enforcement**
 - (1) During **hailstorm**, follow these safety tips to protect yourself:-
 - (a) **Seek Shelter Immediately**. Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or vehicle.
 - (b) **Stay Away from Windows**. Hail can shatter glass - stay in a windowless room if possible.
 - (c) **Protect Your Head**. If caught outside, use anything available (bag, jacket, helmet) to cover your head and neck.
 - (d) **Pull Over Safely (if driving)**. Stop the vehicle under a bridge, roofed area, or off the road. Stay inside with seatbelt fastened.
 - (e) **Do Not Drive in Heavy Hail**. Visibility drops drastically and roads become slippery.
 - (f) **Listen to Weather Updates**. Use radio, mobile alerts, or apps to monitor the situation.
 - (g) **Cover Vehicles and Equipment**. If time allows, protect vehicles, livestock and outdoor equipment with tarps or blankets.
 - (h) **Wait for the All-Clear**. Stay sheltered until authorities confirm it's safe to move.

- (2) During **thunder-storm** and **lightning strike**, follow these safety tips to protect yourself: -
- (a) **Do Not Seek Shelter Under Trees or Poles**. These attract lightning and don't protect well from hail.
 - (b) **Avoid Open Fields and Hilltops**. These are more exposed to hail and lightning.
 - (c) **Do Not Use Electrical Appliances**. Avoid wired devices, plumbing and electronics during accompanying thunderstorms.
 - (d) **Move Away from Drainage Canals and Pondages**. Avoid standing nearby drainage canals and pondages as it attracts lightning.
 - (e) **Seek Shelter Immediately**. Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or **seek shelter** in a **dry place**.
- (3) **Travelers/ tourists** are advised to:-
- (a) Plan travels to picnic and tourist spots **considering weather** and traffic **conditions**.
 - (b) Properly dispose-off garbage at **designated areas** to prevent **clogging** of **drainage systems**.
 - (c) **Avoid overcrowding picnic** and **tourist spots** and ensure personal safety.
 - (d) Keep children away from **nullahs/ pot holes/ drainage lines** to avoid accidents.
 - (e) Keep adequate **supply** of **clean drinking water** and **food item**.
 - (f) Wear **weather appropriate clothing**.
 - (g) Keep at least **20 feet distance** from **River** and **Nullahs**.
 - (h) Choose **hotels** or **guest houses** located on **higher ground** and **away** from **rivers, lakes or nullahs** during this time period.
 - (i) Ask **hotel staff** about **emergency exits**, **local hazards** and **evacuation procedures** in **case of flooding**.
 - (j) **Avoid swimming** in the rivers/ nullah and any water body during this time period.
 - (k) **Avoid walking** or **driving through** flooded areas just **6 inches** of **moving water can knock you off your feet**.
 - (l) **Avoid trekking, hiking, or camping** during **heavy rains** **risk** of **landslides, slippery trails** and **flash floods** increases.
 - (m) **Avoid self-driving** in unfamiliar or **hilly areas** **during rains** opt for **local drivers** who know the terrain.

- (n) **Do not attempt** to cross **bridges** or **roads submerged** in water they may be **damaged** or **unstable**.
- (o) **Cooperate with locals** and **district authorities**, **rescue agencies** during emergencies or **weather** disruptions.
- (4) Do not risk cross any **drain** or **road overtopping** with **water flow**. Wait for flows to normalize and priorities/ ensure safety.
- (5) Do not risk **enter** a **ponded under-construction road**.
- (6) Do not take/ allow children **close** to **ponds/ stagnant** water, water **drainage lines** or any place where **pot holes** are **present**.
- (7) Sensitize all concerned on risks posed by **venturing into water channels** and **crossing nullahs** during flash floods.
- (8) Do not handle/ repair any **electrical equipment**, especially with **exposed lines** to preclude risk of electrocution **during rainfall/ thunderstorms** and water pondage.
- (9) Avoid staying in **weak structures**. In case of **intense rain**, seek shelter in safe places such as schools, government buildings, or any concrete buildings.

4. In this regard, all concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMAs/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMA/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure following along with any other measures deemed necessary**: -

a. **DDMA/ Local Administrations/ DM Responders**

- (1) Activation and deputation of duty staff for **round-the-clock monitoring** through Emergency Operation Centres (**EOCs**) during this time period.
- (2) Collect and share the **latest information** with line departments, **provincial** and **national authorities**.
- (3) Disseminate **advisories**, **alerts** and **guidelines** to **all concerned**.
- (4) Generate Situation Reports (**SITREPs**) to cover any major incidents/ developments, if required.
- (5) Civic Agencies and **Rescue Services** (1122/ Fire Brigade/ Ambulance/ Civil Defence) to **remain alert** and have **sufficient emergency response personnel** and **equipment** during the forecasted holiday period.
- (6) Alert **masses living** in **low-lying areas** to exercise **extra caution** and activate **community-based alert systems**.
- (7) Limit the number of **tourists allowed entry** to **picnic** and **tourist spots** to **avoid overcrowding**.

