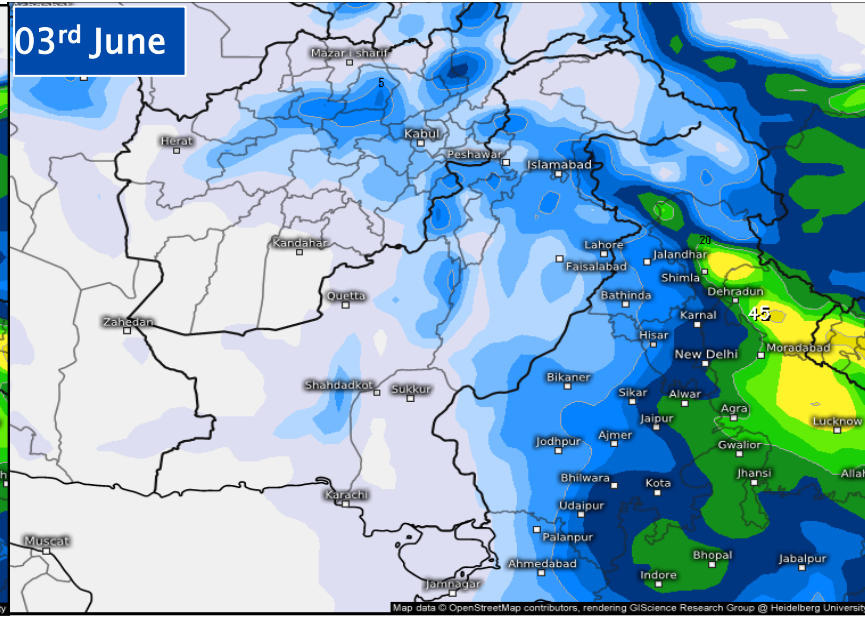

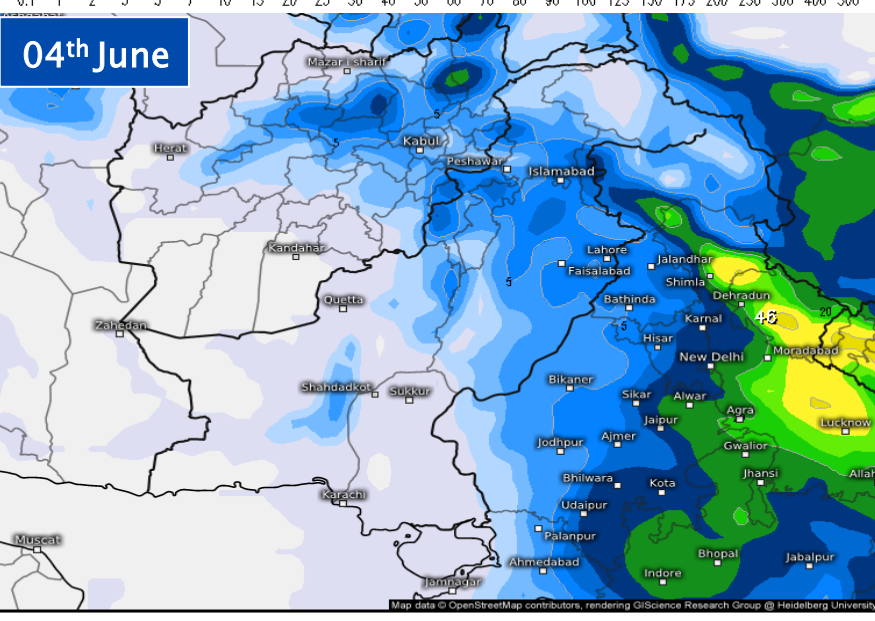
Accumulated total precipitation (mm) From Wed 05/27/2026, 07:00pm CDT to Mon 06/01/2026, 01:00am CDT



