Punjab:

Scattered rainfall, thunderstorm and strong windstorm is expected in upper and central parts of the province including Murree, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Faisalabad, Lahore, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan and surrounding areas on 24, 25 and 29 April. Southern and Central Punjab is expected to remain mostly dry and warm during this period.

Balochistan:

Isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, and windstorm is expected in northern districts including Quetta, Ziarat, Kalat, Khuzdar and surrounding areas on 24, 25 and 27 to 29 April. Northern and Western districts of province will mainly be affected. Coastal areas including Gwadar are expected to remain mainly dry. Temperatures will also steadily rise in the province.

Sindh:

The province is expected to remain mainly hot and dry during this period. Temperatures will also steadily rise in the province. However, very light rainfall with thunderstorm and gusty winds may occur in Hyderabad, Badin, Mithi and surrounding areas on 24 April.

KP:

Isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, is expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Malakand, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Charsadda, Nowshera, Kohat, Kurram and surrounding areas from 24, 25 and 27 to 29 April. Isolated snowfall is also expected in higher altitude regions.

GB & AJK:

Isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, and strong windstorm is expected across the region including Gilgit, Skardu, Hunza, Ghizer, Diamer, Astore, Muzaffarabad, Neelum Valley, Bagh, Haveli, Poonch and surrounding areas from 24 to 29 April. Isolated snowfall is also expected in higher altitude regions.