- (8) Regulate **traffic** at **picnic** and **tourist spots** to ensure a smooth flow and **prevent congestion**.
- (9) Secure **loose structures including billboards/ hoardings/ solar panels** from effects of windstorms/ thunder showers.

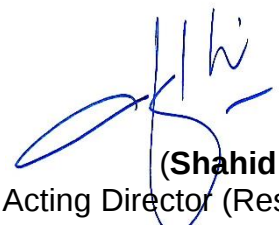
b. **PDMAs/ SDMA/ GBDMA/ ICT Administration**

- (1) Coordinate with respective PDMAs to **align local efforts** with provincial strategies and guidelines.
- (2) Activate/ **ensure staffing** of **HR** in **EOCs** for effective **coordination** and **response**.
- (3) Establish a **streamlined** and **efficient communication channel** to ensure **timely dissemination** of weather forecasts, **advisories** and **alerts** to local administrations and the **public**.
- (4) Ensure flow of information **among all stakeholders** is **accurate, timely** and effectively **coordinated**.
- (5) Ensure **enforcement/ dissemination** of **mitigative/ preparedness/ response guidelines** to **all** concerned.
- (6) Ensure **rapid damage** and **needs assessments** following major incidents.

c. **Federal Ministries/ Departments**

- (1) Ensuring **interagency coordination** and **information sharing** for monitoring and handling emergencies.
- (2) Raise **mass awareness through respective platforms** relevant stakeholders about **seasonal hazards**.
- (3) Ensure **strict** and **proactive monitoring** of the **movement** around/ in close vicinity of nullahs and water channels to **avert possibilities** of **drowning**.

- **Kashmir:** Rain windstorm/thundershower (with scattered heavyfalls at times very heavy) is expected in (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from 18th (evening/night) to 25th July with occasional gaps.
- **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa:** Rain windstorm/thundershower (with scattered heavyfalls at times very heavy) is expected in (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Nowshera, Charsadda, Karak, Tank, Lakki Marwat, Swabi, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Kurram, D.I Khan, Bannu, Waziristan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu from 19th (evening/night) to 23th July.
- **Punjab/Islamabad:** Rain windstorm/thundershower (with scattered heavyfalls at times very heavy) is expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Faisalabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Okara, from 19th (evening/night) to 23th July while in Noor Pur Thal, Bhakkar, Mianwali, Layyah, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Kot Addu, Rahim Yar Khan and Rajanpur from 20th to 24th July with occasional gaps. Heavyfalls is also expected during the period.
- **Gilgit-Baltistan:** Rain windstorm/thundershower (with moderate to heavy falls) is expected in (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar) from 18th (evening/night) to 25th July with occasional gaps.
- **Balochistan:** Rain windstorm/thundershower (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in north/northeastern parts (Zob, Sherani, Loralai, Kohlu, Sibbi, Naseerabad, Jhal Magsi, Jaffarabad, Barkhan, Dera Bugti and Khuzdar) from 19th (evening/night) to 23th July.
- **Sindh:** Mainly hot and very humid weather is expected in most parts of the province. However, isolated rain windstorm/thundershower is likely in Tharparkar, Mithi, Sukkur, Larkana, Shikarpur, Dadu, Jacobabad, from 20th (evening/night) to 24th July.

Possible Impacts and advises:

- Windstorm & lightning may damage weak structures (solar panels, electric poles, bill boards etc.) during the forecast period.
- Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Buner, Mansehra, Abbottabad) Gilgit-Baltistan, Murree & Galliat, and Kashmir during 20th to 25th July.
- Flash flooding in local streams and Nullahs of Kashmir, Murree & Galliat, Northeastern Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit Baltistan, hill torrents of D. G. Khan and Northeastern parts of Balochistan during the wet spell.
- Heavy rains may cause Urban flooding in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Peshawar, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sialkot, Multan and Faisalabad from 20th to 23th July.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- Prevailing hot and humid conditions are likely to subside during the forecast period.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "Vigilant" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward Situation during the forecast period.

