Punjab:

Rain/thundershowers are expected over the upper, central, and northeastern parts of the province. Murree, Rawalpindi, Taxila, Kahuta, Kotli Sattian, Attock, Chakwal, Talagang, Jhelum, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Kasur, Sheikhupura, Nankana Sahib, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Chiniot, Sargodha, Khushab, Jhang, Mianwali, Okara, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Multan, Khanewal, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Layyah, and Muzaffargarh may receive rainfall, with localized heavy falls in upper Punjab and the Pothohar region. Province shall remain hot and humid generally on 6-7 Aug, with Southern districts are expected to remain very hot including Bahawalnagar, Rahim Yar Khan, Bahawalpur, Rajanpur, and Dera Ghazi Khan.

Balochistan:

Northeastern districts are expected to receive isolated to scattered rain/thundershower including Zhob, Sherani, Musakhel, Barkhan, Loralai, Ziarat, Qilla Saifullah, while the western and southern parts will remain mostly hot and dry. Province shall remain hot and humid generally, with districts expected to remain very hot including Sibi, Dera Bugti, Naseerabad, Jaffarabad, Sohbatpur, Washuk, Chagai, Nushki, Khuzdar, Panjgur, Awaran, and Lasbela.

Sindh:

Mainly hot and humid weather will prevail. Isolated to scattered rain-wind/thundershowers are expected over Karachi, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tharparkar, Sanghar, Dadu, Jamshoro, Larkana, Jacobabad, Kashmore, and Sukkur, while the remainder of the province will remain very hot. Daytime temperatures are expected to rise over Jacobabad, Dadu, Larkana, Sukkur, Ghotki, Kashmore, and Shaheed Benazirabad.

KP:

Widespread rain/thundershowers are expected, particularly over the upper and central districts. Chitral, Upper & Lower Dir, Swat, Shangla, Upper & Lower Kohistan, Kolai-Palas, Battagram, Torghar, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Nowshera, Charsadda, Swabi, Mardan, Kurram, and Khyber, with isolated heavy falls over the mountainous areas. The temperatures may rise on 6-7 Aug. Southern districts including Bannu, Lakki Marwat, Tank, Karak, Dera Ismail Khan, and North & South Waziristan will remain mainly hot and humid with only isolated showers.

GB & AJK:

Widespread rain/thundershowers are expected over Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghizer, Diamir, Astore, Skardu, Shigar, Ghanche, Kharmang, Tangir, Darel, and Gupis, with isolated heavy rainfall capable of triggering flash floods and landslides in vulnerable valleys. Widespread rain/thundershowers are likely over Muzaffarabad, Neelum, Hattian Bala, Bagh, Haveli, Poonch, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Mirpur, and Bhimber, with moderate to heavy rainfall expected in the upper catchments. The temperatures may rise on 6-7 Aug however the rainfall shall ease the temperatures later.
