Subject: **Rain - Wind/ thundershower Predicted in the Country from 14th September 2026**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (**Annex-A**) has informed that Monsoon Currents are penetrating Upper parts of the country. A **Westerly wave** is likely to enter **Upper parts** of the country during the weekend and likely to strengthen on **14th September 2026 (Monday)**. Under the influence of this weather system: -

- a. **Kashmir**. Rain - wind/ thundershower (**with isolated heavy falls/ hailstorm**) is expected in (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **12th to 17th September 2026** with occasional gaps.
- b. **Islamabad/Upper Punjab**: Rain - wind/ thundershower (**with isolated heavy fall/ hailstorm**) is expected in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Jhelum, Chakwal, Talagang, Attock from **12th to 17th September 2026** with occasional gaps. Rain-wind/ thundershower (**with isolated heavy fall/ hailstorm**) is expected in Lahore, Sialkot, Sheikhupura, Narowal, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Wazirabad, Hafizabad, Kasur, Okara, Nankana Sahib, Sargodha, Khushab, Mianwali, Noorpur Thal, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Layyah, Bhakkar, Sahiwal, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan and surroundings from **14th (evening/night) to 17th September 2026**. with occasional gaps.
- c. **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa**. Rain-wind/ thundershower (**with scattered heavy falls/ hailstorm**) is expected in (Peshawar, Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Mardan, Nowshera, Charsadda, Swabi, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Hangu, Kurram, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Karak, Tank, Lakki Marwat, D.I Khan, Bannu and Waziristan from **12th to 17th September 2026**, with occasional gaps.
- d. **Gilgit-Baltistan** Rain - wind/ thundershower (**moderate with isolated heavy falls**) is expected in Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar from **12th to 17th September 2026** with occasional gaps.
- e. **Sindh** Mainly hot and humid weather is likely to prevail in most parts. However, Rain-wind/ thunderstorm (**with isolated heavyfall**) is expected in Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Mirpurkhas, Tharparkar, Umarmkot, Thatta, Badin, Karachi and surroundings from **13th (evening/night) to 16th September 2026** with occasional gaps.

- f. **Balochistan**. Mainly hot and humid weather to prevail in most parts during the forecast period. However, **Rain-wind/thunderstorm** is expected in Zhob, Bar khan, Musakhel and surroundings from **13th (evening/night) to 16th September 2026** with occasional gaps.
2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -
- Heavy Rains** may cause **Urban flooding** in low lying areas of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Faisalabad and Lahore from **14th to 17th September 2026**.
 - Heavy rain** may cause **flash flood** in local streams/ Nullahs in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Malakand, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Gilgit-Baltistan, Kashmir, Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad and Rawalpindi from **14th to 17th September 2026**.
 - Landslides** may occur in hilly areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan, Murree, Galliyat and Kashmir during the forecast period.
 - Temperature** is **likely to drop** during the forecast period.
 - Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious during the forecast period.
 - Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid situation general public is advised to follow the safety measures mentioned below: -
- Aspects for Mass Awareness/ Enforcement**
 - Keeping in view the possibility of **hailstorm**, following are the safety tips for general public: -
 - Seek Shelter Immediately**: Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or vehicle.
 - Stay Away from Windows**: Hail can shatter glass - stay in a windowless room if possible.
 - Protect Your Head**: If caught outside, use anything available (bag, jacket, helmet) to cover your head and neck.
 - Pull Over Safely (if driving)**: Stop the vehicle under a bridge, roofed area, or off the road. Stay inside with seatbelt fastened.
 - Do Not Drive in Heavy Hail**: Visibility drops drastically and roads become slippery.
 - Listen to Weather Updates**: Use radio, mobile alerts, or apps to monitor the situation.
 - Cover Vehicles and Equipment**: If time allows, protect vehicles, livestock, and outdoor equipment with tarps or blankets.

- (h) [Wait for the All-Clear](#): Stay sheltered until authorities confirm it's safe to move.
- (2) During **thunder-storm** and **lightning strike**, follow these safety tips to protect yourself: -
 - (a) [Do Not Seek Shelter Under Trees or Poles](#). These attract lightning and don't protect well from hail.
 - (b) [Avoid Open Fields and Hilltops](#). These are more exposed to hail and lightning.
 - (c) [Do Not Use Electrical Appliances](#). Avoid wired devices, plumbing and electronics during accompanying thunderstorms.
 - (d) [Move Away from Drainage Canals and Pondages](#). Avoid standing nearby drainage canals and pondages as it attracts lightning.
 - (e) [Seek Shelter Immediately](#). Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or **seek shelter** in a **dry place**.
- (3) **Travelers/ tourists** are advised to:-
 - (a) Plan travels to picnic and tourist spots **considering weather** and traffic **conditions**.
 - (b) Properly dispose-off garbage at **designated areas** to prevent **clogging** of **drainage systems**.
 - (c) **Avoid overcrowding picnic** and **tourist spots** and ensure personal safety.
 - (d) Keep children away from **nullahs/ pot holes/ drainage lines** to avoid accidents.
 - (e) Keep adequate **supply** of **clean drinking water** and **food item**.
 - (f) Wear **weather appropriate clothing**.
 - (g) Keep at least **20 feet distance** from **River** and **Nullahs**.
 - (h) Choose **hotels** or **guest houses** located on **higher ground** and **away** from **rivers, lakes or nullahs** during this time period.
 - (i) Ask **hotel staff** about **emergency exits**, **local hazards** and **evacuation procedures** in **case of flooding**.
 - (j) **Avoid swimming** in the rivers/ nullah and any water body during this time period.
 - (k) **Avoid walking** or **driving through** flooded areas just **6 inches** of **moving water can knock you off your feet**.
 - (l) **Avoid trekking, hiking, or camping** during **heavy rains** risk of **landslides, slippery trails** and **flash floods** increases.