محمد موسیات کے مطابق بحیرہ عرب سے آنے والی مون سون ہوائیں ملک کے ہلائی اور وسطی علاقوں میں مسلسل داخل ہو رہی ہیں اور ایک ایسے دوران مزید شدت اختیار کرنے کا امکان ہے۔ پچھلے روز مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ ملک کے ہلائی علاقوں میں داخل ہو گا۔ اس مونی نظام کے زیر اثر:

• **شعبہ 18 (شام ارات) سے 25 جولائی:** (نظم و ہلی، مظفر آباد، راولا کوٹ، پونچھ، ہلیاں، باغ، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، جمہور، میرپور میں تیز ہواؤں / آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران کہیں کہیں بڑے موسلا دار تیز موسلا دار بارش کی توقع ہے۔

• **شعبہ 19 (شام ارات) سے 23 جولائی کے دوران:** درہیزال، سوات، کوہستان، مالاکنڈ، نوشہرہ، چارسدہ، کرک، ٹانک، کٹی مروت، صوبائی، شانگلہ، بگرام، پونچھ، کوہاٹ، کرم، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، وزیرستان، ہماچل، چنبل، خیر اور کٹی، ہماچل، ڈیرہ، پشاور، مردان اور مگوش تیز ہواؤں / آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران کہیں کہیں بڑے موسلا دار تیز موسلا دار بارش کی بھی توقع ہے۔

• **بھٹیاب / اسلام آباد:** 19 جولائی (شام ارات) سے 23 جولائی کے دوران: اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، مری، گلیات، ٹانک، پشاور، چنبل، مظفر آباد، گوجرانو، حافظ آباد، فیصل آباد، خوشاب، سرگودھا اور، شوچر، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، ساہیوال، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، مظفر صاحب، پٹیوٹ اور اوکاڑہ میں تیز ہواؤں / آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران کہیں کہیں بڑے موسلا دار تیز موسلا دار بارش کی بھی توقع ہے۔ 20 جولائی سے 24 جولائی کے دوران: نور پور، قلعہ بکر، میانوالی، ایف، بہاولپور، بہاولنگر، ڈیرہ غازی خان، ملتان، خانیوال، لودھراں، مظفر گڑھ، کوٹ اور درہم پڑخان اور راجن پور میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں / آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کی بھی توقع ہے۔ اس دوران موسلا دار بارش کا بھی امکان ہے۔

• **گلگت بلتستان:** 18 جولائی (شام ارات) سے 25 جولائی کے دوران: پورما، دستور، غلڑ، سکرو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گاجی اور خٹک میں تیز ہواؤں / آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران درہم پڑخان سے موسلا دار بارش کی بھی توقع ہے۔

• **بلوچستان:** 19 جولائی (شام ارات) سے 23 جولائی کے دوران: قوچ، شیرانی، کوہلو، لورائی، سی، نصیر آباد، جھل مٹی، جعفر آباد، ہارکمان، ڈیرہ گمشدہ اور خضدار میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا دار بارش کی بھی توقع ہے۔

• **منہج:** صوبہ کے بیشتر علاقوں میں موسم گرم اور شدید مہیں رہنے کا امکان ہے۔ تاہم 20 جولائی (شام ارات) سے 24 جولائی کے دوران قحط پھر کر مٹی، سکھر، لاڈکانہ، قحط پور، دادو اور جیکب آباد میں چند مقامات پر تیز ہواؤں / آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔

نکتہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- موسلا دار بارش، تیز آندھی اور آسانی بجلی گرنے کے باعث کمزور تعمیرات (سور پینٹن، بجلی کے کھمبے، ہل پور ڈزہ وغیرہ) کو نقصان پہنچنے کا خدشہ ہے۔
- 20 سے 25 جولائی کے دوران ہلائی شعبہ پختونخوا (درہیزال، سوات، کوہستان، پونچھ، مہار، ڈیرہ گلگت بلتستان، مری، گلیات اور شعبہ کے پہاڑی علاقوں میں لینڈ سلائیڈنگ کا خدشہ ہے۔
- بارشوں کے دوران شعبہ مری و گلیات، شمال مشرقی پنجاب، اسلام آباد، خیر پختونخوا، گلگت بلتستان، ڈیرہ غازی خان کے پہاڑی ہندوستان اور شمال مشرقی بلوچستان کے بھی مقامی / برساتی ندی نالوں میں طغیانی کا خدشہ ہے۔
- 20 سے 23 جولائی کے دوران اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، پشاور، گوجرانو، لاہور، سیالکوٹ، ملتان اور فیصل آباد میں موسلا دار بارشوں کے باعث ٹھیکسی ملک سے زیر آب آنے کا خدشہ ہے۔
- سیاحوں اور مسافروں کو ہدایت کی جاتی ہے کہ پیش گوئی کے دوران غیر ضروری سفر سے گریز کریں اور احتیاطی برتیں۔
- کسان حضرات کو مشورہ دیا جاتا ہے کہ موسمی حالات کو مد نظر رکھتے ہوئے اپنی زرعی سرگرمیوں کی منصوبہ بندی کریں اور مویشیوں کی حفاظت کا بھی خصوصی خیال رکھیں۔
- بارشوں کے باعث ملک کے بیشتر علاقوں میں جاری گرم اور مہیں والے موسم میں نمایاں کمی آنے کا امکان ہے۔
