Punjab:

The province is expected to experience widespread rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm with isolated heavy falls in districts including Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar, Layyah, Mianwali, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, R.Y. Khan, Kot Addu, and surrounding areas. Isolated hailstorm may also occur during this time. Rainfall may ease the temperatures but the province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

Balochistan:

The province is expected to experience isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm in districts including Quetta, Kalat, Jafarabad,, Zhob, Ziarat, Kohlu, Sibi, Khuzdar, Turbat and surrounding areas. Isolated hailstorm may also occur during this time. Rainfall may ease the temperatures but the province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

Sindh:

The province is expected to experience isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm in districts including Jacobabad, Sukkur, Mehrabpur, Dadu, Nawabshah, Hyderabad, and surrounding areas. Rainfall may ease the temperatures but the province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

KP:

The province is expected to experience widespread rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm in districts including Chitral, Dir, Mingora, Batkhela, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mansehra, Swabi, Peshawar, Mardan, Landi Kotal, Kohat, Hangu, Sadda, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Bannu, D.I. Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Parachinar, Kurram and surrounding areas. Isolated hailstorm may also occur during this time. Rainfall may ease the temperatures but the province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

GB & AJK:

The province is expected to experience widespread rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm in districts including Gilgit, Skardu, Hunza, Ghizer, Diamer, Astore, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Bhimber, Mirpur, Kotli, Bagh, Forward Kahuta, Dadiyal, Khui Ratta, Garhi Duppatta and surrounding areas. Isolated hailstorm may also occur during this time. Rainfall may ease the temperatures but the province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.
