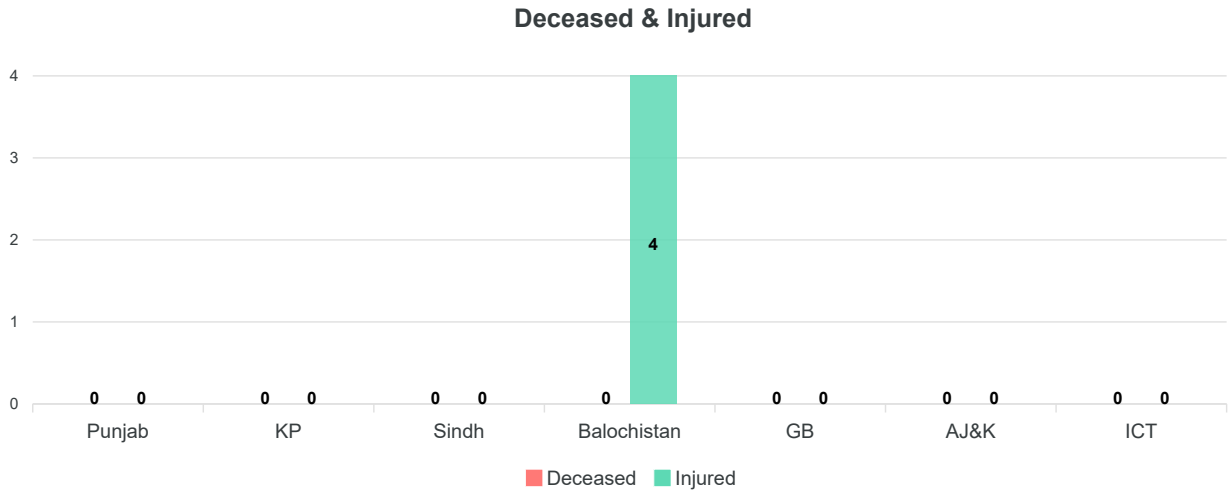

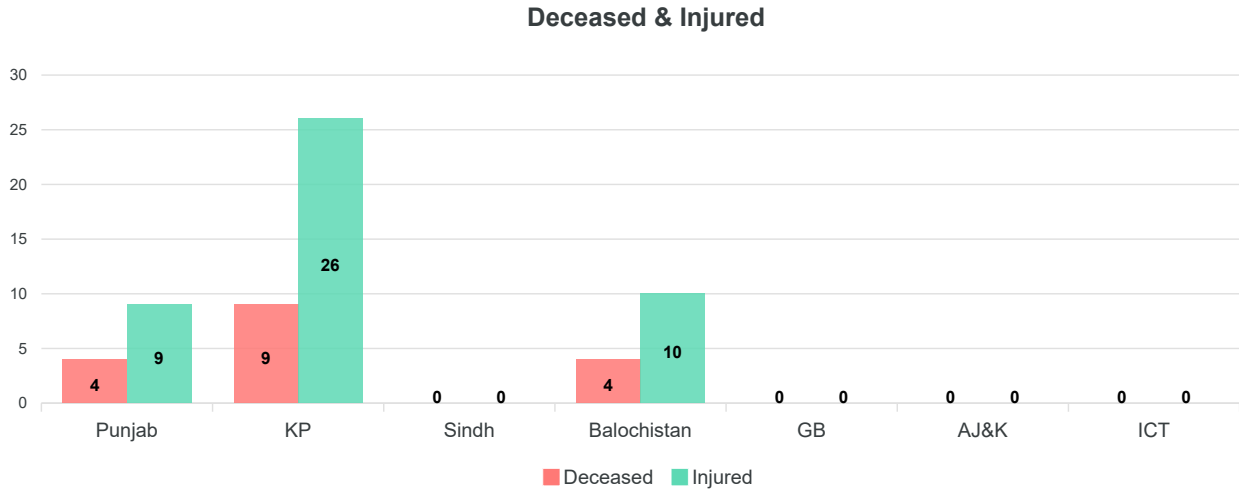

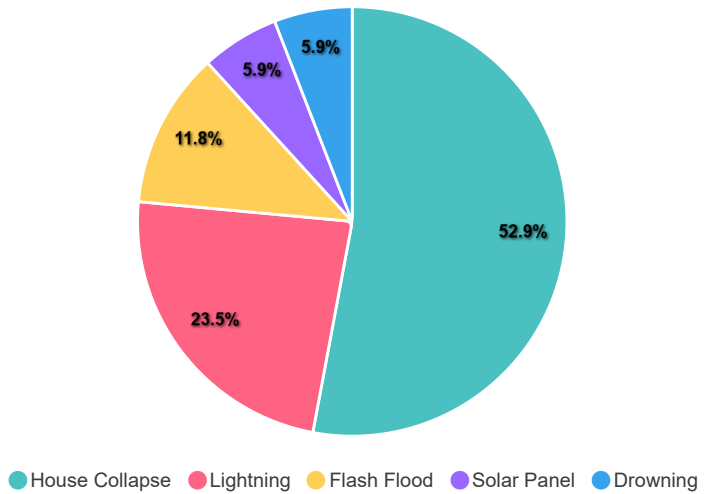

Cumulative Casualties And Injuries - (From 26 June 2026 to 4 July 2026)



