Subject: **FLASH FLOOD ALERT – DG KHAN DIVISION HILL TORRENTS**

According to the latest **hydrometeorological conditions**, scattered to **widespread rainfall** with **isolated heavy falls** is expected over the catchment areas of the **hill torrents** of **Dera Ghazi Khan** during the **next 24 hours** (PMD Press Release is attached at **Annex-A**). Consequently, **Low** to **Medium-Level flows** are expected in the nullahs of **DG Khan** and **Rajanpur** districts. PDMA Punjab, Punjab Irrigation Department and respective District Administration(s) / DDMA(s) and Rescue 1122 Punjab are advised to ensure following along with any other measures deemed necessary: -

- a. Maintain **enhanced alert level / monitoring** of developing situation to reduce reaction / response times.
- b. All civic agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) to **remain alert** and **ensure availability** of **personnel** and **equipment** during the mentioned period, especially in at-risk areas.
- c. People living in or nearby at-risk areas to be **sensitized about expected increase of water flows** and **flash flooding situation**.
- d. Timely **evacuation of at-risk population from low-lying / flood prone areas** as per Evacuation Plans and ensure availability of shelter, food and medicines in those shelter camps.
- e. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be **forewarned to shift cattle away from low lying areas / at-risk areas**.
- f. **Restrict vehicle movement in low lying / at-risk areas**.
- g. Provision of **POL for back-up generators at water pumping stations** and **timely pre-placement of de-watering equipment for de-flooding**.
- h. DISCOs and relevant local administration / departments to **ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken** to avoid electrocution incidents and timely restoration of power supply.
- i. Coordinate with concerned departments for **clearance of roads** in case of any blockage / obstruction, waterlogging.

- j. Travelers and tourists are **forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas** with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
 - k. In case of any eventuality, **Special SITREP / Update** be shared immediately with NDMA.
2. **Flood Forecasting Division / PDMA Punjab**. Please share **regular updates on water flows from DG Khan Division Hill Torrents every 3 hours** with NDMA.
3. **Press Information Department Only**. With the request for **wider circulation and public awareness**.

DG Khan Division Hill Torrents
