


2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -
  - a. Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir during the period.
  - b. Due to heavy rains Flash flood is expected in northeast Balochistan (Khuzdar, Awaran, Kharan, Kalat, Mastung, Kohlu, Lasbela, Zhob, Qilla Saifullah, Qilla Abullah, Sherani), Hill torrents of Dera Ghazi Khan while in local stream and nullahs of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Khurram, Khyber, Mohmand, Bajaur, Dir, Swat, Malakand, Kohistan, Chitral) from 02nd to 04th April. Windstorm/ hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, billboards, solar panels etc.) during the forecast period.
  - c. Windstorm/ hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc) during the forecast period.
  - d. Hailstorm/windstorm may damage standing crops in Punjab, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa and Sindh. Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions.
  - e. Tourists and travellers are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.
  - f. Day time temperatures are likely to decrease during the forecast period.
3. Keeping in view the possibility of **hailstorm**, following are the safety tips for general public: -
  - a. **Seek Shelter Immediately**. Move indoors or take cover in a sturdy building or vehicle.
  - b. **Stay Away from Windows**. Hail can shatter glass - stay in a windowless room if possible.
  - c. **Protect Your Head**. If caught outside, use anything available (bag, jacket, helmet) to cover your head and neck.
  - d. **Pull Over Safely (if driving)**. Stop the vehicle under a bridge, roofed area, or off the road. Stay inside with seatbelt fastened.
  - e. **Do Not Drive in Heavy Hail**. Visibility drops drastically and roads become slippery.
  - f. **Listen to Weather Updates**. Use radio, mobile alerts, or apps to monitor the situation.
  - g. **Advice for farmers**. Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions.
  - h. **Cover Vehicles and Equipment**. If time allows, protect vehicles, livestock, and outdoor equipment with tarps or blankets.
  - i. **Wait for the All-Clear**. Stay sheltered until authorities confirm it's safe to move.

4. All concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMAs/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMAs/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure all necessary measures**.
