Punjab & ICT:

The ICT region & the Punjab province is expected to experience scattered rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm with isolated heavy falls. The provincial districts include Murree, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Khushab, Sargodha, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Sialkot, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Jhang, Bhakkar, Narowal, Sheikupura, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Layyah, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Multan, and surrounding areas. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

Balochistan:

Sindh:

KP:

Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Hangu, Parachinar, Kurram and surrounding areas. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.

GB & AJK:

The province is expected to experience isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm with isolated heavy falls in districts including Gilgit, Skardu, Hunza, Ghizer, Diamer, Astore, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Bhimber, Mirpur, Kotli, Bagh, Garhi Duppatta and surrounding areas. The province is expected to remain mainly hot and humid with rising daytime temperatures.
