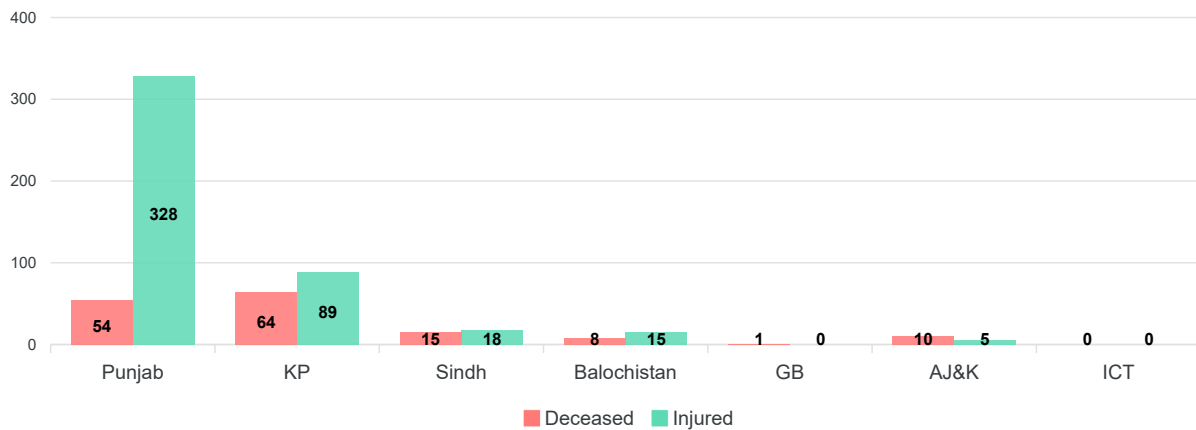

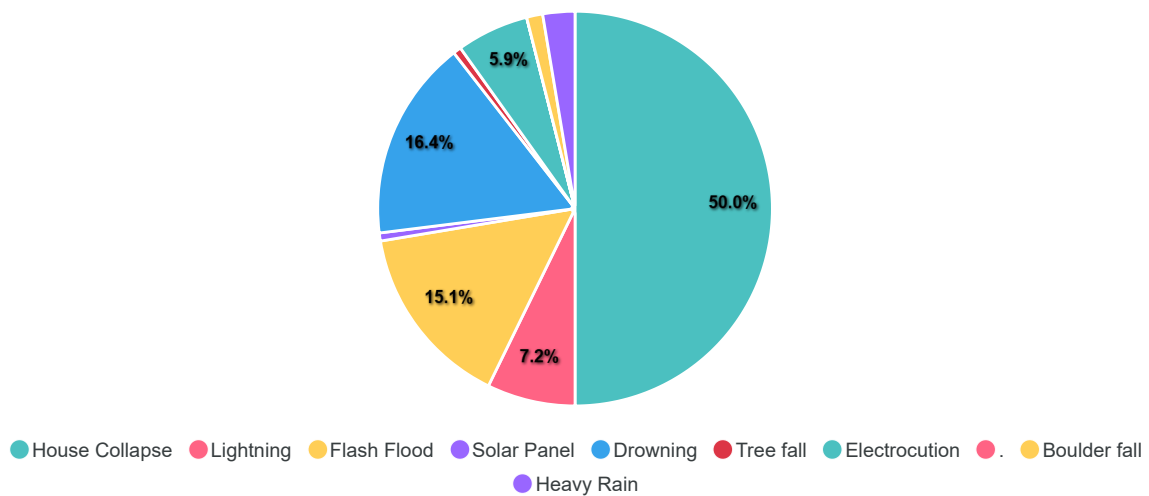

### Deceased & Injured



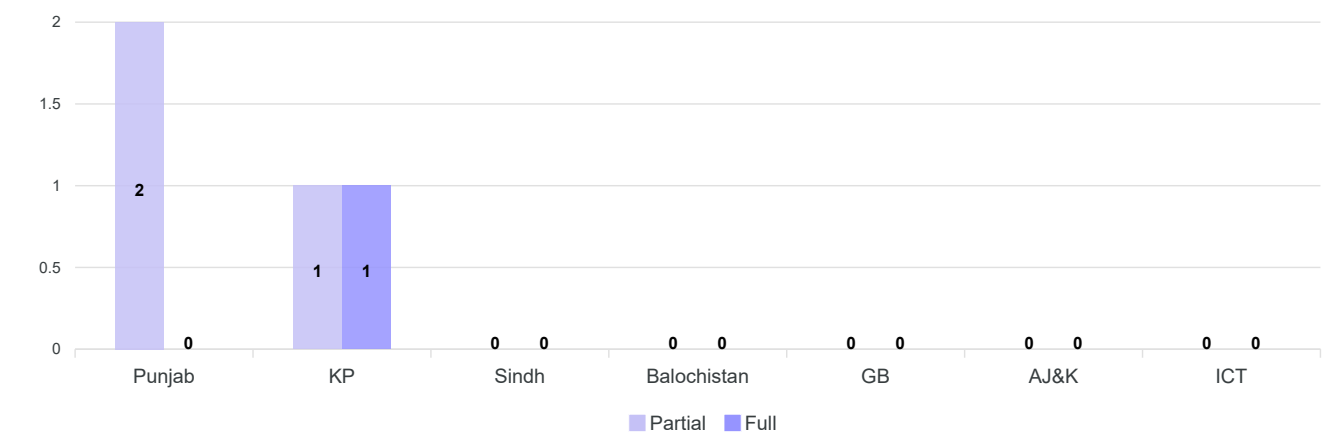

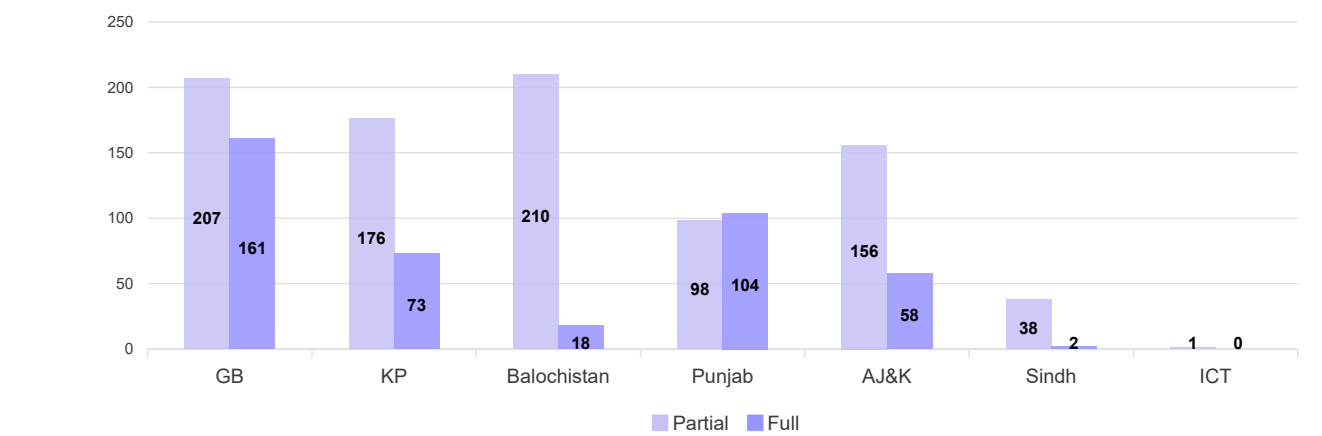

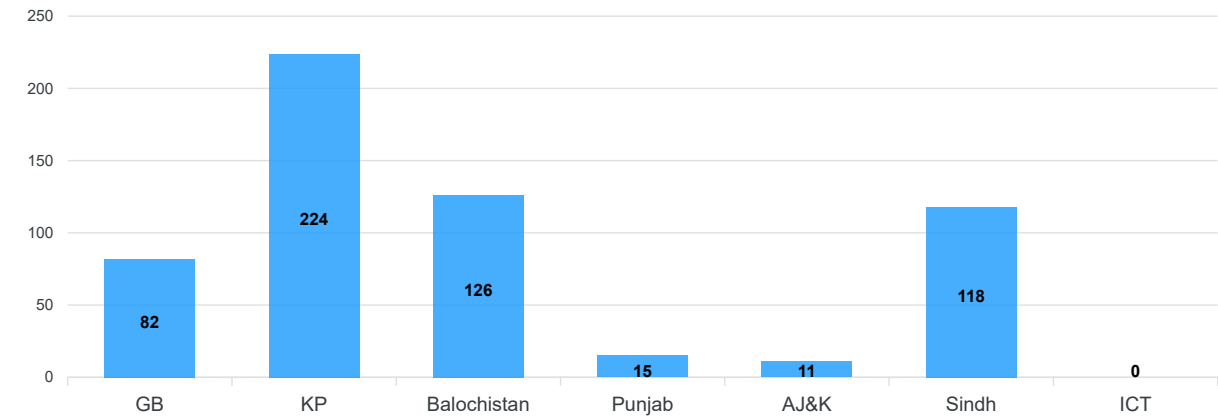

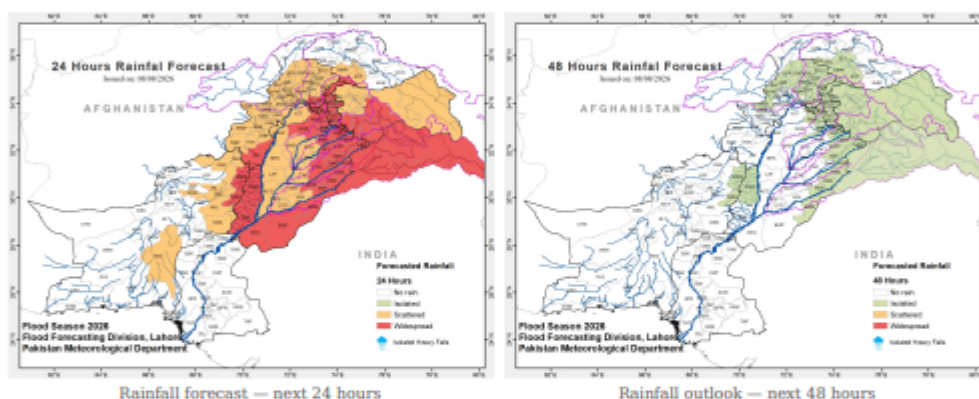

## RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST

### I. METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES

- A fresh trough of westerly wave lies over northeast Iran.
- The monsoon trough extends from northwest Rajasthan and adjoining areas of Pakistan towards West Bengal (India) along side the foothills of Himalayan mountains.
- Seasonal low-pressure area lies over northeast Balochistan.
- Moderate moist currents from Bay of Bengal are penetrating into the upper parts of the country up to 7,000 feet.

### II. METEOROLOGICAL OUTLOOK

- **Widespread rain-wind/thunderstorm with isolated heavy falls** is expected over the **upper catchments of eastern rivers including Islamabad, Kashmir and Punjab during next 24-hours.**



