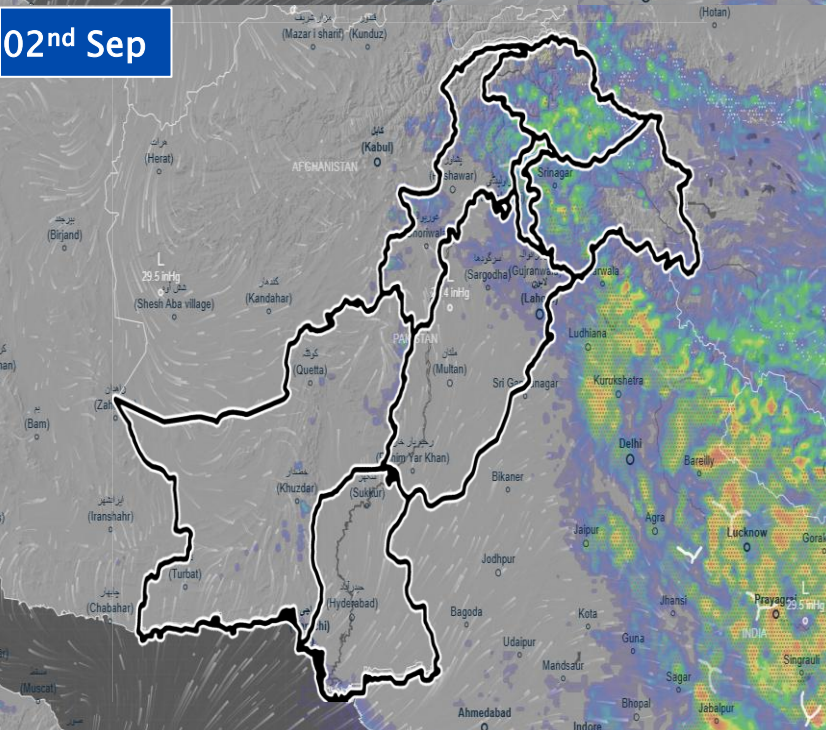
Balochistan:

The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

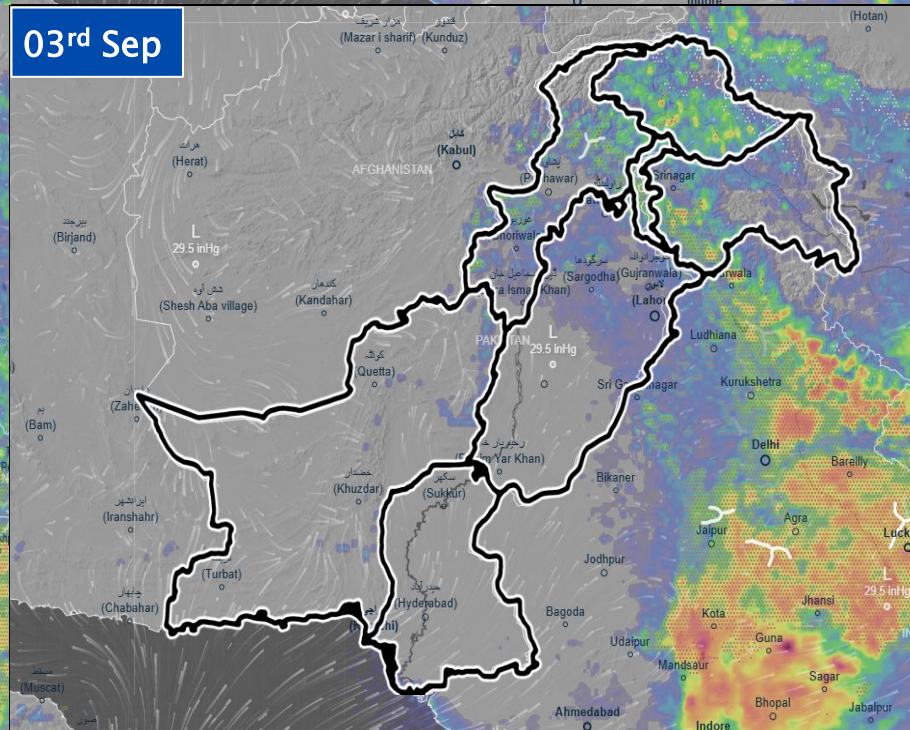

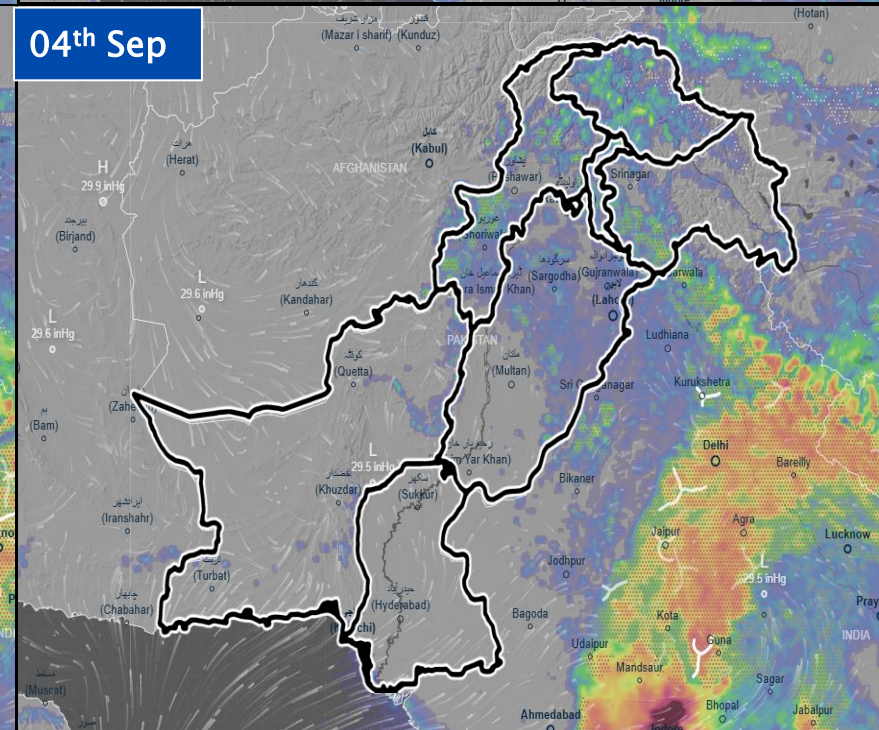
