




Extreme Rainfall & Potential Flooding in the Pacific Northwest (USA)



Valid: From December 8, 2025 (intensification begins) to December 12, 2025 (rain weakening thereafter).

Affected Areas

Washington State: Seattle, Tacoma, Olympia, Everett, Snohomish County, King County, Pierce County, Cascade foothills, Yakima, Wenatchee.

Oregon State: Portland Metropolitan Area, Salem, northern Oregon Coast Range, Columbia River Gorge, Tillamook, Clatsop, Hood River region.

Canada (adjacent): Vancouver & Fraser Valley.

Hazard Summary

A strong Atmospheric River (AR) is bringing intense and prolonged rainfall to the Pacific Northwest. Western Washington and Oregon may receive 100–200+ mm of rain, with higher amounts in mountainous regions. Flash flooding, rapid river rises, urban flooding, and landslides are likely, particularly along the Skagit, Snoqualmie, Stillaguamish, Puyallup, Cowlitz, and Columbia tributaries. Residents should follow local warnings and avoid low-lying areas and riverbanks.
