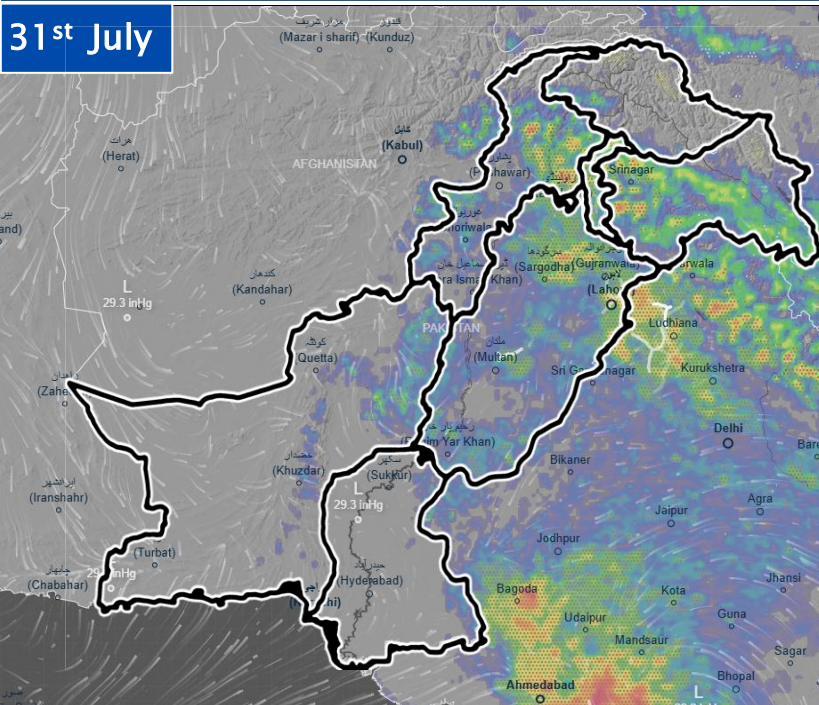




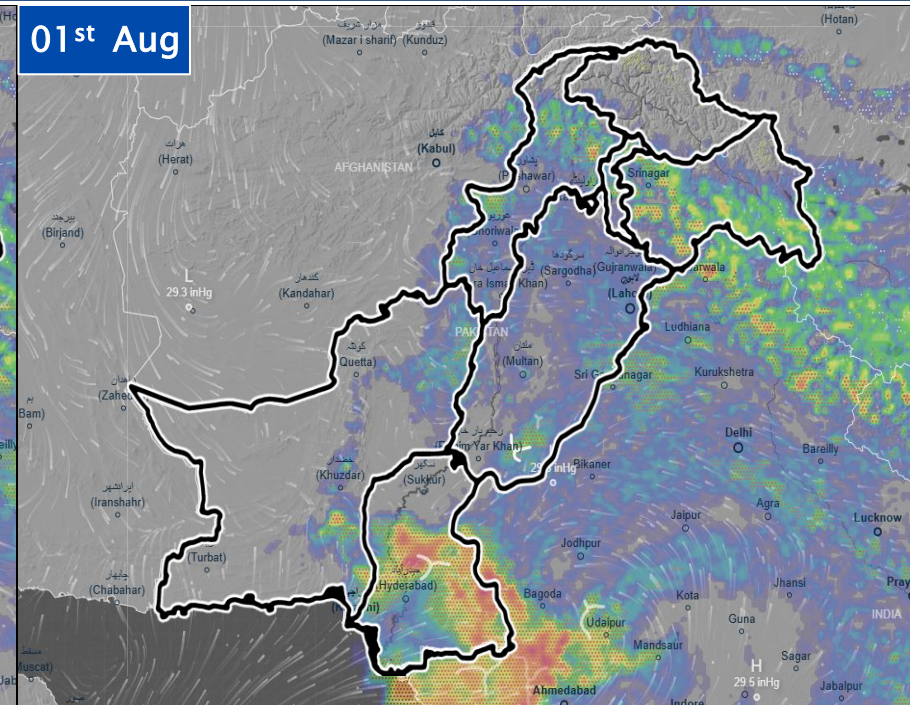

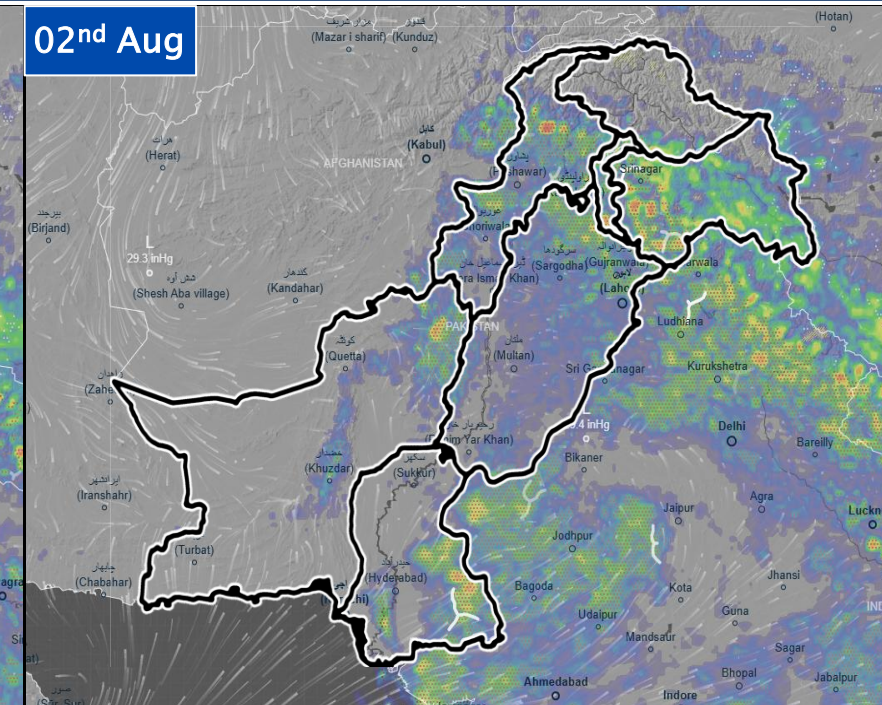

Punjab:

The province is expected to experience widespread rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm with isolated heavy falls in districts Murree, Rawalpindi, Islamabad, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Khushab, Sargodha, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Sialkot, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Jhang, Bhakkar, Narowal, Sheikupura, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Layyah, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Sahiwal, Khanewal, Muzzafarghar, Dera Ghazi Khan, Pakpattan, Vehari, Lodhran, Multan, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, Rahim Yar Khan, and surrounding areas. Rainfall may ease daytime temperatures but the province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

Balochistan:

The province is expected to experience isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm with isolated heavy falls in districts including Quetta, Kalat, Jafarabad, Loralai, Zhob, Ziarat, Kohlu, Naseerabad, Qila Saifullah, Qila Abdullah, Sibi, Barkhan, Khuzdar, and surrounding areas. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

Sindh:

The province is expected to experience light to moderate rainfall in Sukkur, Kashmore, Jacobabad, Hyderabad, Ghotki, Shikarpur, Larkana, Dadu, Karachi and surrounding areas whereas isolated heavy falls are expected in western districts including Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mithi, Matli, Sanghar, Mirpur Khas and Badin. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