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**III. HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST**

- **River Indus** at Kalabagh, Chashma, Taunsa and Guddu is in **Low flood level** at downstream.
- All other major rivers are flowing in their normal flows at other gauging stations.

**IV. HYDROLOGICAL OUTLOOK**

- **Flows are expected to increase** in the **hill torrents of DG Khan & northern Balochistan**.
- **Urban Flooding** is also expected in **Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal, Faisalabad, Okara and Lahore**.

**V. WEATHER FORECAST FOR 24-HOURS**

- **Widespread rain-wind/thunderstorm** with **isolated heavy falls** is expected over the upper catchments of **Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab rivers, Islamabad, Kashmir,**

**Khyber Pakhtunkhwa:** Abbotabad, DI Khan and Haripur.

**Punjab:** Rawalpindi, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, Chakwal, DG Khan, Faisalabad, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Hafizabad, Jhelum, Kasur, Lahore, Mandi Bahauddin, Nankana Sahib, Narowal, Okara, Pakpattan, Rahim Yar Khan, Rajanpur, Sahiwal, Sheikhupura and Sialkot.

**Balochistan:** Barkhan and Musakhel.

- **Scattered rain-wind/thunderstorm** is expected over the upper catchments of **Indus, Jhelum rivers,**

**Khyber Pakhtunkhwa:** Bajaur, Bannu, Batagram, Buner, Charsadda, Dir, Hangu, Karak, Khyber, Kohat, Kohistan, Kurram, Lakki Marwat, Malakand, Mansehra, Mardan, Mohmand, Nowshera, Orakzai, Peshawar, Shangla, Waziristan, Swabi, Swat, Tank and Tor Ghar.

**Punjab:** Attock, Bhakkar, Chiniot, Jhang, Khanewal, Khushab, Layyah, Lodhran, Mianwali, Multan, Muzaffargarh, Sargodha, Toba Tek Singh and Vehari.

**Balochistan:** Dera Bugti, Duki, Harnai, Khuzdar, Kohlu, Loralai, Sherani and Zhob.

**Gilgit-Baltistan:** Astore and Diamir.

**VI. WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS**

- **Isolated rain-wind/thunderstorm** is expected over the **upper catchments of all the major rivers, Islamabad, Kashmir,**

**Khyber Pakhtunkhwa:** Abbottabad, Bajaur, Batagram, Buner, Dir, Haripur, Khyber, Kohistan, Mansehra, Mohmand, Orakzai, Shangla, Swat and Tor Ghar.

