Subject: **More Rain Thundershowers Predicted in Southern/ Central Parts Including Sindh from Friday Evening/ Night to Monday**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (**Annex-A**) has informed that a **Low-Pressure Area (LPA)** is located over **Southwest of Rajasthan** and adjoining areas. Due to this (**LPA**) **monsoon currents** are penetrating in **Southern** and **Central parts** of the country. Under the influence of this weather system following are expected: -

- a. **Sindh.** **Rain-thundershowers** with a **few heavy falls** expected in Tharparkar, Umer Kot, Mirpur Khas, Badin, Sanghar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Mityari, Jamshoro, Shaheed Benazirabad, Ghotki, Kashmore, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Sukkur, Qambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Khairpur, Nosheroferoz and Thatta districts from **24th (evening/ night) to 27th July 2026** with **occasional gaps**. Mostly weather condition with chances of **rain-thundershower** also expected in Karachi on **25th & 26th July 2026**.
- b. **Kashmir.** **Isolated rain windstorm/thundershower** is expected in (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhnoti, Kotli, Bhimber and Mirpur) from **24th (evening/ night) to 28th July 2026** with **occasional gaps**.
- c. **Punjab/Islamabad.** **Rain windstorm/thundershower (with isolated heavyfalls)** is expected in Lahore, Sheikhupura Okara, Sahiwal, Pak Pattan, Vehari, Khanewal, Multan, Dera Gazi Khan, Rajanpur, Kot Addu, Muzaffargarh, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, R Y Khan and Khan Pur from **24th (evening/ night) to 27th July 2026**. **Mostly partly cloudy** at times cloudy weather conditions with **rain-thundershower** is expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Faisalabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Sialkot, Narowal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib and Chiniot from **24th (evening/night) to 26th July 2026** with **occasional gaps**.
- d. **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa.** **Mostly partly cloudy** at times cloudy weather conditions with **rain-thundershower** is expected in (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Nowshera, Charsadda, Karak, Tank, Lakki Marwat, Swabi, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Kurram, D.I Khan, Bannu, Waziristan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan and Hangu from

24th (evening/ night) to 27th July 2026.

- e. **Gilgit-Baltistan.** **Mostly partly cloudy** at times cloudy weather conditions with **rain-thundershower** is expected in (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche and Shigar) from **24th (evening/ night) to 26th July 2026** with **occasional gaps.**
- f. **Balochistan.** **Mostly partly cloudy** at times cloudy weather conditions with **rain-thundershower** is expected (**with isolated heavy falls**) is expected in **North/Northeastern** parts (Zhob, Sherani, Loralai, Kohlu, Sibbi, Naseerabad, Jhal Magsi, Jaffarabad, Barkhan, Dera Bugti, Awaran and Khuzdar) from **24th (evening/ night) to 27th July 2026.**

2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -

- a. Strong **Windstorm** and **lightning** may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc) during the forecast period.
- b. **Heavy rains** may cause **Urban flooding** in Gujranwala, Lahore, on **24th and 25th July 2026.** While in Bahawalpur, R Y Khan, Sukkur, Shahed Benazirabad, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Sanghar, Khairpur, Mithi, Mir Pur Khas, Umer Kot, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Sialkot, Multan and Faisalabad from **24th to 26th July 2026.**
- c. Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious during the forecast period
- d. Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid situation general public is advised to follow the safety measures mentioned below :-

a. **Aspects for Mass Awareness/ Enforcement**

- (1) During **thunder-storm** and **lightning strike**, follow these safety tips to protect yourself: -
 - (a) **Do Not Seek Shelter Under Trees or Poles.** These attract lightning and don't protect well from hail.
 - (b) **Avoid Open Fields and Hilltops.** These are more exposed to hail and lightning.
 - (c) **Do Not Use Electrical Appliances.** Avoid wired devices, plumbing and electronics during accompanying thunderstorms.
 - (d) **Move Away from Drainage Canals and Pondages.** Avoid standing nearby drainage canals and pondages as it attracts lightning.
 - (e) **Seek Shelter Immediately.** Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or **seek shelter** in a **dry place.**

- (2) **Travelers/ tourists** are advised to:-
- (a) Plan travels to picnic and tourist spots **considering weather** and traffic **conditions**.
 - (b) Properly dispose-off garbage at **designated areas** to prevent **clogging** of **drainage systems**.
 - (c) **Avoid overcrowding picnic** and **tourist spots** and ensure personal safety.
 - (d) Keep children away from **nullahs/ pot holes/ drainage lines** to avoid accidents.
 - (e) Keep adequate **supply** of **clean drinking water** and **food item**.
 - (f) Wear **weather appropriate clothing**.
 - (g) Keep at least **20 feet distance** from **River** and **Nullahs**.
 - (h) Choose **hotels** or **guest houses** located on **higher ground** and **away** from **rivers, lakes or nullahs** during this time period.
 - (i) Ask **hotel staff** about **emergency exits**, **local hazards** and **evacuation procedures** in **case of flooding**.
 - (j) **Avoid swimming** in the rivers/ nullah and any water body during this time period.
 - (k) **Avoid walking** or **driving through** flooded areas just **6 inches** of **moving water can knock you off your feet**.
 - (l) **Avoid trekking, hiking, or camping** during **heavy rains** **risk** of **landslides, slippery trails** and **flash floods** increases.
 - (m) **Avoid self-driving** in unfamiliar or **hilly areas** **during rains** opt for **local drivers** who know the terrain.
 - (n) **Do not attempt** to cross **bridges** or **roads submerged** in water they may be **damaged** or **unstable**.
 - (o) **Cooperate with locals** and **district authorities, rescue agencies** during emergencies or **weather** disruptions.
- (3) Do not risk cross any **drain** or **road overtopping** with **water flow**. Wait for flows to normalize and priorities/ ensure safety.
- (4) Do not risk **enter** a **ponded under-construction road**.
- (5) Do not take/ allow children **close** to **ponds/ stagnant** water, water **drainage lines** or any place where **pot holes** are **present**.
- (6) Sensitize all concerned on risks posed by **venturing into water channels** and **crossing nullahs** during flash floods.