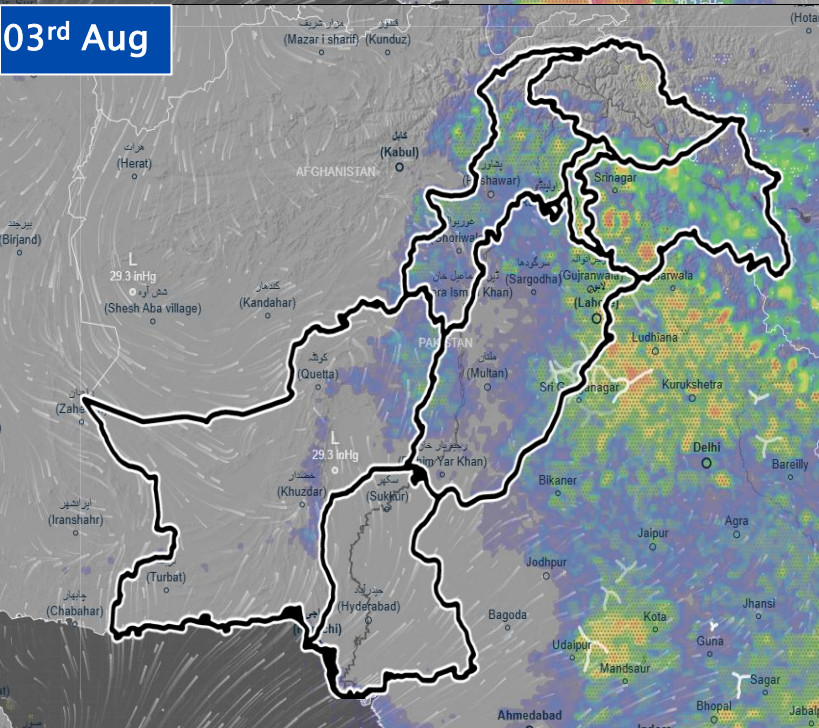
KP:

The province is expected to experience widespread rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm in districts including Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Kolai Palas, Batagram, Mansehra, Torghar, Buner, Abbotabad, Haripur, Swabi, Mardan, Malakand, Bajaur, Nowshera, Charsadda, Mohmand, Peshawar, Khyber, Kohat, Orakzai, Kurram, Hangu, Karak, Bannu, Lakki Marwat, Tank, Waziristan, Dera Ismail Khan, and surrounding areas. Rainfall may ease daytime temperatures but the province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

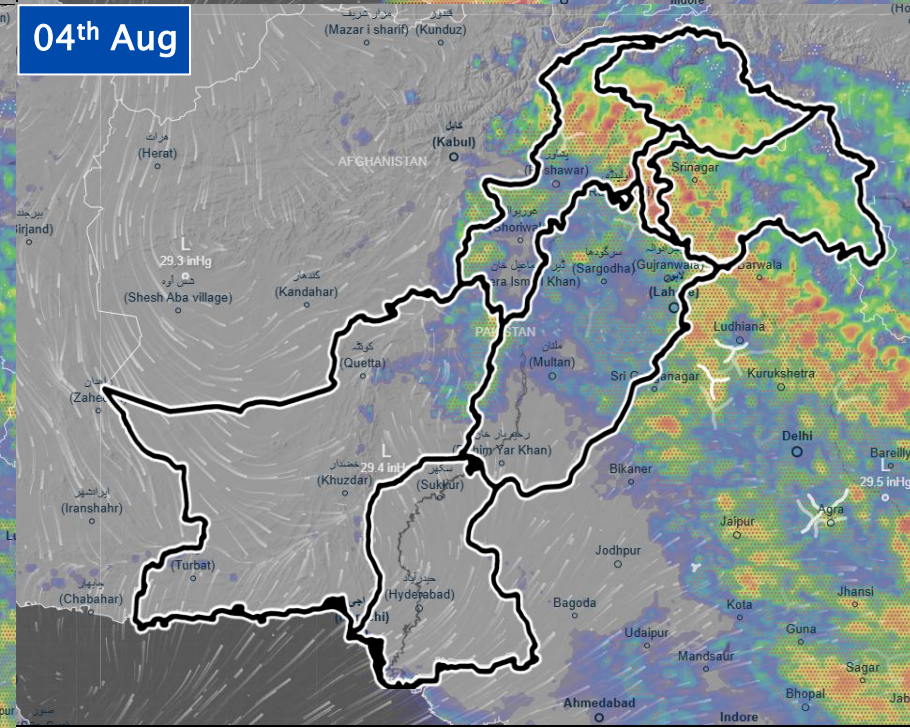
GB & AJK:

The province is expected to experience widespread rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated heavy falls in Gupis, Ghizer, Hunza, Nagar, Shigar, Gilgit, Rondu, Darel, Tangir, Diamir, Astore, Skardu, Ghanche, Kharmang, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, Hattian Bala, Bagh, Haveli, Poonch, Sudhnoti, Kotli, Mirpur, Bhimber, and surrounding areas. Rainfall may ease daytime temperatures but the province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.
