Subject: **Dust/ Thunderstorm - Rain Predicted in Upper Parts of the Country from 2nd to 5th June 2026**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (**Annex-A**) has predicted that a **Westerly wave** is likely to approach **upper parts** of the country on **2nd June** and likely to persist till **5th June 2026**. Under the influence of this weather system:-

- a. **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**. Scattered **Rain wind / thunderstorm (with few heavy falls and hailstorm)** is expected in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu and Kurram from **2nd to 5th June 2026** with occasional gaps.
 - b. **Punjab/ Islamabad**. Scattered **dust / thunderstorm-rain (with few heavy falls and hailstorm)** is expected in Islamabad / Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar, Mianwali, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan and Layyah from **2nd to 5th June 2026** with **occasional gaps**.
 - c. **Azad Jammu & Kashmir/ Gilgit Baltistan**. Scattered **Rain wind / thunderstorm (with few heavy falls and hailstorm)** is expected in Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhnoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **2nd to 5th June 2026** with occasional gaps. Rain wind/thunderstorm is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche & Shigar) from **4th to 6th June 2026** with **occasional gaps**.
 - d. **Balochistan**. **Dust / thunderstorm-rain** is expected in **Northeastern parts** (Quetta, Zhob, Sherani, Ziarat, Chaman, Killa Abdullah, Killa Saifullah, Barkhan and Dera Bugti) from **2nd to 4th June 2026**.
 - e. **Sindh**. **Dust / thunderstorm-rain** is expected in **upper Sindh** (Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Khairpur, Dadu, Ghotki, Kashmore, Shikarpur and Shaheed Benazirabad) on **2nd to 4th June 2026**.
2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -
- a. Windstorm, hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill

boards, solar panels etc) during the forecast period.

- b. Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from **03rd to 06th June 2026**.
 - c. Farmers are advised to manage their activities in accordance with the dust storm and rain prediction.
 - d. Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.
3. Keeping in view the possibility of hailstorm, following are the safety tips for general public:-
- a. **Seek Shelter Immediately**. Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or vehicle.
 - b. **Stay Away from Windows**. Hail can shatter glass - stay in a windowless room if possible.
 - c. **Protect Your Head**. If caught outside, use anything available (bag, jacket, helmet) to cover your head and neck.
 - d. **Pull Over Safely (if driving)**. Stop the vehicle under a bridge, roofed area, or off the road. Stay inside with seatbelt fastened.
 - e. **Do Not Drive in Heavy Hail**. Visibility drops drastically and roads become slippery.
 - f. **Listen to Weather Updates**. Use radio, mobile alerts, or apps to monitor the situation.
 - g. **Cover Vehicles and Equipment**. If time allows, protect vehicles, livestock and outdoor equipment with tarps or blankets.
 - h. **Wait for the All-Clear**. Stay sheltered until authorities confirm it's safe to move.
4. All concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMAs/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMA/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure all necessary measures**.
5. **Press Information Department Only**. With the request for wider circulation and public awareness.

According to Met office westerly wave is likely to approach upper parts of the country on 02nd June and likely to persist till 05th June. Under the influence of this weather system.

Punjab/Islamabad: Scattered dust/thunderstorm-rain (with few heavyfalls and hailstorm) is expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Muree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar, Mianwali, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan and Layyah from 02nd to 05th June with occasional gaps.

Kashmir/Gilgit-Baltistan: Scattered Rain wind/thunderstorm (with few heavyfalls and hailstorm) is expected in Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from 02nd to 05th June with occasional gaps. Rain wind/thunderstorm is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar) from 04th to 06th June with occasional gaps.

Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa: Scattered Rain wind/thunderstorm (with few heavyfalls and hailstorm) is expected in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu and Kurram from 02nd to 05th June with occasional gaps.

Balochistan: Dust/thunderstorm-rain is expected in Northeastern parts (Quetta, Zhob, Sherani, Ziarat, Chaman, Qila Abdullah, Qillah Saifullah, Barkhan and Dera Bugti) from 02nd to 04th June.

Sindh: Dust/thunderstorm-rain is expected in upper Sindh (Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Khairpur, Dadu, Ghotki, Kashmore, Shikarpur, Shaheed Benazirabad) on 02nd to 04th June.

Possible Impacts and advises:

- Windstorm/ hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (solar panels, electric poles, bill boards etc.) during the forecast period.
- Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from 03rd to 06th June.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.

خیبر پختونخوا: 02 سے 05 جون کے دوران: در، ہزارا، سوات، کوہستان، مالاکنڈ، ہاٹھ، شانگلہ، بگرام، پونیر، کوہاٹ، بنوں، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، مہمند، خیبر، وزیرستان، اورکزئی، ماہرہ، لیٹ آباد، پشاور، مردان، بنگلہ اور کرم میں کہیں کہیں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش (بعض مقامات پر موسلا حد بارش اور ڈال بارش) کا امکان۔

بلوچستان: 02 سے 04 جون کے دوران: شمال مشرقی علاقوں (کوئٹہ، ڈوب، شیرانی، زیارت، چمن، قلعہ مہاراجہ، قلعہ سیف اللہ، ہارکھان اور ڈیرہ گمشدہ) میں تیز ہواؤں / آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ سندھ: 02 سے 04 جون کے دوران: بالائی اور جنوب مشرقی سندھ (سکھر، لاڑکانہ، جیکب آباد، ٹیرپور، ہوادہ، گھوٹکی، کشمور، حصار پور اور شہید تنظیم آباد) میں تیز ہواؤں / آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔
