Punjab:

Scattered to widespread rain/thundershowers are expected, with locally heavy rainfall possible, particularly over northern and northeastern Punjab. Rainfall is likely over Islamabad, Murree, Kahuta, Kotli Sattian, Gujar Khan, Kallar Syedan, Rawalpindi, Taxila, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Kharian, Sialkot, Daska, Narowal, Gujranwala, Lahore and Sheikhupura. Northern and central areas will remain warm and humid, while southern Punjab is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

Balochistan:

Isolated to scattered monsoon thunderstorms are likely, mainly over northeastern and southeastern parts, while western areas will remain predominantly dry. Rainfall may affect Zhob, Sherani, Musakhel, Loralai, Barkhan, Harnai, Ziarat, Sibi, Dera Bugti, Khuzdar and Kalat. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures however, lowland areas will remain hot to very hot.

Sindh:

Scattered to isolated rain/thundershowers are possible, with greater rainfall potential over southeastern and coastal Sindh. Areas that may receive showers include Karachi, Thatta, Jati, Sujawal, Shah Bandar, Badin, Golarchi, Mithi, Islamkot, Diplo, Nagarparkar, Umerkot, Samaro, Mirpur Khas, Tando Allahyar and Hyderabad. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

KP:

Widespread to scattered rain/thundershowers are expected, with isolated heavy falls particularly over northern and eastern districts. Areas likely to receive rainfall include Chitral, Drosh, Dir, Saidu Sharif, Mingora, Bahrain, Matta, Kalam, Besham, Alpuri, Pattan, Dassu, Mansehra, Balakot, Abbottabad, Battagram, Haripur, Peshawar, Charsadda and Nowshera. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

GB & AJK:

Scattered to widespread rain/thundershowers are expected during the forecast period, with locally moderate to heavy showers possible, particularly during afternoon and evening hours. Rainfall is likely over Gilgit, Danyor, Hunza, Aliabad, Nagar, Gupis, Yasin, Chilas, Darel, Astore, Skardu, Shigar, Khaplu and Ghanche. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures. Widespread rain/thundershowers are expected in AJK, with locally heavy showers possible over mountainous areas. Rainfall is likely across Muzaffarabad, Hattian Bala, Athmuqam, Sharda, Bagh, Dhirkot, Rawalakot, Hajira, Pallandri, Kotli, Sehnsa, Mirpur and Bhimber. Temperatures will generally remain hot, with cooler conditions over higher elevations.
