



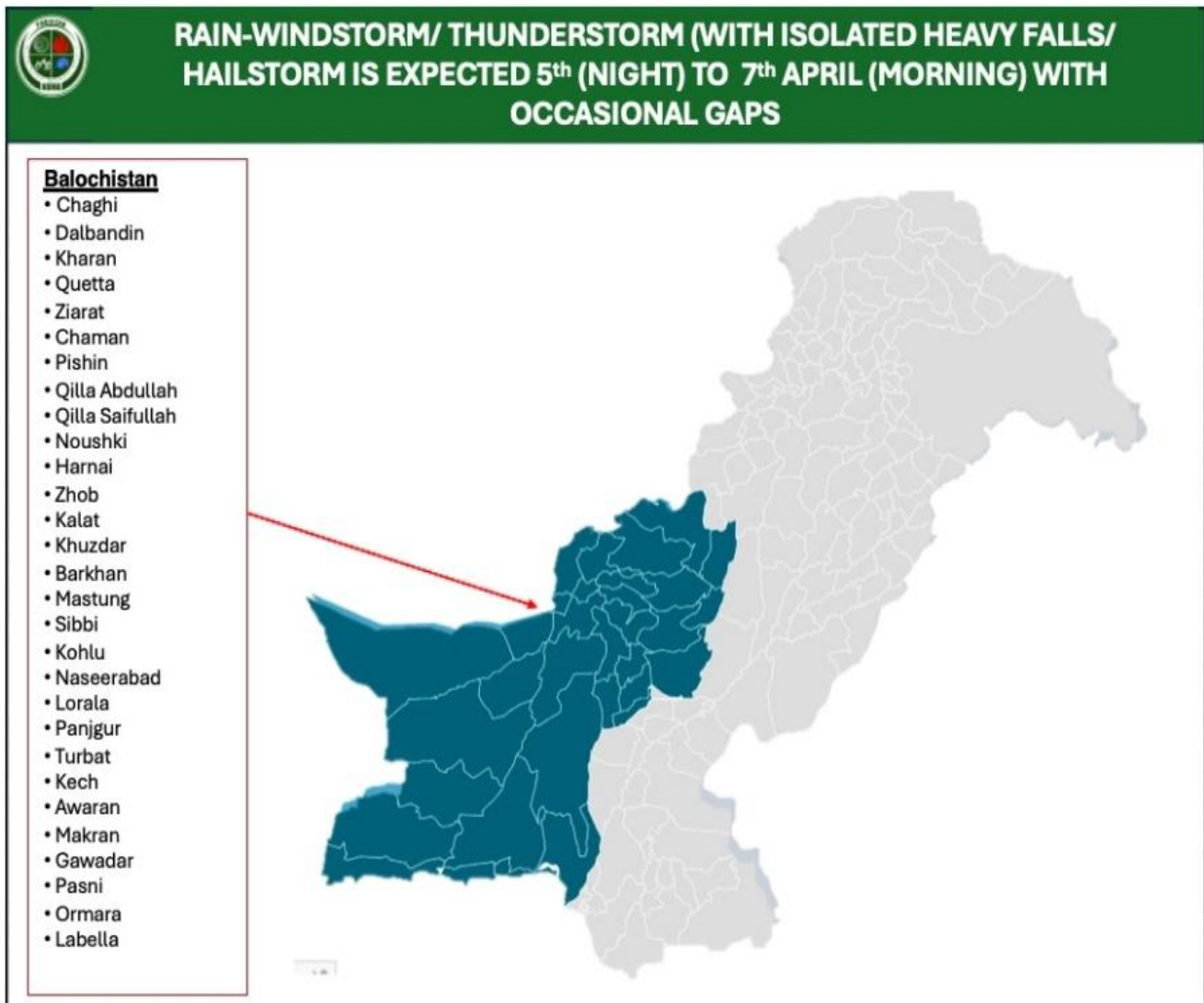

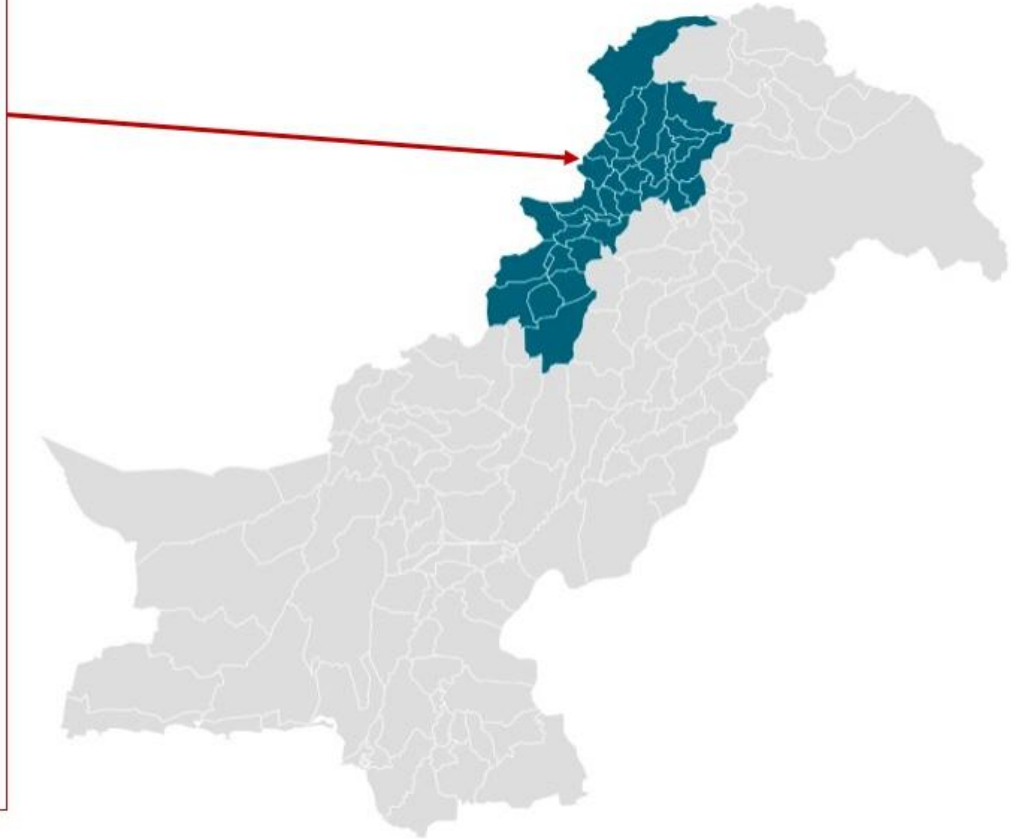

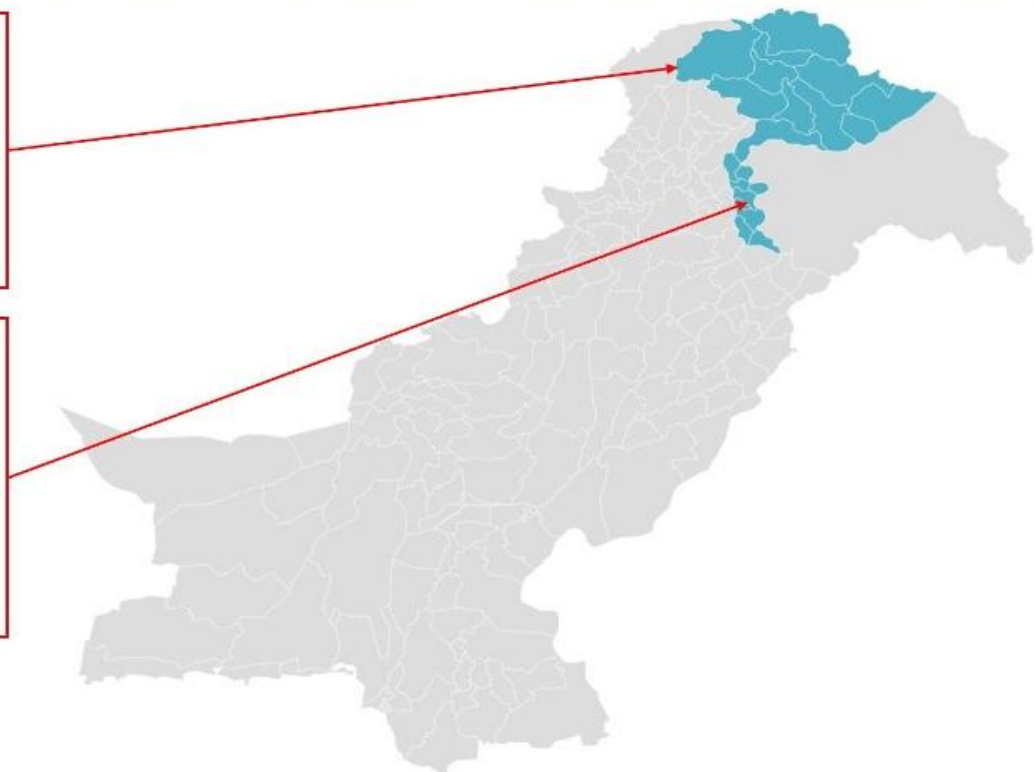
**RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSTORM WITH FEW HEAVY FALLS (SNOWFALL OVER THE HILLS)

HEAVYFALL IS LIKELY AT ISOLATED PLACES IN KASHMIR DURING THE PERIOD**

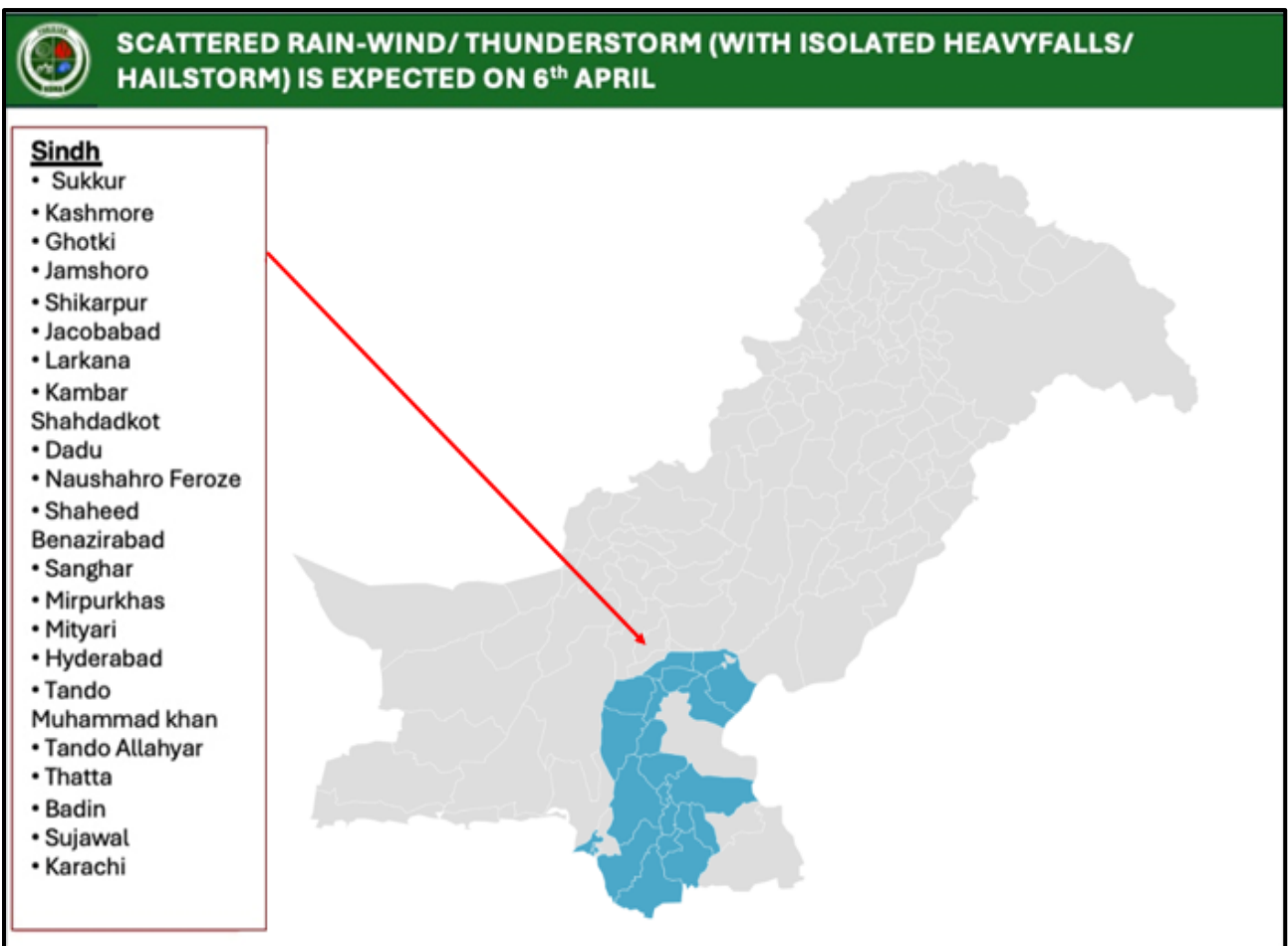
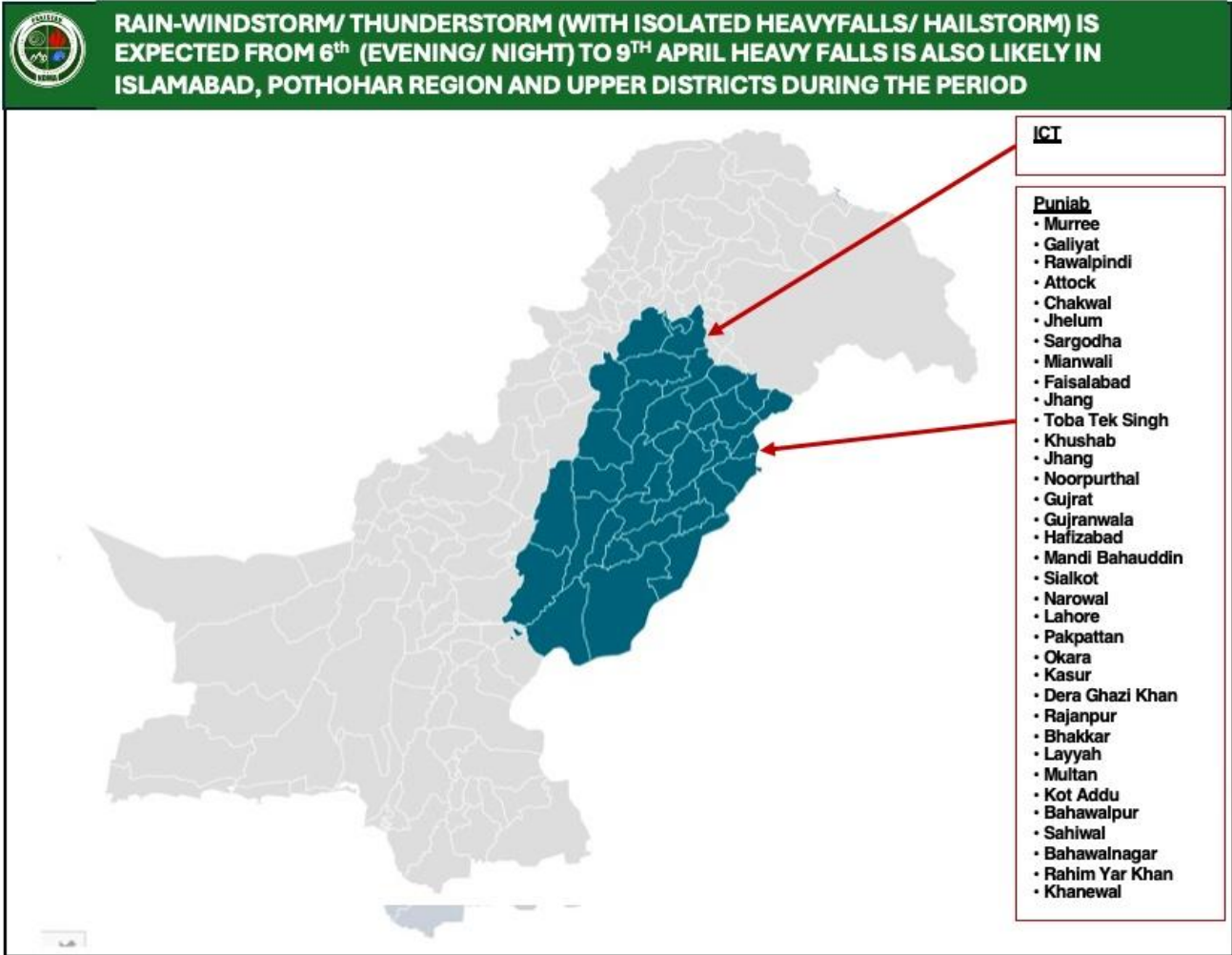

2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -
 - a. Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir during the period.