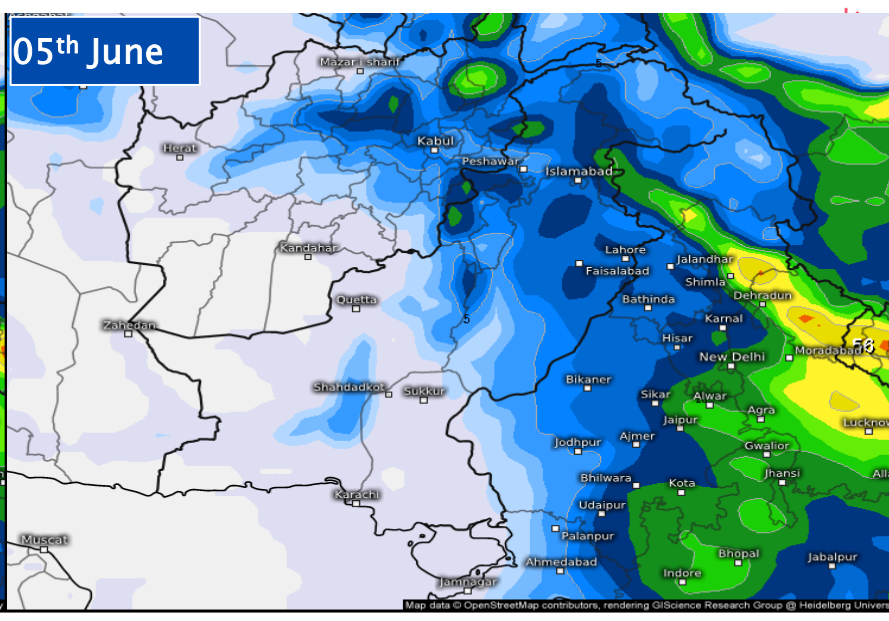
Accumulated total precipitation (mm) From Wed 05/27/2026, 07:00pm CDT to Tue 06/02/2026, 01:00am CDT



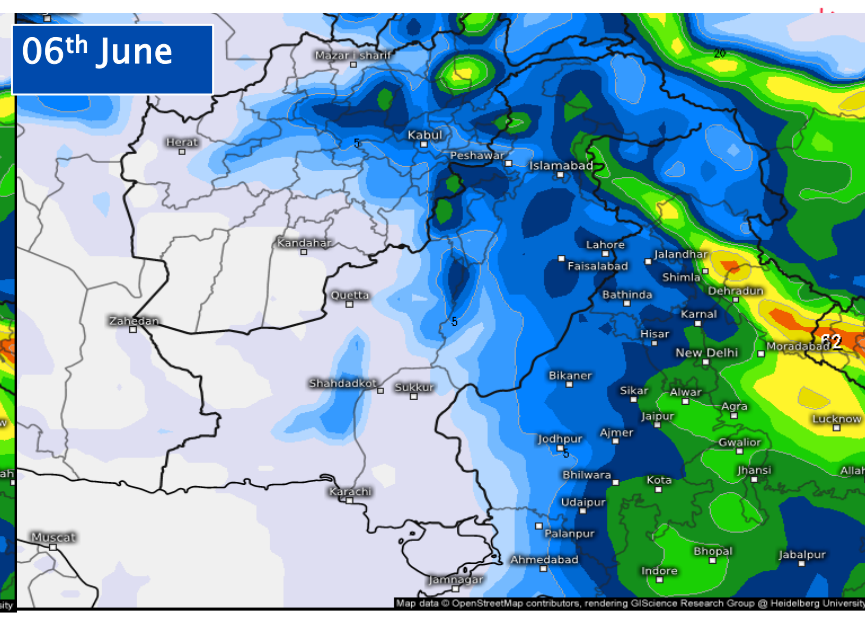
Accumulated total precipitation (mm) From Wed 05/27/2026, 07:00pm CDT to Wed 06/03/2026, 07:00am CDT

Hot and dry weather is expected over most parts of the country during 01–06 June due to prevailing continental conditions. However, a weak westerly disturbance interacting with moist air may generate scattered rain-thunderstorms over upper Punjab, KP, GB, and AJK, with increased activity from 04–06 June, while isolated thunderstorms are also possible in parts of Sindh and Balochistan.

Punjab:

The province is expected to experience scattered rain-thunderstorms in northern Punjab including Murree, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Islamabad, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore and surrounding areas. Isolated to scattered rain-thunderstorm activity is also expected in southern Punjab including Multan, Khanewal, Vehari, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, Rahim Yar Khan and surrounding areas.

Balochistan:

Most parts of the province are expected to remain hot and dry during the forecast period. However, isolated rain-thunderstorm activity may occur in Zhob, Musakhel, Barkhan, Sherani, Quetta, Ziarat and surrounding areas.

Sindh:

Isolated light showers and dust-thunderstorm activity is expected in parts of southern Sindh including Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Tharparkar, Umerkot and surrounding areas. Isolated rain-thunderstorm activity is also possible in northern Sindh including Sukkur, Larkana, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Kashmore, and surrounding areas. Most of the province is expected to remain dry.

KP:

The province is expected to experience scattered to widespread rain-thunderstorms in districts including Chitral Upper & Lower, Dir Upper & Lower, Swat, Shangla, Kohistan Upper & Lower, Battagram, Torghar, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Buner, Malakand, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Mardan, Swabi, Peshawar, Nowshera, Kohat, Hangu, Kurram and surrounding areas. Widespread activity is expected from 04–06 June.

GB & AJK:

Widespread rain-thunderstorm activity is expected in Gilgit, Hunza, Skardu, Ghizer, Diamer, Astore, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, Bagh, Poonch and surrounding areas during the forecast period.
