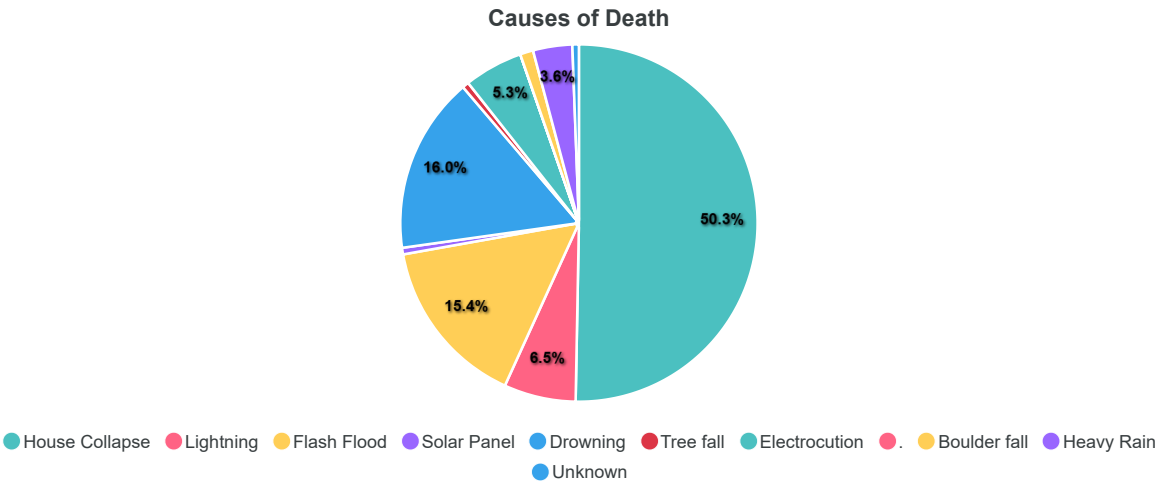
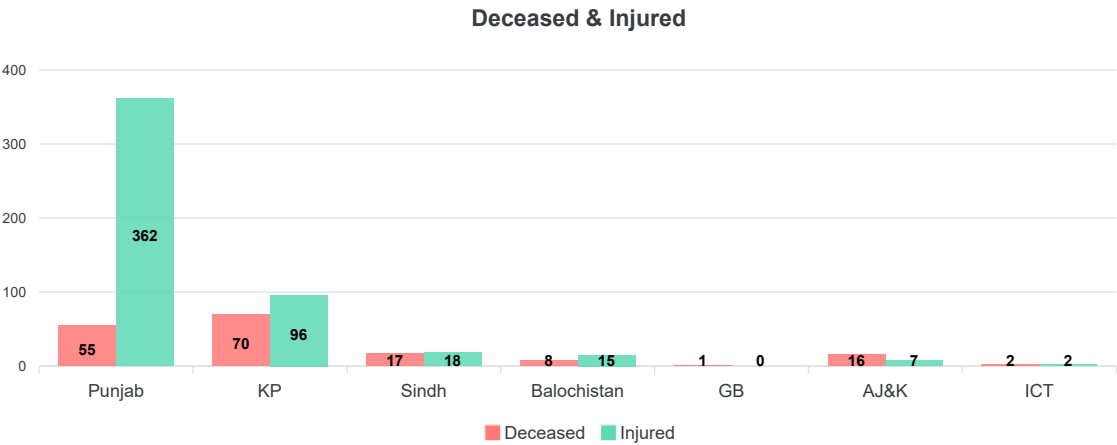

