- Rain-wind-thundershower is expected in Mirpurkhas, Tharparkar, Umerkot, Sanghar, Thatta, Badin Karachi, Hyderabad, Tando Allayar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Mitiari, Shaheed Benazirabad, Dadu, Kalat, Khuzdar, & Lasbella from 28th September (Tuesday) to 2nd October (Staurday) with occasional gaps. Heavy falls are also expected in Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Dadu and Hyderabad during the period.
- Rain-wind-thunderstorm is also expected at scattered places in Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Kohlu, Sibbi, Naseerabad, Barkhan, Zhob, Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, and Bahawalpur during 28th September (Tuesday) to 30th September (Thursday).
- Isolated Rain-wind-thunderstorm is expected in Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan,
 Islamabad, Northeast Punjab, Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa druing 27th/28th
