



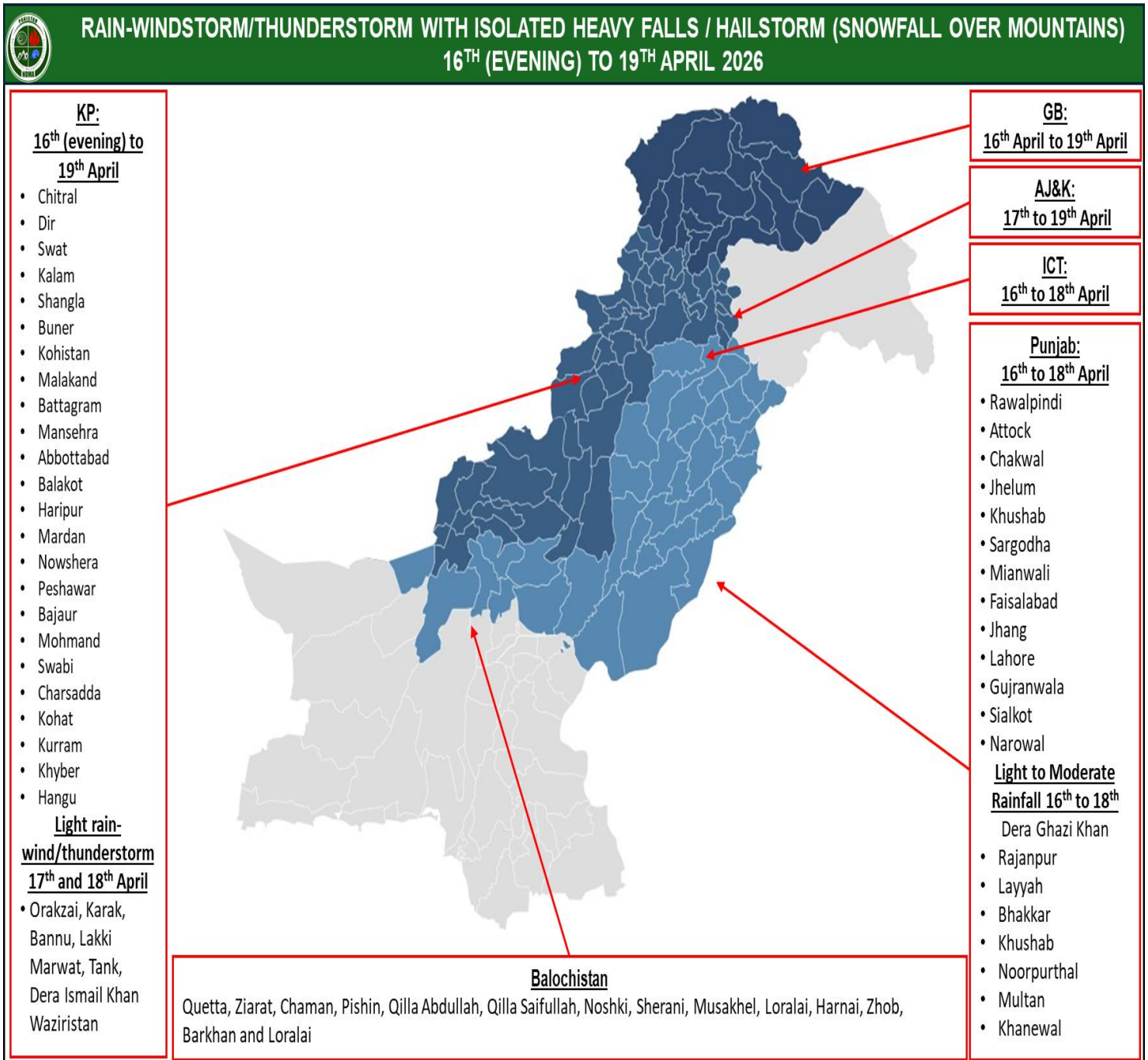

Subject: **Rain-Wind/Thunderstorm (with Isolated Heavy falls/Hailstorm) Predicted in Upper Parts From 16th to 19th April 2026**

Met office predicted that a **Westerly wave** is likely to approach **Northwestern parts** of the country on **16th April 2026** and likely to persist in Upper parts till **19th April 2026**. Under the influence of these Meteorological conditions following are the likely Impact areas: -



Sindh:

- Windstorm /dust raising winds are expected in upper Sindh from 16th to 18th April 2026.

2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -
 - a. Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan** and **Kashmir** from **17th to 19th April 2026**.
 - b. Windstorm/ hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc.) during the forecast period.
 - c. **Hailstorm / windstorm** may damage standing crops in **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa** and upper **Punjab**. Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions.
 - d. **Tourists** and **travelers** are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.
 - e. Due to heavy rains **Flash flood** is expected in vulnerable areas of **upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Shangla, Battagram, Chitral) Gilgit Baltistan and Kashmir (Neelum Valley)**.
3. All concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMAs/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMA/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure following necessary measures:-**
 - a. Maintain enhanced alert level / monitoring of developing situation to reduce reaction / response times.
 - b. All civil agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment during this period, especially at-risk areas.
 - c. Identification of vulnerable points / at-risk communities and devise mitigation and safety measures.
 - d. Launch urgent evacuation of trapped population using boats, heavy vehicles and helicopters (if required).
 - e. Prioritize vulnerable groups (women, children, elderly and persons with disabilities).
 - f. Fully operationalize pre-identified relief camps with adequate capacity.
 - g. Deploy mobile medical units and health teams in flood-hit areas.
 - h. Maintain strict control on vehicular movement near inundated areas.
 - i. Strengthen vulnerable embankments with sandbags and heavy machinery.
 - j. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be forewarned to shift cattle away from low lying areas adjacent to River & associated Nullahs.
 - k. Ensure availability of fodder for livestock at designated safe sites.
 - l. Provision of POL for back-up generators at water pumping stations and timely pre-placement of de-watering equipment for de-flooding.
 - m. DISCOs and relevant Local Administration / Departments to ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken to avoid electrocution incidents and timely restoration

of power supply.

- o. Coordinate with concerned departments for clearance of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction & waterlogging and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / appropriate locations.
 - p. Travelers and Tourists are forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
 - q. Highlight critical needs immediately for federal support.
4. **Flood Forecasting Division Only**. Please share regular updates on water flows on major rivers, **especially associated Nullahs every 3 hours** with NDMA.
