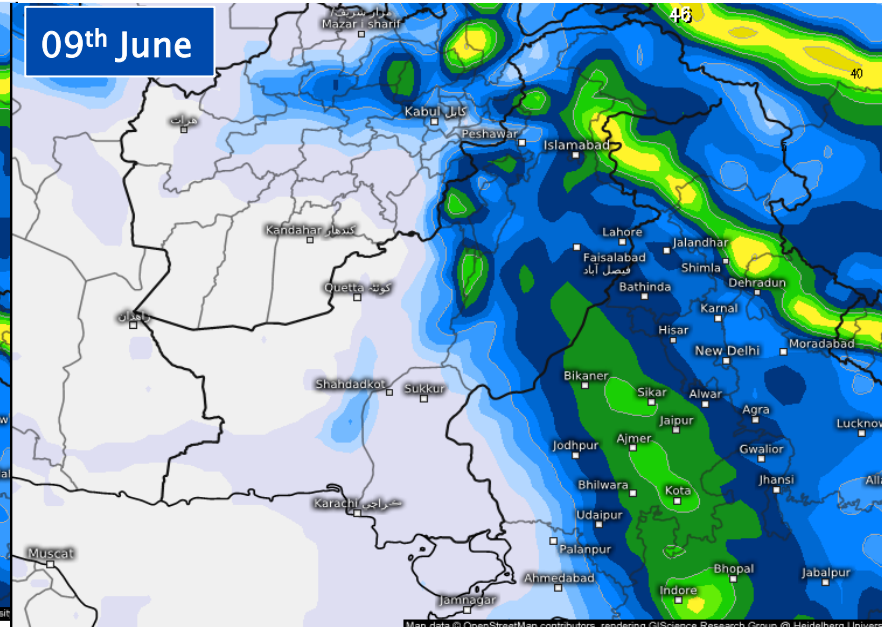
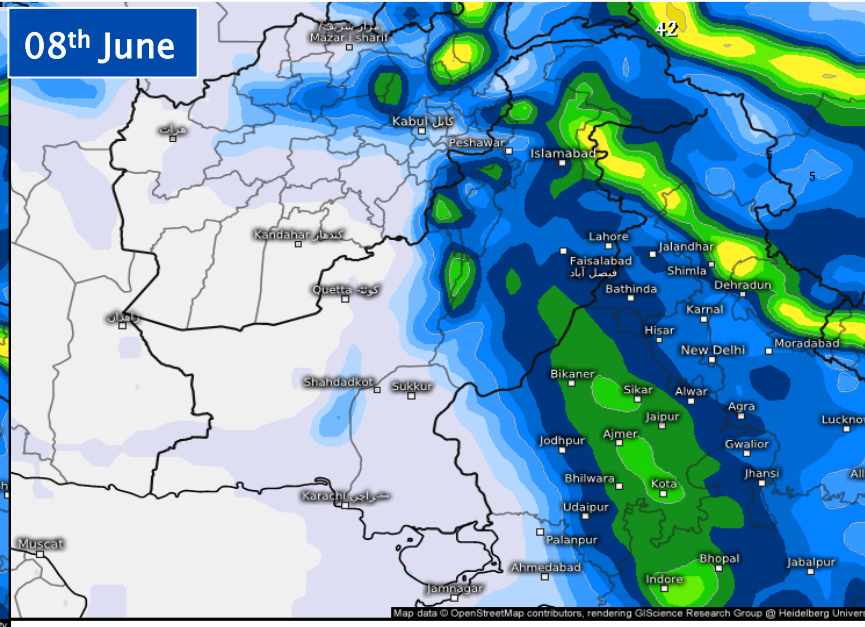
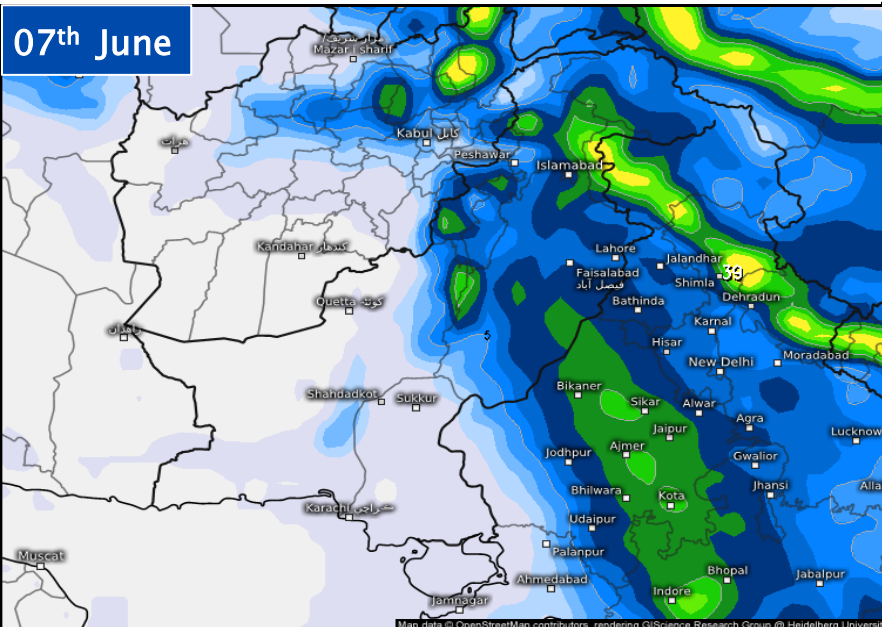




# Weather Advisory (07<sup>th</sup> June to 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2026)

Heatwave conditions are expected to prevail across most parts of the country, with more intense heatwave conditions likely over Sindh, southern Punjab, and much of Balochistan. A weak westerly wave and localized moisture may trigger isolated rain-thunderstorms over upper KP, Islamabad, northern Punjab, GB, and AJK during 11–12 June.

**Punjab:** Heatwave conditions are expected to prevail across Punjab, with maximum temperatures remaining significantly above normal over central and southern districts. Isolated to scattered rain-thunderstorms may occur during 11–12 June over Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Lahore, and adjoining areas, accompanied by occasional gusty winds. Southern Punjab is expected to remain under persistent heatwave conditions

**Sindh:** Heatwave conditions are expected to prevail across Sindh during 07–12 June, including Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur, Larkana, Mirpurkhas, and Tharparkar, with temperatures remaining above normal over most districts. Isolated cloud development may occur over northern Sindh

**Balochistan:** Heatwave conditions are expected to prevail Balochistan during this week. However, isolated rain-thunderstorms may develop during 11–12 June over northeastern districts including Zhob, Musakhel and adjoining areas due to weak upper-level disturbances. Heatwave conditions are likely to persist across central and southern Balochistan, with heatwave and heat stress conditions continuing in lowland districts.

**KP:** Heatwave conditions are expected to prevail across most parts of KP during 07–10 June. However, a weak westerly wave and localized moisture may trigger isolated to scattered rain-thunderstorms during 11–12 June over Chitral, Dir, Swat, Malakand, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Peshawar, and adjoining areas

**GB & AJK:** A weak westerly pattern and persistent moisture availability may produce scattered to widespread rain-thunderstorms during 07–12 June over GB and AJK. Localized moderate to heavy rain falls and gusty winds are possible over higher elevations. Temperatures are expected to remain below normal due to cloud cover and precipitation.