- (m) **Avoid self-driving** in unfamiliar or **hilly areas during rains** opt for **local drivers** who know the terrain.
- (n) **Do not attempt** to cross **bridges** or **roads submerged** in water they may be **damaged** or **unstable**.
- (o) **Cooperate with locals** and **district authorities**, **rescue agencies** during emergencies or **weather** disruptions.
- (4) Do not risk cross any **drain** or **road overtopping** with **water flow**. Wait for flows to normalize and priorities/ ensure safety.
- (5) Do not risk **enter** a **ponded under-construction road**.
- (6) Do not take/ allow children **close** to **ponds/ stagnant** water, water **drainage lines** or any place where **pot holes** are **present**.
- (7) Sensitize all concerned on risks posed by **venturing into water channels** and **crossing nullahs** during flash floods.
- (8) Do not handle/ repair any **electrical equipment**, especially with **exposed lines** to preclude risk of electrocution **during rainfall/ thunderstorms** and water pondage.
- (9) Avoid staying in **weak structures**. In case of **intense rain**, seek shelter in safe places such as schools, government buildings, or any concrete buildings.

4. In this regard, all concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMAs/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMA/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure following along with any other measures deemed necessary:-**

a. **DDMA/ Local Administrations/ DM Responders**

- (1) Activation and deputation of duty staff for **round-the-clock monitoring** through Emergency Operation Centres (**EOCs**) during this time period.
- (2) Collect and share the **latest information** with line departments, **provincial** and **national authorities**.
- (3) Disseminate **advisories**, **alerts** and **guidelines** to **all concerned**.
- (4) Generate Situation Reports (**SITREPs**) to cover any major incidents/ developments, if required.
- (5) Civic Agencies and **Rescue Services** (1122/ Fire Brigade/ Ambulance/ Civil Defence) to **remain alert** and have **sufficient emergency response personnel** and **equipment** during the forecasted holiday period.
- (6) Alert **masses living** in **low-lying areas** to exercise **extra caution** and activate **community-based alert systems**.

- (7) Limit the number of **tourists allowed entry** to **picnic** and **tourist spots** to **avoid overcrowding**.
- (8) Regulate **traffic** at **picnic** and **tourist spots** to ensure a smooth flow and **prevent congestion**.
- (9) Secure **loose structures including billboards/ hoardings/ solar panels** from effects of windstorms/ thunder showers.

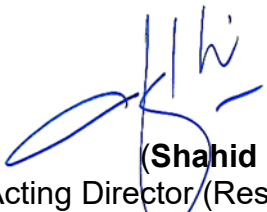
b. **PDMAs/ SDMA/ GBDMA/ ICT Administration**

- (1) Coordinate with respective PDMAs to **align local efforts** with provincial strategies and guidelines.
- (2) Activate/ **ensure staffing** of **HR** in **EOCs** for effective **coordination** and **response**.
- (3) Establish a **streamlined** and **efficient communication channel** to ensure **timely dissemination** of weather forecasts, **advisories** and **alerts** to local administrations and the **public**.
- (4) Ensure flow of information **among all stakeholders** is **accurate**, **timely** and effectively **coordinated**.
- (5) Ensure **enforcement/ dissemination** of **mitigative/ preparedness/ response guidelines** to **all** concerned.
- (6) Ensure **rapid damage** and **needs assessments** following major incidents.

c. **Federal Ministries/ Departments**

- (1) Ensuring **interagency coordination** and **information sharing** for monitoring and handling emergencies.
- (2) Raise **mass awareness through respective platforms** relevant stakeholders about **seasonal hazards**.
- (3) Ensure **strict** and **proactive monitoring** of the **movement** around/ in close vicinity of nullahs and water channels to **avert possibilities** of **drowning**.