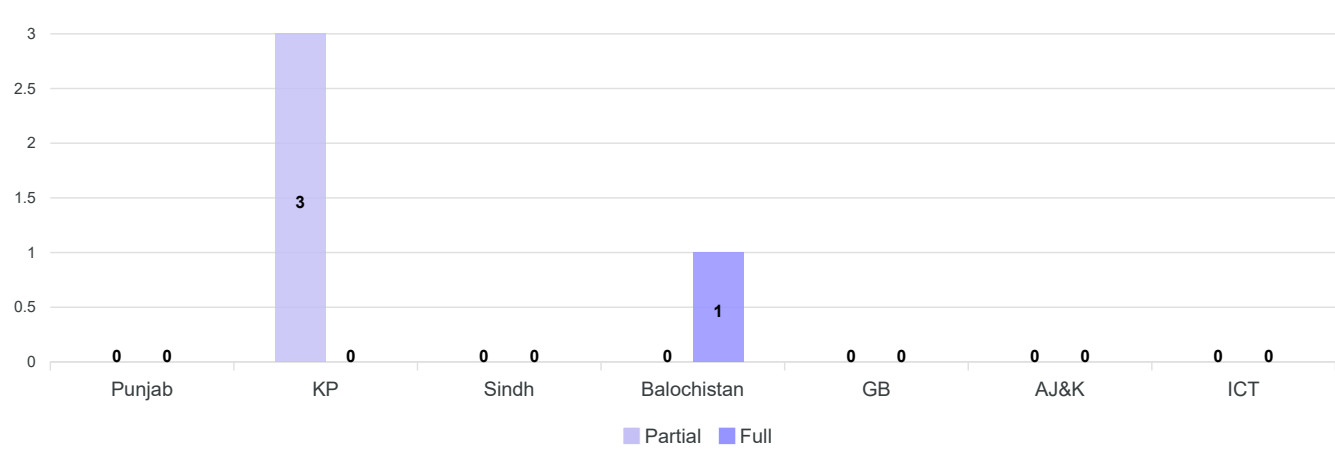

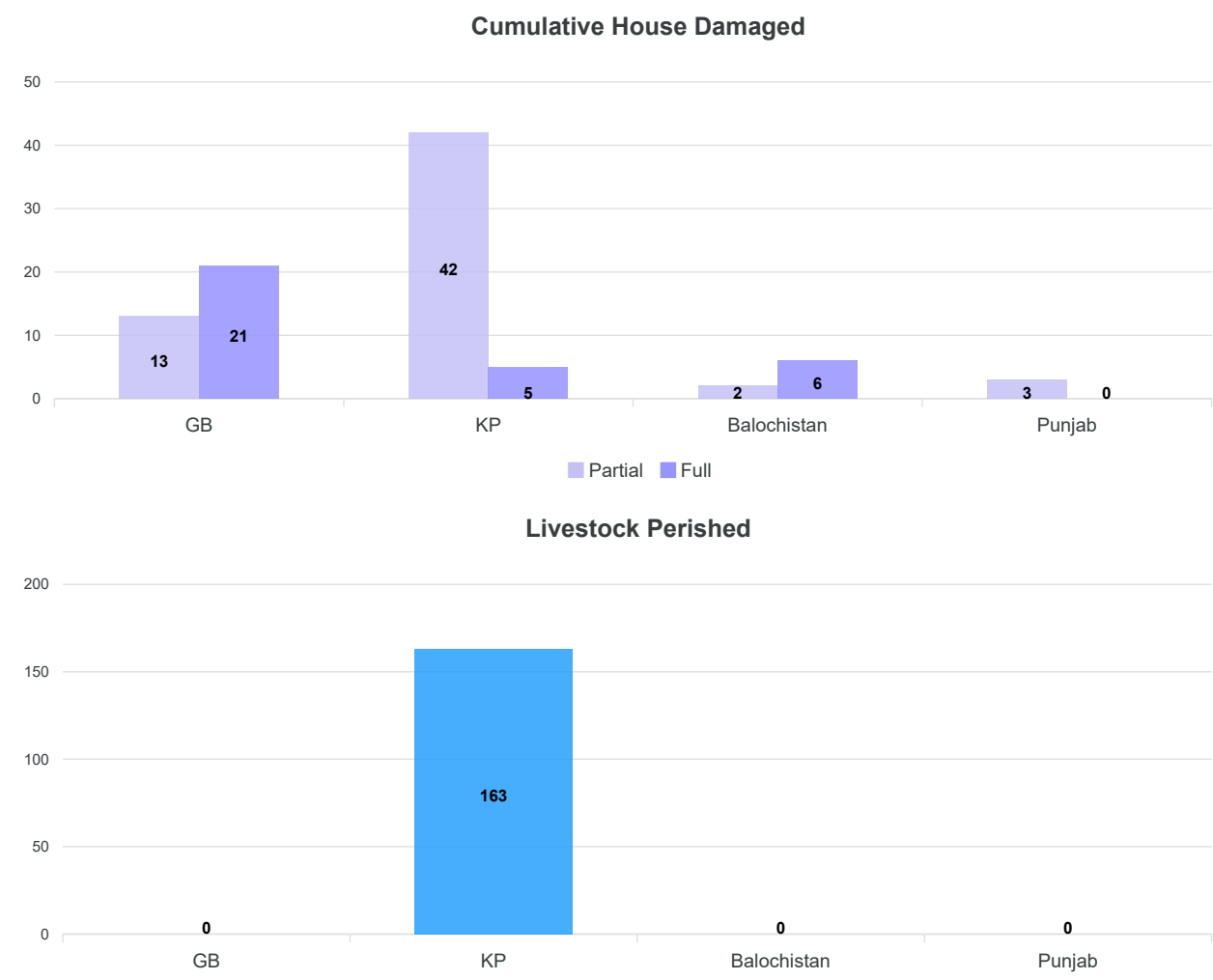

1. RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST AND OUTLOOK

- All the major rivers are flowing within their normal flows.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES

- A trough of westerly wave continues to persist over the norther parts of country.
- The seasonal low-pressure area lies over northwest Balochistan.
- Low Pressure area with central pressure (995 hPa) lies over Northeast Odisha (India).
- Weak moist currents are penetrating the lower half of the country and extending up to an altitude of 2,000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR 24-HOURS

- **Isolated rain-wind/thunderstorm** is expected over the upper catchments of Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab rivers **Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan.**
Punjab: Sialkot and Narowal.
Mainly hot and humid weather is expected for rest of the country.