 - b. Due to heavy rains Flash flood is expected in Kashmir, northeast Balochistan (Khuzdar, Kalat, Mastung, Kohlu, Zhob, Barkhan, Loralai and Sherani) and Kohe Sulaiman mountains on 06th April while in local streams and nullahs of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Kurram, Orakzai, Khyber, Mohmand, Bajaur, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Malakand, Kohistan, Chitral, Buner and Abbottabad) from 07th to 08th April.
 - c. Urban flooding is also expected in Peshawar, Nowshera, Mardan, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Gujrat, Gujranwala and Sialkot on 07th & 08th April.
 - d. Windstorm/hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc) during the forecast period.
 - e. Hailstorm/windstorm may damage standing crops in Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Sindh. Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions.
 - f. Tourists and travellers are advised to remain cautious and avoid unnecessary traveling during the forecast period.
 - g. Day time temperatures are likely to decrease during the forecast period.
3. Keeping in view the possibility of **hailstorm**, following are the safety tips for general public: -
 - a. **Seek Shelter Immediately**. Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or vehicle.
 - b. **Stay Away from Windows**. Hail can shatter glass - stay in a windowless room if possible.
 - c. **Protect Your Head**. If caught outside, use anything available (bag, jacket, helmet) to cover your head and neck.
 - d. **Pull Over Safely (if driving)**. Stop the vehicle under a bridge, roofed area, or off the road. Stay inside with seatbelt fastened.
 - e. **Do Not Drive in Heavy Hail**. Visibility drops drastically and roads become slippery.
 - f. **Listen to Weather Updates**. Use radio, mobile alerts, or apps to monitor the situation.
 - g. **Advice for farmers**. Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions.
 - h. **Cover Vehicles and Equipment**. If time allows, protect vehicles, livestock, and outdoor equipment with tarps or blankets.
 - i. **Wait for the All-Clear**. Stay sheltered until authorities confirm it's safe to move.
4. All concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMA/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMA/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure all necessary measures**.