- (7) Do not handle/ repair any **electrical equipment**, especially with **exposed lines** to preclude risk of electrocution **during rainfall/ thunderstorms** and water pondage.
- (8) Avoid staying in **weak structures**. In case of **intense rain**, seek shelter in safe places such as schools, government buildings, or any concrete buildings.

4. In this regard, all concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMAs/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMA/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure following along with any other measures deemed necessary**: -

a. **DDMAs/ Local Administrations/ DM Responders**

- (1) Activation and deputation of duty staff for **round-the-clock monitoring** through Emergency Operation Centres (**EOCs**) during this time period.
- (2) Collect and share the **latest information** with line departments, **provincial** and **national authorities**.
- (3) Disseminate **advisories**, **alerts** and **guidelines** to **all concerned**.
- (4) Generate Situation Reports (**SITREPs**) to cover any major incidents/ developments, if required.
- (5) Civic Agencies and **Rescue Services** (1122/ Fire Brigade/ Ambulance/ Civil Defence) to **remain alert** and have **sufficient emergency response personnel** and **equipment** during the forecasted holiday period.
- (6) Alert **masses living** in **low-lying areas** to exercise **extra caution** and activate **community-based alert systems**.
- (7) Limit the number of **tourists allowed entry** to **picnic** and **tourist spots** to **avoid overcrowding**.
- (8) Regulate **traffic** at **picnic** and **tourist spots** to ensure a smooth flow and **prevent congestion**.
- (9) Secure **loose structures including billboards/ hoardings/ solar panels** from effects of windstorms/ thunder showers.

b. **PDMAs/ SDMA/ GBDMA/ ICT Administration**

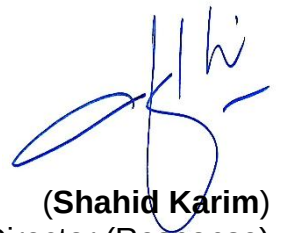
- (1) Coordinate with respective PDMAs to **align local efforts** with provincial strategies and guidelines.
- (2) Activate/ **ensure staffing** of **HR** in **EOCs** for effective **coordination** and **response**.
- (3) Establish a **streamlined** and **efficient communication channel** to ensure **timely dissemination** of weather forecasts, **advisories** and **alerts** to local administrations and the **public**.

- (4) Ensure flow of information **among all stakeholders** is **accurate, timely** and effectively **coordinated**.
- (5) Ensure **enforcement/ dissemination** of **mitigative/ preparedness/ response guidelines** to **all** concerned.
- (6) Ensure **rapid damage** and **needs assessments** following major incidents.

c. **Federal Ministries/ Departments**

- (1) Ensuring **interagency coordination** and **information sharing** for monitoring and handling emergencies.
- (2) Raise **mass awareness through respective platforms** relevant stakeholders about **seasonal hazards**.
- (3) Ensure **strict** and **proactive monitoring** of the **movement** around/ in close vicinity of nullahs and water channels to **avert possibilities** of **drowning**.

- **Sindh:** Rain-thundershowers **with a few heavy falls** expected in Tharparkar, Umer Kot, Mirpur Khas, Badin, Sanghar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Mityari, Jamshoro, Shaheed Benazirabad, Ghotki, Kashmore, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Sukkur, Qambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Khairpur, Nosheroferoz & Thatta districts from **24th (evening/night) to 27th July** with occasional gaps. Mostly weather condition with chances of rain-thundershower also expected in Karachi on 25th/26th July.
- **Kashmir:** Isolated rain windstorm/thundershower is expected in (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber and Mirpur) from **24th (evening/night) to 28th July** with occasional gaps.
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- Mostly partly cloudy at times cloudy weather conditions with rain-thundershower is expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Faisalabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Sialkot, Narowal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib and Chiniot from **24th (evening/night) to 26th July** with occasional gaps.
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- **Balochistan:** Mostly partly cloudy at times cloudy weather conditions with rain-thundershower is expected **(with isolated heavy falls)** is expected in north/northeastern parts (Zhob, Sherani, Loralai, Kohlu, Sibbi, Naseerabad, Jhal Magsi, Jaffarabad, Barkhan, Dera Bugti, Awaran and Khuzdar) from **24th (evening/night) to 27th July**.

- Heavy rains may cause Urban flooding in Gujranwala, Lahore, on 24th/25th July While in Bahawalpur, R Y Khan, Sukkur, Shahed Benazirabad, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Sanghar, Khairpur, Mithi, Mir Pur Khas, Umer Kot, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Sialkot, Multan and Faisalabad from 24th to 26th July.
- Windstorm & lightning may damage weak structures (solar panels, electric poles, bill boards etc.) during the forecast period.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