**Punjab:** Bahawalnagar, DG Khan, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Jhelum, Kasur, Lahore, Narowal, Okara, Pakpattan, Rawalpindi, Sheikhupura and Sialkot.

**Balochistan:** Barkhan and Musakhel.

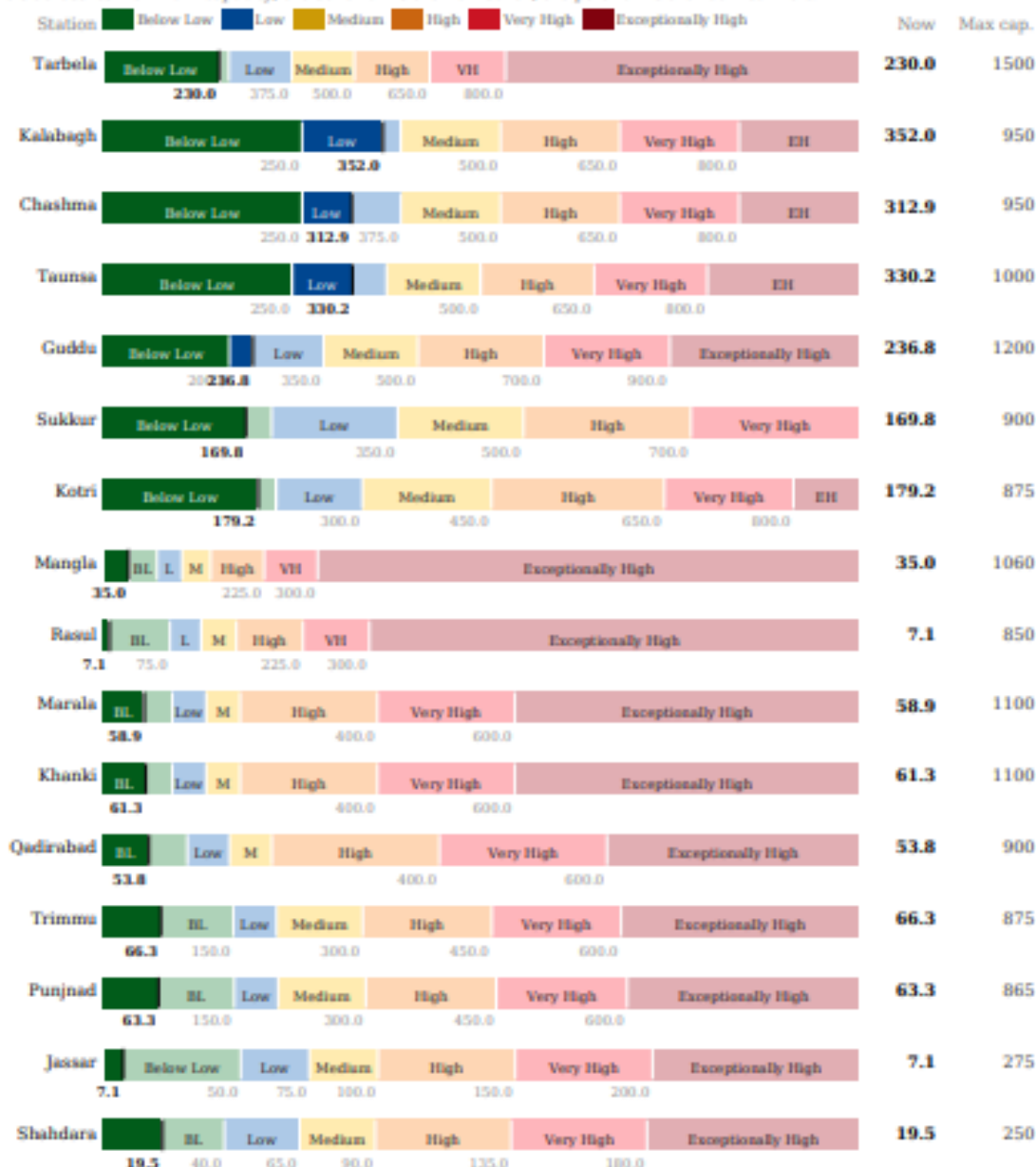
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## 5. HOW CLOSE IS EACH RIVER TO ITS LIMIT?

Kalabagh is in low flood at 352.0 — 23.0 below its medium flood level (375.0). Each bar is one station's own flood levels across its maximum capacity; the solid run is the flow so far, the pale run is the room still left.
