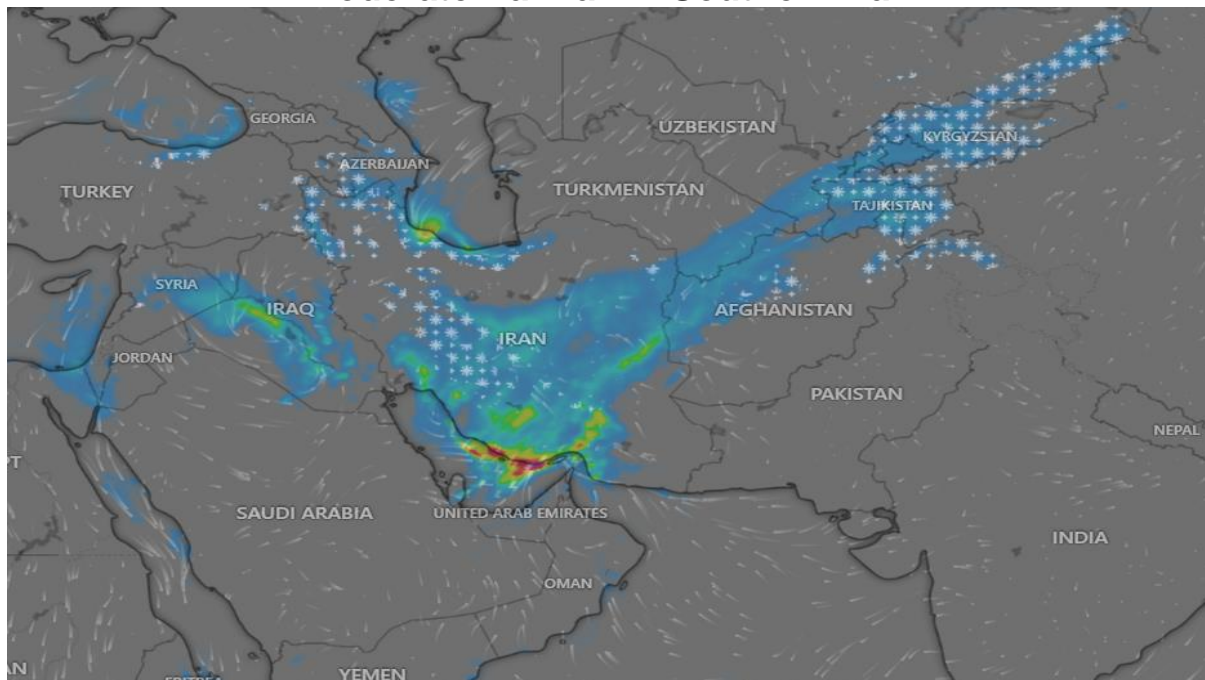




Moderate Rainfall in Southern Iran



Valid: December 13–20, 2025 (scattered showers early, main phase mid-week in south)

Affected Areas

Khuzestan, Fars, Bushehr, Hormozgan, Kohgiluyeh and Boyer-Ahmad, Chaharmahal and Bakhtiari, southern Lorestan, Zagros mountain ranges, Persian Gulf coastal plains.

Hazard Types

Moderate to Heavy Rainfall & Localized Flash Flooding, Thunderstorms with Lightning, Hail & Wind Gusts

Hazard Summary

A low-pressure system drawing moisture from the Arabian Sea and Persian Gulf is generating convective rainfall over southwestern and southern Iran. Intensification occurs December 16-18 with accumulated totals exceeding 50–100 mm in Zagros highlands and coastal plains of Khuzestan and Fars, raising risk of flash flooding and landslides in elevated terrain. Precipitation diminishes sharply northward with negligible amounts over the central plateau and northern provinces.
