#### Subject: FLOOD ADVISORY - RIVER SUTLEJ EXCEPTIONALLY HIGH FLOOD LEVEL

Under the influence of a well-marked Monsoon low over North Rajasthan, in synchronization with a westerly wave over Kashmir and adjoining areas, Moderate Rainfall has commenced over the Upper catchments of the Sutlej River, both Upstream and Downstream of Bhakra and Pong dams. The prevailing weather system has the potential to produce Very Heavy to Exceptionally Heavy rainfall which, combined with releases from Indian dams, is likely to trigger Exceptionally High Flood Level in the Sutlej River at Ganda Singh Wala and downstream during the next 48 Hours; Flood Forecasting Division Warning No A-08/2025 dated 25 August 2025 attached as Annex-A. All concerned Authorities are advised to take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period and ensure the following: -

- Identification of vulnerable points / at-risk communities and devise a. mitigation and safety measures.
- Maintain enhanced alert level / monitoring of developing situation to reduce b. reaction / response times.
- All civil agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil C. Defence) to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and **equipment** during the next 48 hours, especially in at-risk areas.
- d. People living along the banks of River Sutlej & Indus and its associated Nullahs to be sensitized about expected increase of water flows.
- Timely evacuation of at-risk population from low-lying / flood prone areas e. as per Evacuation Plans and availability of shelter, food and medicines in those shelter camps.
- f. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be forewarned to shift cattle away from low lying areas adjacent to River Sutlej & Indus and its associated Nullahs.
- g. Restrict vehicle movement in low lying / at-risk areas, close to River Sutlej & Indus and its associated water channels / nullahs.
- h. Provision of POL for back-up generators at water pumping stations and timely pre-placement of de-watering equipment for de-flooding.
- i. DISCOs and relevant Local Administration / Departments to ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken to avoid electrocution incidents and

- timely restoration of power supply.
- j. Provision of relief / medical supplies to affectees in timely manner.
- k. Coordinate with concerned departments for clearance of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction & waterlogging and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / appropriate locations.
- I. Travelers and Tourists are forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
- m. In case of any eventuality, **Special SITREP / Update** be shared immediately with NDMA.
- 2. <u>Flood Forecasting Division Only</u>. Please share regular updates on water flows on major rivers, <u>especially River Sutlej every 3 hours</u> with NDMA.
- 3. <u>Press Information Department Only</u>. With the request for wider circulation and public awareness.
- 4. Forwarded for information / necessary action, please.