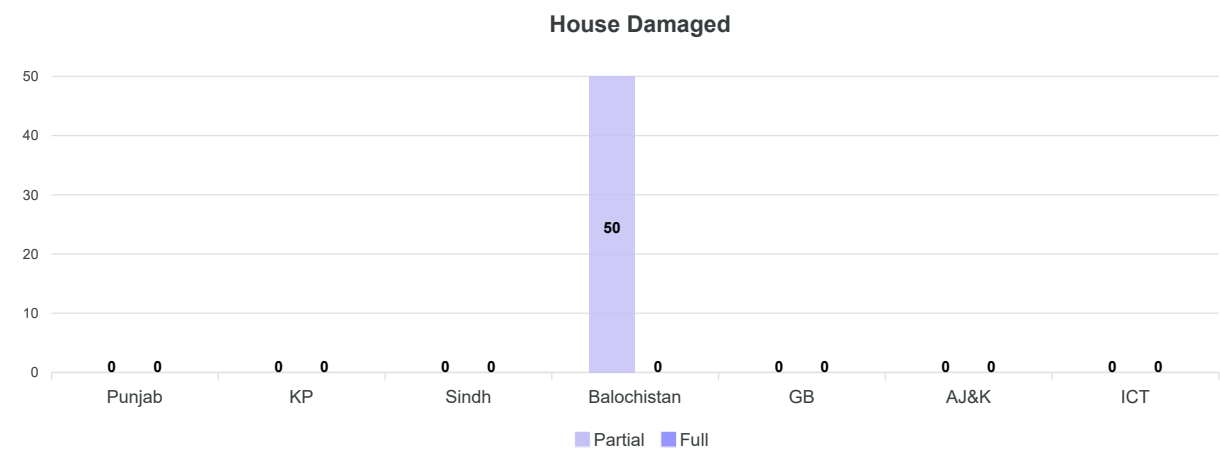

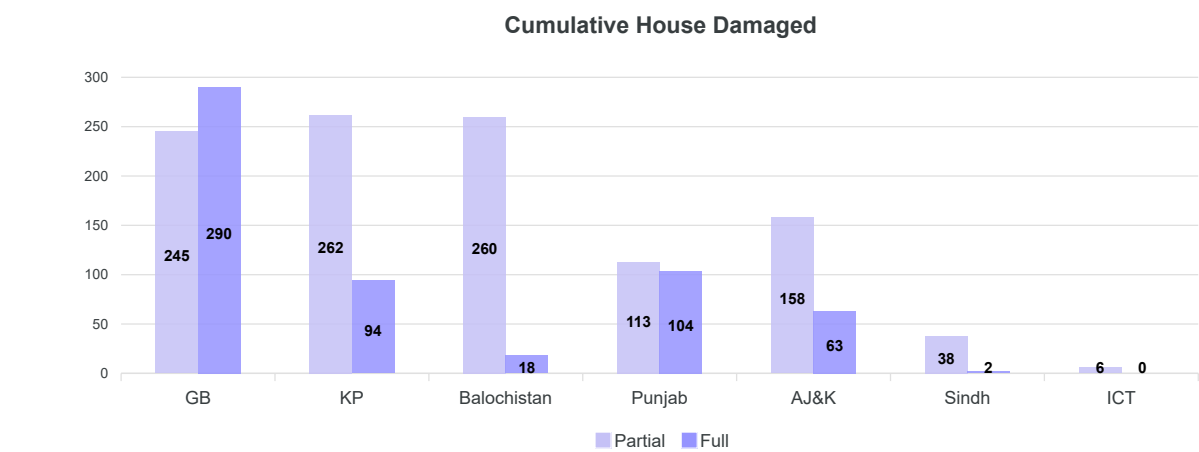

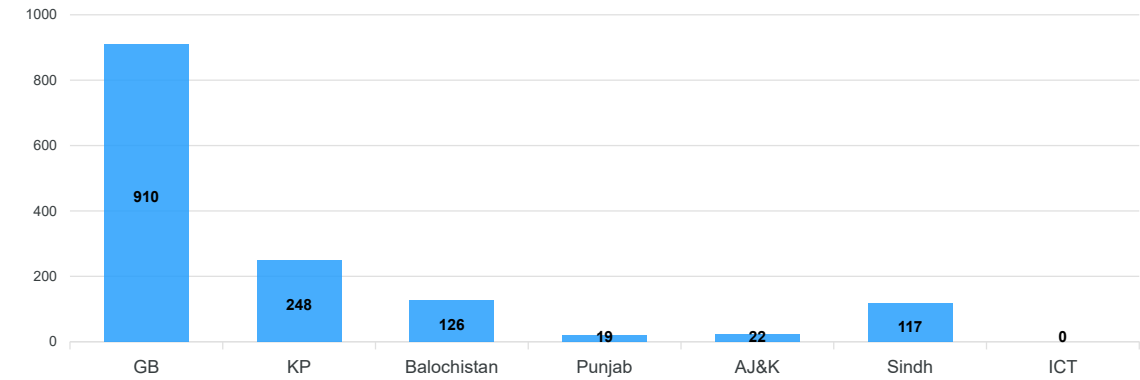

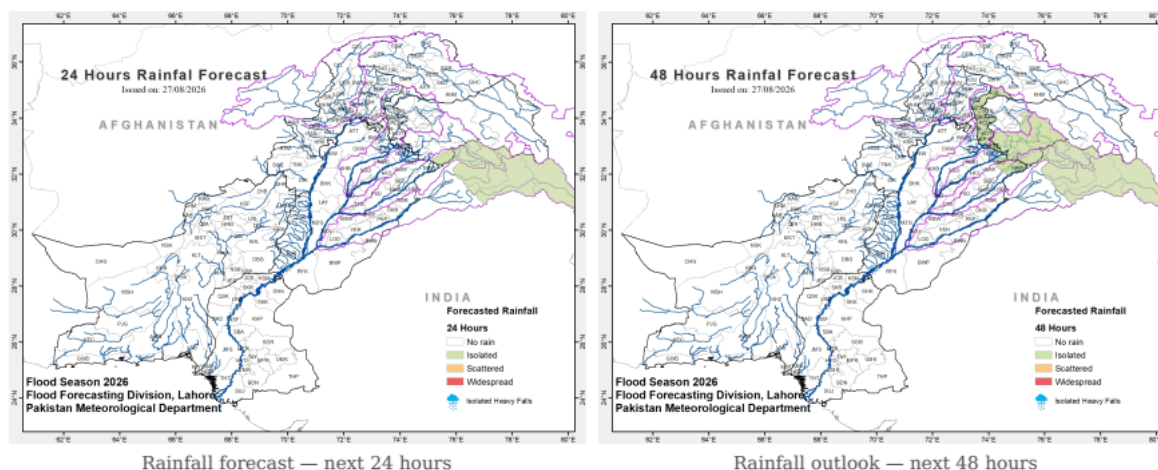

## RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST

### I. METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES

- Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over northwest Iran today lies over northeast Iran.
- Seasonal low-pressure area lies over northeast Balochistan.
- Yesterday's low pressure system over northeast Madhya Pradesh has moved slightly westwards and today lies over central Madhya Pradesh (India).
- Weak moist currents from Arabian sea are penetrating into the upper parts of the country up to 3,000 feet.

### II. METEOROLOGICAL OUTLOOK
