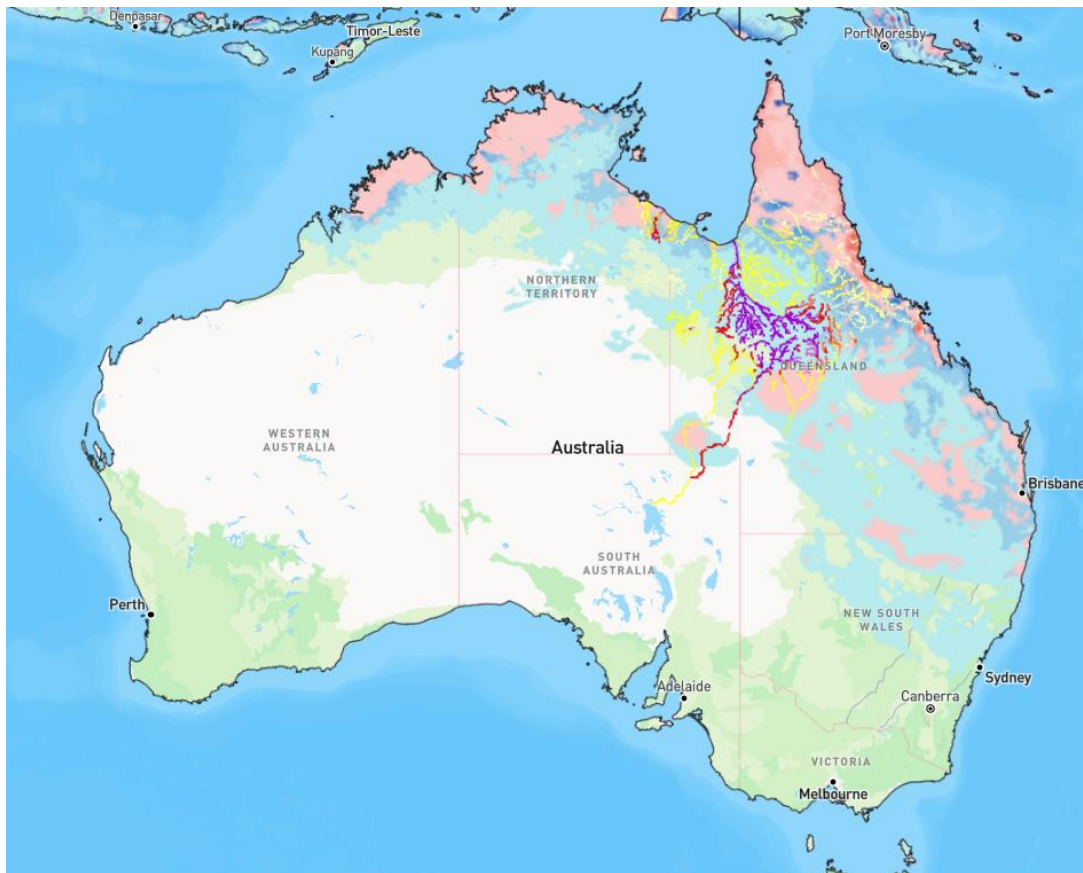

Hazard Summary

Widespread riverine flooding is affecting northern and north-eastern Australia due to heavy monsoonal rainfall and persistent tropical systems. Major and moderate flooding is occurring along rivers such as the Flinders, Georgina, and Thomson, inundating low-lying areas, roads, and farmland. River levels are expected to remain elevated for several days, with further rises possible as upstream flows continue. Communities and essential services may be impacted, and caution is advised.