- **Islamabad/Punjab:** Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavyfall/hailstorm) is expected in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliat, Jhelum, Chakwal, Talagang, Attock from 12th to 17th September with occasional gaps. Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavyfall/hailstorm) is expected in Lahore, Sialkot, Sheikhupura, Narowal, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Wazirabad, Hafizabad, Kasur, Okara, Nankana Sahib, Sargodha, Khushab, Mianwali, Noorpur Thal, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Layyah, Bhakkar, Sahiwal, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan and surroundings from 14th (evening/night) to 17th September with occasional gaps.
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- **Gilgit-Baltistan:** Rain-wind/thundershower (with moderate to isolated heavyfall) is expected in Diamir, Astora, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar from 12th to 17th September with occasional gaps.
- **Sindh:** Mainly hot and humid weather is likely to prevail in most parts. However, rain-wind/thunderstorm (with isolated heavyfall) is expected in Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Mirpurkhas, Tharparkar, Umarkot, Thatta, Badin, Karachi and surroundings from 13th (evening/night) to 16th September with occasional gaps.
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Possible Impacts and advices:

- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions.

مختصر موسمیات کے مطابق مون سون ہوائیں ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہو رہی ہیں۔ ایک مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ ویک اینڈ کے دوران ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کا امکان ہے، مغربی ہواؤں کے سلسلے میں 14 ستمبر (پیر) سے اضافہ ہونے کی توقع ہے۔ اس موسمی نظام کے زیر اثر:

- **شعبہ 12 سے 17 ستمبر کے دوران** وادی نیلم، مختصر آباد، راولا کوٹ، پونچھ، ہلیاں، باغ، جلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، جمہور اور میرپور میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش اور ڈالہ ہادی کا امکان۔
- **اسلام آباد، پنجاب: 12 سے 17 ستمبر کے دوران** اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، مری، گجرات، جہلم، پکوال، تلہ گنگ اور الگ میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش اور ڈالہ ہادی کا امکان۔ 14 ستمبر (شام اوقات) سے 17 ستمبر کے دوران لاہور، سیالکوٹ، شیوپور، روڈ ناں، دال، منڈی بہاؤ الدین، گجرات، گوجرانوالہ، وزیر آباد، قصور، اوکاڑہ، ننکانہ صاحب، سرگودھا، خوشاب، میانوالی، نورپور، فیصل آباد، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، لیہ، بکھر، ساہیوال، ڈیرہ غازی خان، دھماں اور گردونواح میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ جبکہ چند مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش اور ڈالہ ہادی کا امکان۔
- **شعبہ 12 سے 17 ستمبر کے دوران** پشاور، دیر، چترال، سوات، کوہستان، مالاکنڈ، مردان، نوشہرہ، چارسدہ، صوابی، شانگلہ، جہلم، یوٹیر، کوہاٹ، منگو، کرم، باجوڑ، مہمند، خیبر، اورکزئی، ماسہرہ، دیپٹ آباد، ہری پور، کرک، ٹانک، کلی، مروت، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، ہٹوں اور زہستان میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش اور ڈالہ ہادی کا امکان۔
- **گت 12 سے 17 ستمبر کے دوران** دہلی، استور، نڈر، اسکرو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گانچے اور شمر میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر درمیانی سے موسلا حد بارش بھی متوقع۔
- **سندھ:** صوبہ کے بیشتر اضلاع میں موسم گرم اور مرطوب رہنے کا امکان۔ جبکہ 13 (شام اوقات) سے 16 ستمبر کے دوران سکس، لاڑکانہ، جیکب آباد، میرپور خاص، قحدر، کراچی، ٹھٹھ، بدین، کراچی اور گردونواح میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش بھی متوقع ہے۔
- **بلوچستان:** صوبہ کے بیشتر اضلاع میں موسم گرم اور مرطوب رہنے کا امکان۔ جبکہ 13 (شام اوقات) سے 16 ستمبر کے دوران ژوب، ہارکان، موئی ٹیل اور گردونواح میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کی توقع۔

- موسلا حد بارش کے باعث 14 سے 17 ستمبر کے دوران دیر، چترال، سوات، کوہستان، شانگلہ، جہلم، یوٹیر، چارسدہ، صوابی، دال، منڈی بہاؤ الدین، گجرات، گوجرانوالہ، وزیر آباد، قصور، اوکاڑہ، ننکانہ صاحب، سرگودھا، خوشاب، میانوالی، نورپور، فیصل آباد، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، لیہ، بکھر، ساہیوال، ڈیرہ غازی خان، دھماں اور گردونواح میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔
- ویک اینڈ کے دوران درج ذیل علاقوں میں درج ذیل گت کا حد۔
- سیالکوٹ، ساہیوال، مری، گجرات، جہلم، یوٹیر، کوہاٹ، منگو، کرم، باجوڑ، مہمند، خیبر، اورکزئی، ماسہرہ، دیپٹ آباد، ہری پور، کرک، ٹانک، کلی، مروت، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، ہٹوں اور زہستان میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔
- گجرات، مری، گجرات، جہلم، یوٹیر، کوہاٹ، منگو، کرم، باجوڑ، مہمند، خیبر، اورکزئی، ماسہرہ، دیپٹ آباد، ہری پور، کرک، ٹانک، کلی، مروت، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، ہٹوں اور زہستان میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔

نوٹ: تمام حلقہ واریں کو "اوقات" سے پہلے اور کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔

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
