

The well-marked low-pressure area (WML) over Saurashtra coast and adjoining Gulf of Kuch, Gujrat (India) has moved Westward and now lay over Northeast Arabian Sea and adjoining Saurashtra coast, Gujrat (India) about 310Km Southeast of Karachi. The system is likely to move Westwards, intensify further into a depression during next 12 hours over Northeast Arabian Sea and move initially in West / Southwest direction.

2. Under its influence, Wind-Thunderstorm / Rain of light to moderate intensity likely in Tharparkar, Umerkot, Sanghar, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Thatta, Sujawal, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Matiari districts and Karachi Division today.


